**Beginner Group (\$50 per month)** Mondays 2:45 – 3:45pm weekly, starting October 16

This group is geared towards students in grades K – 4 who are new to learning the violin and/or have minimal experience. Students in beginner group will grow and expand in their musicianship skills and learn the fundamentals in violin. Students are strongly encouraged to take separate private lessons with either Miss Nuzzo or with another instructor.

This group is geared towards students in grades 5-8 who already have foundations in violin and sight reading. Students in the intermediate class will grow and expand in sight reading and violin expertise. This year marks an exciting change for the Choir program! Choir will be offered at both the St. Mary's elementary and St. Joseph's middle school campuses of Kingston Catholic School.

## Instrumental Music Program



Kingston Catholic School offers instrumental music lessons (brass, woodwinds and percussion) and ensemble classes (Band). Students in grades 4 -8 can sign up to participate.

The instruments available to learn are: **trumpet, trombone, clarinet, saxophone, flute, and drums**. String instruments (violin, cello, etc. ) use a different sign up sheet provided by Ms. Nuzzo.

Lessons and band rehearsals will be held immediately after school. Students with one or more years of experience will have a group lesson once per week and have a band rehearsal once per week. Beginning students will have a group lesson once per week at first, then join a band class after 4 months ( usually in February) . The schedule will be set up during the first week in October. Cost:

**Returning music students** who will be in the intermediate band - \$75 per month. This covers one group lesson and one band rehearsal per week. (October will be pro rated because we are starting during the week of Oct. 9<sup>th</sup>).

**Beginners** - \$50 per month for the first four months. Beginners will get one group lesson per week ( 2- 4 students in each group) until we will start beginner band (Usually after February). The beginners WILL BE PLAYING in the Christmas concert Dec. 19<sup>th</sup>, but Beginner band rehearsals will not formally start until February or March 2018 ( It usually takes 4 or 5 months of lessons to get the beginner band started)....the fee will then increase to \$75 per month ( at that time). \* October will be pro rated because we will start lessons the week of Oct. 9<sup>th</sup>.

Parents,

You will need to rent or buy an instrument for your child to play. Barcone's is the most local music store with good rental programs for students. I recommend that you call them first. If they don't have your choice of instrument available at this time, call the other music stores on the list.

**To non-beginners and returning students:** Bring your instrument and all music materials that you have studied in the past...we will then decide after the first lesson which book(s) to use.

**To ALL beginners (Brass, Woodwinds, & Drums):** You need to buy the method book called "Essential Elements 2000" Book 1. (for your choice of instrument). These books are in stock at Barcone's Music in Kingston (331-6089) This book comes with a DVD/CD in the book. I recommend that you and your parent(s) watch the "Startup Video" (put in the DVD to your computer, click "Startup Page", then click on "Startup Video"). Have your child follow along with his/her instrument. Watching this video will give you a head start on your first lesson!

**Saxophone students:** You will need to buy alto saxophone reeds. **Brand:** Rico **Strength:** 2 1/2 They come in packs of three.

**Clarinet students:** You will need to buy reeds. **Brand:** Rico **Strength:** 2 1/2... They come in packs of three.

**Drummers:** Parents...it's easiest to buy a practice pad and sticks. Also, buy the Essential Elements Book 1 for Percussion.

**To all:** Rental instruments generally do not have swabs or cleaning kits. For woodwinds, I recommend "Pad Saver" type swabs. They are fast and easy to use. Ask at Barcone's for the correct size. Brass players need a mouthpiece brush.
