Is your child frequently late to school?

We need your help.



Problems with Tardiness: The most crucial learning hours of a school day are the morning hours because they are when students are most attentive. Students who are tardy miss the beginning of their morning classes, and they also cause a distraction when they arrive late to class. We schedule reading and math blocks in the morning so that our students have the best opportunity to learn. Arriving late, impedes crucial learning in these two core subject areas.

Effect on Others: When students are tardy, they negatively impact their teachers and other students. Teachers are often required to disrupt their teaching and learning environment to allow tardy students to catch up on their work. This often requires teachers to restructure their lessons or re-teach missed material. <u>Tardiness also takes other students' attention away from a teacher's lesson, leading to more behavior concerns and missed instruction.</u>

As a school community, we are here to help. Here are some suggestions to ensure your child arrives to school on time before the tardy bell rings at 8:00am.

- 1) Pack backpacks/lunchboxes the night before.
- 2) Make sure everyone's backpacks are ready to go and prepare home lunches as much as you can. Also fill their water bottles ahead of time and store in the refrigerator.
- 3) Lay clothes out.
- 4) Set up a "last stop" area. Pick any available area near the door you typically leave through and put everything there for the day: backpacks, phones, homework, and especially coats and shoes.
- 5) If all else fails, wake up earlier and/or leave the house earlier.

Minutes of a Regular Meeting Wednesday, February 21st, 2024

A regular meeting of the Kingston Catholic School Family Organization (KCSFO) was held on Wednesday, February 21st at 6:00 pm.

Minutes: Previous minutes have been reviewed and any open items are addressed below.

Administration update:

- There were many celebrations at KCS- we celebrated Catholic Schools week, the 100th and 101st days of school, and the 8th grade Winterfest.
- National Jr. Honor Society collected 700 cans of soup for People's Place
- Student Council collected personal hygiene items for Catholic Charities
- We are hoping to go back to Forsyth Park for field day this year and have a donation to cover the cost of busing!
- UPK at KCS will most likely begin in the Fall
- At the time of our meeting we had 4 remaining snow days

Treasurer's Report/Recap:

• The current balance in our account is \$37,132.10 and a \$25,000 transfer will be made to the KCS operating account per our fundraising obligation.

Community Outreach:

• Gina Nuzzo is still looking into the Lutheran Community refrigerator but has not received much information from them yet.

Old Business:

- 1. Ole Savannah Breakfast: KCS raised \$1360 with this event, thanks to Mr. Dave Amato and the team at Ole Savannah. Thank you cards have been sent.
- 2. Lucky Squares Raffle: After payouts, \$7256 was raised and the second prize winner donated their \$250 prize back to KCS! All other winners were paid. The sweet treat celebration for students that sold all squares on their sheet will take place on Wednesday 3/20 during the school day.
- **3. Krupa Brothers Pierogi Sale:** This local company was very easy to work with, and KCS made a profit of \$420.
- **4. Crazy Bowlz Fundraising Dinner:** \$213 was raised with this fundraiser and KCS thanks the Dong family for their continued support
- **5. Ole Savannah Winter Fest:** Thank you to the Gathen Family! \$866 was raised for KCS in bartending tips!
- **6. Catholic Schools Week:** The ice cream party was a huge hit and \$2708 was raised with the Penny Challenge. Pizza will be sent to the winning classes this month.
- **7. Marco the Magician:** This event had a low turnout and didn't cover our costs. We will hold off on future events that have a minimum requirement for now.

New Business/Upcoming Events:

- 1. **Spring Auction:** May 4th at Ole Savannah. Linda will determine ticket prices and menu with Dave within the next few weeks. Cynthia has secured some great donations but help is still needed to gather more items and donations. She will hold periodic Zoom meetings for anyone available to help.
- 2. Book Fair: The Scholastic Book will be held after spring break, to coincide with our read a thon. Linda will contact Gina so they can get our initial book order in, and Eldeva will head the read-athon again. The kick-off date will be Friday 4/12.
- 3. April Guest Bartender fundraiser: Instead of a fundraising dinner for April, Farrier has set up a guest bartending night at Stella's on Monday April 8th. Snacks will be available, more information to come.
