

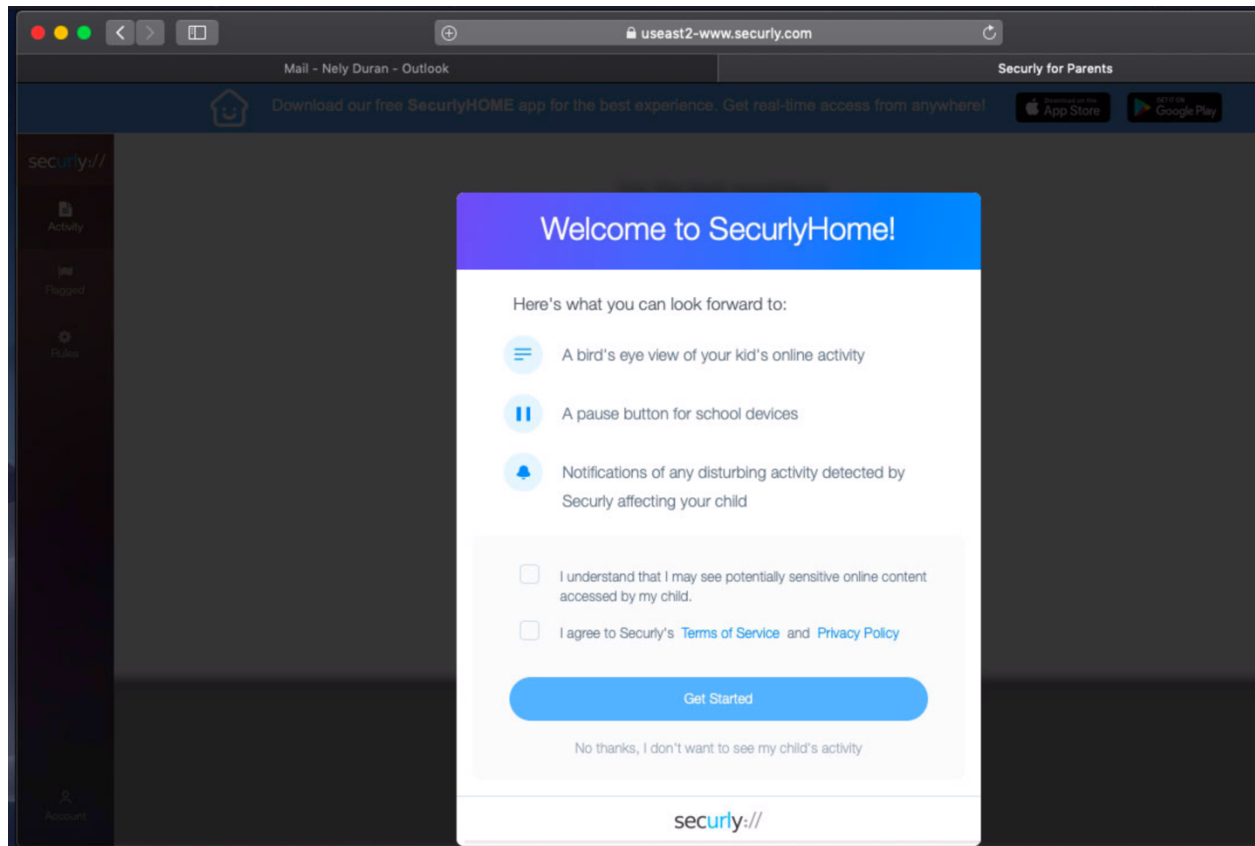
## Parent Portal (Desktop Browser)

When you open the Magic link on your desktop computer, the portal will open as shown below:

After you logon for the first time with the Magic link on a desktop browser, you will be requested to update your password. Please ensure to make a note of your new password.



## Sample web Parent Portal:

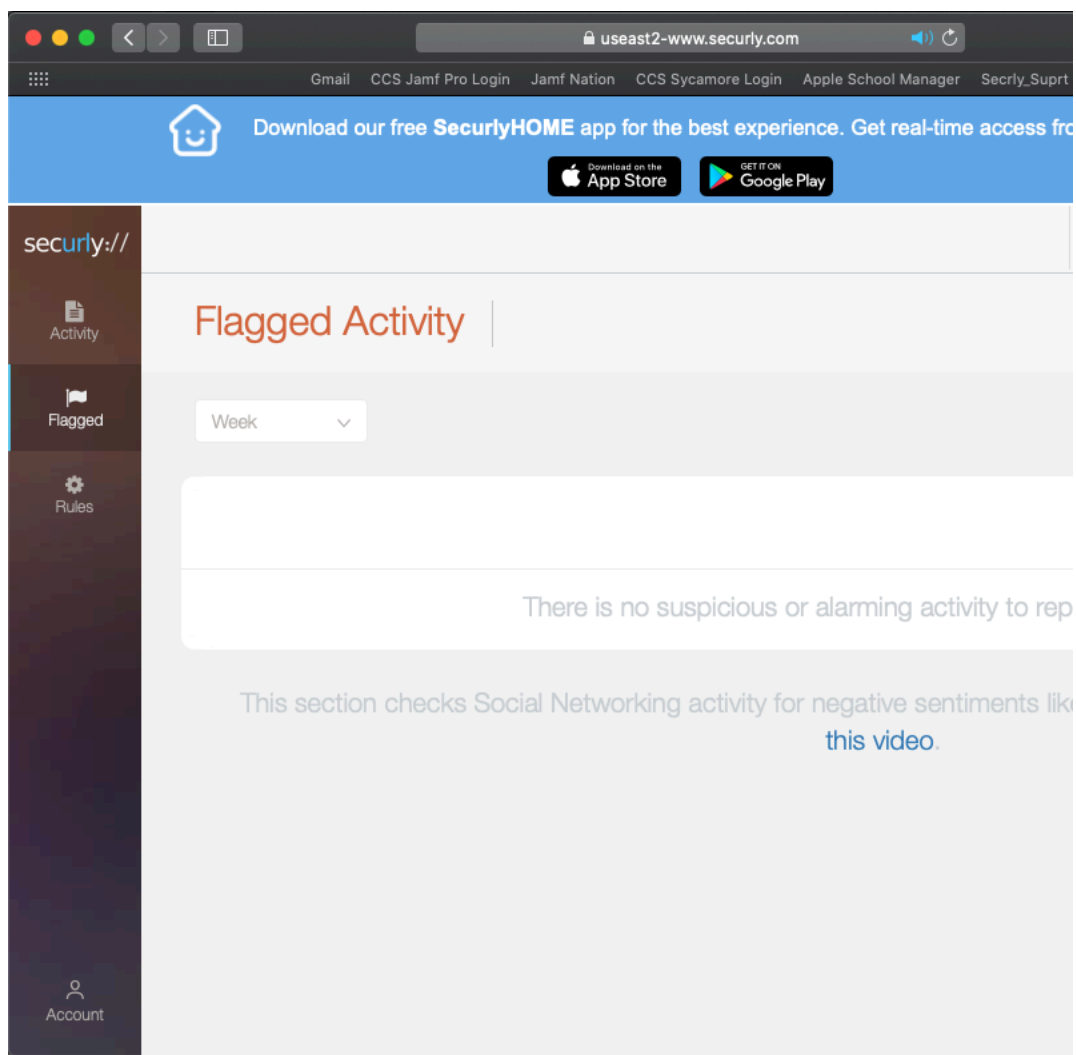
**Activity** feed shows all internet traffic from your student device. You may sort data through the listed columns, or perform searches via keyword and date range.



**Flagged Activity** gives you an overview of data that your student is working on that may trigger an alert. Because Securly also [detects verbiage](#) that coincides with negative emotions or actions the system will log the activity and raise a flag to alert you of the incident.
