



Good people frequently disagree on which problems to address, which policies to adopt and how best to apply them. But for citizens and elected officials alike, the basic principle is simple: We must begin with a commitment never to intentionally kill, or collude in the killing, of any innocent human life, no matter how broken, unformed, disabled or desperate that life may seem. In other words, the choice of certain ways of acting is always and radically incompatible with the love of God and the dignity of the human person created in His

of the Day

Jesus' gaze, when he walked the earth, would cause a profound awakening in others. When he passed by, the eyes of the blind were opened. Paralytics threw away their crutches. Those who were sick sprang from their beds completely cured. Jesus had a divine attraction about him which tore at hearts that were thirsting for love and truth. He satisfied their longing because he himself was love, truth, and life. Jesus always looks at us with infinite kindness. He watches over us. He never tires of knocking at the door of our hearts. Nor does he tire of waiting for us to open to him, because he loves us. He will take our mortal life into his own divine hands so that he might give us eternal life. He will close our eyes here on earth, that he might open them to the true light. He will always be our consolation and our happiness. He will not al low us to weep like those who have no hope. The Father looks with a glance that gives. By means of that eternal and infinite gaze, the Father communi cated his essence to the divine Word. That gaze is life giving, since it is the gaze of God himself. Let us ask Jesus to look at us...with this life-giving gaze that pro duces saints. Let us beg for those divine glances that open the soul to holy expansiveness. And let us allow ourselves to be bathed in those most holy glances that purify, sanctify, unite, and intimately bind the divine heart to our own. Jesus wishes that his eternal gaze at his Father pass on through our souls and our eyes. His is a gaze of purity, tenderness, and adoration. Let us always keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, that we may know him, discern his desires, better understand his teachings, and penetrate into his heart.
