## October 27th, 2023

WHAT: This family friendly event calls for volunteers to reserve a spot in the St. Mary's Church parking to lot to park their car and decorate their trunks/tailgates. Students will come trick-or-treating to the trunks. Parents, faculty or KCS Student Organizations (Honor Society, Scouts, Student Council, with required adult/faculty supervision) are invited to reserve spots. Older students and siblings of PK-4 students may hand out candy with a family sponsored vehicle.
REGISTRATION FORMS ARE INCLUDED. ONLY THOSE RESERVING A PARKING SPOT/DECORATING A trunk need to register.

WHO: Trunk or Treat is open to all current students in Pre-K through $\mathbf{4}^{\text {th }}$ Grade accompanied by an adult. Students (and parents too!) can dress up in their Halloween costumes and trick-or-treat from car to car in the St. Mary's Church parking lot. To ensure student safety, this is a closed event and only open to KCS families.

WHERE: St Mary's Church parking lot (families may park in back school lot and around school grounds), then walk through walkway entrance on Broadway to crossing zone. If you are parking on McEntee Street, please walk in front of school to crossing zone.

WHEN: Friday October 27th $6-7 \mathrm{pm}$. Cars may arrive at 5:00 pm for set-up. Lot will be closed at $5: 55 \mathrm{pm}$ for student safety.

# Kingston Catholic School Family Organization <br> Minutes of a Regular Meeting <br> Wednesday, October 18 ${ }^{\text {th }}, 2023$ 

A regular meeting of the Kingston Catholic School Family Organization (KCSFO) was held on Wednesday October 18 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ at 6:00 pm.

Minutes: Previous minutes have been reviewed and any open items are addressed below.

## Administration update:

- It has been a busy few weeks at KCS! The front doors have been replaced and painted.
- Clubs have started up again, and there are many offerings. For more information, please see the weekly envelopes on our website.
- With the exception of PK, all grades have enjoyed a field trip this fall, and the middle school will take another trip to the Center of Performing Arts in November.
- Earlier this month the Kingston Fire Department came to KCS for Fire prevention Day.
- There is no school on Friday 10/20. This is a Data Day for our educators to review NYS and MAP tests to plan for the next 10 weeks of school.
- Student Council will be planning a pumpkin hunt for Pre-K, date TBD
- After listening to the explanation of our fundraising goal at Back-to-School night, a generous $\$ 5,000$ donation was made to the KCSFO, and the donor would like to remain anonymous. Thank you!!


## Treasurer's Report/Recap:

- We collected $\$ 1,258$ from the Go for the Goal dress down day to be donated to pediatric cancer research.
- $\$ 360$ was raised from the 5 guys October restaurant night and the check should be arriving shortly from Gellfam, the parent company of 5 Guys.
- To date we have collected $\$ 105$ in craft vendor fees for the Pancake Breakfast in December.
- The balance in our account is $\$ 19,487.85$.


## Community Outreach:

- Linda Bradley dropped the sweater drive donation off at People's Place and they were very grateful.
- Gina Nuzzo is arranging a coat drive for November for Family of Woodstock as well as a pet food drive in honor of the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi (10/4) which will be brought to the Saugerties Animal shelter and possibly the SPCA.
- We will participate in a Christmas gift drive for People’s Place and Gina Nuzzo will send information out in the weekly envelope.


## Old Business:

1. Art to Remember projects: 33 art projects were turned in, which is not quite the turnout we were hoping for. Next year we will try to turn this into a buddy activity for the first Friday of September. The artwork we received has been sent to Art to Remember and Jenn will send home order forms when they are available.
2. Monsignor O'Connor: Monsignor has embarked on the next chapter of his life and before his departure he was presented with a Perpetual Mass offering at the National Shrine of The Divine Mercy on behalf of the KCS community.
3. Father Bill's Anniversary gift: A pewter chalice and case was ordered for Father Bill, and Goretti is working on getting a plaque for the case engraved. This gift will be presented to him hopefully at the First Friday mass in November.

## New Business/Upcoming Events:

1. Trunk or Treat, Friday $\mathbf{1 0} / \mathbf{2 7} \mathbf{6 - 7 p m}$ : At the time of the meeting 16 trunks were confirmed and any remaining sign ups will be sent to Beth Eisgruber. The timing of Prayer group at St. Mary's has been changed for 10/27 and we have safety officers lined up so we should not have any issues with traffic in the parking lot during the event. The NJHS will host a trunk and they will also be in charge of judging the trunks this year. Beth is in the process of securing items for $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ prizes.
2. Santa Fe Restaurant Night: Our November restaurant night will be held on Thursday $11 / 2$ at the Sante Fe Uptown location only, for dine-in or take out, and $20 \%$ of sales will be donated back to KCS. This is always a popular and fun night for KCS!
3. First Friday family social 11/3: Wood $N$ Wheel invites us to skate on Friday $11 / 3$ from $1: 30-$ 4 pm . The cost is $\$ 15 \mathrm{pp}$, and this is a social event, not a fundraiser. Tina and Jamie will help collect payment at the door. Beth will create the flyer for this event.
4. Deising's Thanksgiving Pie Sale: Orders will be due back on $11 / 13$ so they can be totaled and sent to Eric on $11 / 14$. Melissa will adjust the flyer and Mimi will contact Eric to arrange for a delivery.
5. Raise Right: This is a gift card fundraiser that Linda Bradley will organize. Order forms will go out on $11 / 15$ and be due back on 12/1. Gift cards can also be ordered at the Santa Breakfast on 12/3.
6. The Holiday Shoppe: Linda Bradley has contacted Lil' Shoppers and sent up the holiday shoppe. Students will have the opportunity to shop for holiday gifts during the school day by grade. The shop will be open 12/4, $12 / 5$ and half a day on 12/6. Kristin Bradley, Jackie Chiappetta and Jamie Baressi have volunteered to help with this event.
7. Santa Breakfast: Catering through Dana foods has been confirmed for Sunday $12 / 3$ so this event will be a Pancake breakfast once again! Student servers and adult volunteers will be needed. 9. Auction: The auction will be held at Ole Savannah on Saturday $5 / 4$ in the evening. Cynthia would also like to organize an online component to the auction to reach those not able to attend. More details to come.
