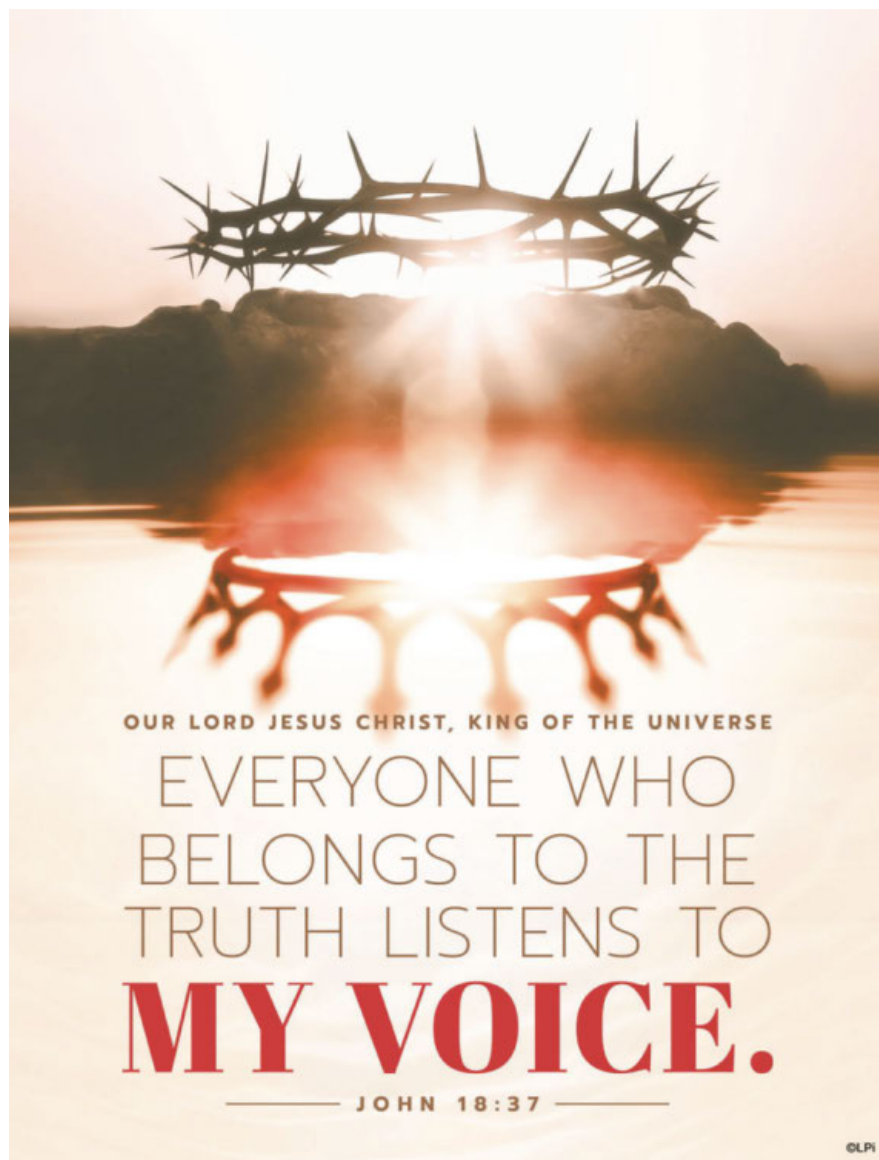

Happy Solemnity of Christ the King!

The Solemnity of Christ the King celebrates the end of the liturgical year. Parishes mark this Solemnity with special events or, like at our 11AM Mass, a Eucharistic procession. These actions help us remember that Jesus Christ is truly the King of the Universe ... the King of our lives.

The readings today speak of Jesus as a witness to the truth. He testifies to the truth, and indeed, testifying to the truth is a significant part of his mission. That mission persists in the body of Christ, that is, the Church. The Church is called to bear witness to the truth.

As Catholics, we help to build up the common good in our society by bearing witness to the reign of Christ in public life. Witnessing to truth is not only a matter of speaking. It is also a matter of listening. A way we can witness to truth is by opening ourselves up to the possibility of encountering truth through dialogue with others. A truthful person is always open to conversion. Pope Francis describes how we are to live this out in *Fratelli Tutti*, when he says "The heroes of the future will be those who can ... respectfully promote truthfulness, aside from personal interest. God willing, such heroes are quietly emerging, even now, in the midst of our society" (no. 202).

The Solemnity of Christ the King is a day for Catholics to rededicate themselves to the truth by listening to the voice of Christ, and to recognizing the reign of Christ by obeying his word. One way we might acknowledge Christ's kingship in our individual lives, then, is by examining our consciences, so that we can hear how Christ is calling us to grow in truth. Have I held back from speaking truthfully because of fear? Have I been obstinate in refusing to listen to others who are also seeking the truth in good faith? These are all questions we can ask ourselves, and can bring to the Lord, who strengthens us with his grace.

As faithful witnesses to the reign of Christ our sovereign king, we can plant seeds of renewal in our Church and in our country.

Please be sure to check the bulletin for all the important events coming up, including the Thanksgiving Day Mass and the Advent liturgies and activities. Please note that the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, usually celebrated on December 8, has been transferred to Monday, December 9. This is a holy day of obligation, so we will have holy day Masses at 9AM and 6:30PM.

¡Feliz Solemnidad de Cristo Rey!

La Solemnidad de Cristo Rey celebra el fin del año litúrgico. Las parroquias celebran esta solemnidad con eventos especiales o, como en nuestra Misa de las 11am, con una procesión eucarística. Estas acciones nos ayudan a recordar que Jesucristo es verdaderamente el Rey del Universo... el Rey de nuestras vidas.

Las lecturas de hoy hablan de Jesús como testigo de la verdad. Él da testimonio de la verdad y, de hecho, dar testimonio de la verdad es una parte importante de su misión. Esa misión persiste en el cuerpo de Cristo, es decir, la Iglesia. La Iglesia está llamada a dar testimonio de la verdad.

Como católicos, contribuimos a construir el bien común en nuestra sociedad dando testimonio del reino de Cristo en la vida pública. Dar testimonio de la verdad no es sólo cuestión de hablar. También es cuestión de escuchar. Una forma de dar testimonio de la verdad es abrirnos a la posibilidad de encontrar la verdad a través del diálogo con los demás. Una persona veraz siempre está abierta a la conversión. El Papa Francisco describe cómo vivir esto en *Fratelli Tutti* cuando dice: "Los héroes del futuro serán aquellos que sepan promover respetuosamente la veracidad, al margen de los intereses personales. Si Dios quiere, estos héroes están surgiendo silenciosamente, incluso ahora, en medio de nuestra sociedad" (n. 202).

La Solemnidad de Cristo Rey es un día para que los católicos se vuelvan a dedicar a la verdad escuchando la voz de Cristo y reconociendo el reino de Cristo obedeciendo su palabra. Una manera en que podemos reconocer el reinado de Cristo en nuestras vidas individuales, entonces, es examinando nuestras conciencias, para que podamos escuchar cómo Cristo nos está llamando a crecer en la verdad. ¿Me he abstenido de hablar con la verdad por miedo? ¿He sido obstinado en negarme a escuchar a otros que también están buscando la verdad de buena fe? Todas estas son preguntas que podemos hacernos y podemos presentar al Señor, quien nos fortalece con su gracia.

Como testigos fieles del reinado de Cristo, nuestro Rey soberano, podemos plantar semillas de renovación en nuestra Iglesia y en nuestro país.

No olvide consultar el boletín para conocer todos los eventos importantes que se avecinan, incluida la misa del Día de Acción de Gracias y las liturgias y actividades de Adviento. Tenga en cuenta que la Solemnidad de la Inmaculada Concepción, que normalmente se celebra el 8 de diciembre, se ha trasladado al lunes 9 de diciembre. Este es un día de precepto, por lo que tendremos misas de días santos a las 9 am y a las 6:30PM.
