

OCTOBER

OUR LEARNING FOCUS...

Math 5: The students will reason correctly using place value understanding to relate adjacent base ten units from millions to thousandths. The students will then be able to multiply a decimal fraction by a power of ten, the product will be shifting to the left or right on a place value chart.

Math 6: The students will be able to identify rational and irrational numbers as they explore operations using decimals.

Math 7: The students will be able to understand Integer Numbers on a number line. They will develop an understanding of how to use new vocabulary relating to positive and negative numbers and how to evaluate operations using integers.

Religion 7: The students will learn the ways that members of the Church can live by the virtues of faith, hope, and love.

Math 8: In this unit, students build upon their foundation with exponents as they make conjectures about how zero and negative exponents of a number should be defined and prove the properties of integer exponents They make sense out of very large and very small numbers, using the number line model to guide their understanding of the relationship of those numbers to each other.

Algebra I: The students develop general methods for solving linear equations using properties of equality and inverse operations. Solutions to equations and inequalities are defined in terms of making statements true.
