FROM FR. LEO



Today Jesus' public ministry begins. John recognized him and refused to baptize him knowing the reverse would be more appropriate. But to fulfill the words of the prophets Jesus persuaded him to go ahead and baptize him. When he did, the heavens opened, a dove descended on him, and a voice from heaven declared Jesus as his beloved son, with whom the Father is well pleased.

In the Acts of the Apostles, Paul adds that after his baptism, "Jesus went about doing good and healing those who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him." His ministry of healing and reuniting us with the Father began.

From this we have the Sacrament of Baptism in the church. In baptism we are lowered into the water, the tomb of Christ, to share in his death. Then rising up out of the water we come to share in his resurrection. We enter the tomb and then rise with Christ being baptized in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

When we celebrate baptism, I like to think that the Father speaks the same words over us that he spoke over Jesus. This is my beloved son or daughter, in whom I am well pleased. Just as parents are pleased in their child. The grace given in baptism is the foundation of our faith that grows until we rise from this life. It's a big celebration bestowing the promise of eternal life now and forever. We celebrate being adopted the sons and daughters of God.

The grace of baptism helps us become saints of God; disciples who live in the same spirit of Christ and bring that spirit to others. We become another Christ; vehicles for the Holy Spirit to work through to continue to forgive and heal as Jesus did.

This first sacrament of Initiation culminates in the third sacrament of initiation, the Holy Eucharist. Here we receive the body of Christ to become the body of Christ and be formed more and more in his image.

Today, we celebrate our adoption in Christ and are called to find joy knowing that God has made us his sons and daughters and that in us he is well pleased!
