3 points of Entry

Bus drop off—Sidewalk between the Church & School

Car dropoff—Front Entrance
Traffic circle

PreK 3—Entrance to the
PreK3 room on the east side of
the school.

If a temperature of **100.0 degrees farenheight or greater** is found,
that student ***must go home***.

New wrist temperature scanners
positioned at the main entrance and
at the side Bus arrival entrance.

Instant read nontouch thermometers
for screening student arrival by car.

2 students at a time.



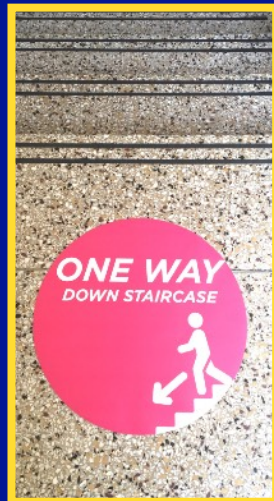
All students must wear a mask upon entering the school building

Supervised Mask breaks throughout the day when students are socially distanced during lunch and periodically during the day.

Students are recommended to bring a few clean masks for use each day.

Social distancing in hallways and classrooms and upon entering & leaving the school will be enforced.

Directional hallways and staircases are marked to ensure social distancing.

Students will not be permitted into the building until **7:40am**

No one except the screened student is permitted to leave the car, or enter the building at morning dropoff.

3 Exits for Dismissal

Dismissal will be at 2:20 through the front doors for Bus riders.

Dismissal will be at 2:20 through the Church Side exit for MiniBus riders.

Dismissal will be at 2:20 through the back door for car pickups.



Lunch will be eaten in the classroom, socially distanced, with a mask break for eating.

Menu will be posted online, or bring your own.

Preordered wrapped lunch will be brought to the student in the classroom.

Students will remain within their cohorts for a socially distanced Recess period, out of doors weather permitting.

Bagged snacks and drinks will be offered for sale each day.

Isolation Rooms

Two Guardian Angel Rooms have been designated within the Nurse's complex to accommodate students and staff who have symptoms.

St. Augustine School has a fulltime fully certified Nurse on campus for all students needs.

Students with symptoms will be taken immediately to the Guardian Angel Room, they will wear a face mask and will await immediate pick up by an authorized person. Parents or guardians will be notified.
