

Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The first reading today is from one of the twelve *minor* prophets. They have smaller books in the Bible. There are four *major* prophets whose books are longer. There are also prophets like Elijah and Elisha who do not have books in the Bible, but their stories are told in the book of Kings. Zechariah is encouraging the Israelites who have returned to Babylon captivity to rebuild Jerusalem. He assures them that the Messiah will come soon and that there would be peace. In the Gospel passage today, Jesus invites all who are weary to come to him and he will help them overcome their afflictions.


