## From Fr. Leo



Reading today's gospel reminded me of Sr. Thea Bowman, F.S.P.A. A young black woman who joined an all white convent in La Crosse, Wisconsin. At first her "Amen's" during liturgy were a little disturbing to the good sisters of the North, but a professed sister she became. She was the first black woman to graduate from Catholic University. A woman of talent as a teacher, speaker, evangelizer and singer. She helped her sisters embrace the black community at a time it wasn't much spoken of.

At her life celebration in La Crosse we were standing on the pews at one point singing, "This little light of mine. I'm going to let it shine, I'm going to let it shine. The song was her! She was a little light that shined with the light of Christ transforming the Catholic Church in America. There were many bishops at her funeral and now there is a cause put forth for her canonization. Her last years and illness was spent in the South where she did much for the Church and where she was laid to rest.

She was my teacher. She asked in class what was wisdom? I responded something to the effect that it is a way of perceiving. She liked the answer. She new wisdom because she had a deep and living faith that was most evident when her incredible voice sang the negro spirituals with heart. She sang one in class as she was teaching about how oral tradition precedes written tradition.

My point in telling her story, is that we all are a "little light of God." We are our own Thea Bowman! And I think, what lights that little fire that grows, is the experience of the Holy Spirit. St. Paul mentions that faith isn't knowing just what he taught them, but the experience of God's power that they experienced through him.

Let us pray for that experience, that each of us may glow intensely with the love of God animating us to love, to love some more, and some more! Let us let our little lights shine! Amen!
