WHAT: This family friendly event calls for volunteers to reserve a spot in the St. Mary's Church parking to lot to park their car and decorate their trunks/tailgates. Students (and parents too!) can dress up in their Halloween costumes and trick-or-treat from car to car in the St. Mary's Church parking lot. To ensure student safety, this is a closed event and **only open to KCS families.**

WHERE: St Mary's Church parking lot (families may park in back school lot and around school grounds), then walk through walkway entrance on Broadway to crossing zone. If you are parking on McEntee Street, please walk in front of school to crossing zone.

WHEN: Friday October 27th 6 -7pm. Cars may arrive at 5:00 pm for set-up. Lot will be closed at 5:55pm for student safety.



Progress Reports!



It has been an amazing first five weeks at KCS! Please find in your family envelope your child's MAP score report for grades K-8. Also in this week's envelope, is your students' five-week progress report for scholars in grades 1-8.

The purpose of the MAP score report is to show you your child's current level of mastery in the areas assessed, as well as his/her growth from last spring. This data is used by your child's teacher to plan for instruction, re-teaching, and goal set.

Progress Reports are there to let you know how your student is performing, while there is still plenty of time to address any issues of concern before Quarter 1 report cards. Please review Progress Reports carefully, students in grades 3-8 could be included when you review the reports. Once you have reviewed your child's Progress Report, kindly sign it and return it to school on or before Monday, October 16th. As always, your child's success in school is important to us. Please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher with any questions or concerns. (All staff emails at KCS are first name. last name at kingstoncatholic.org)

WE NEED YOUR HELP, PLEASE
