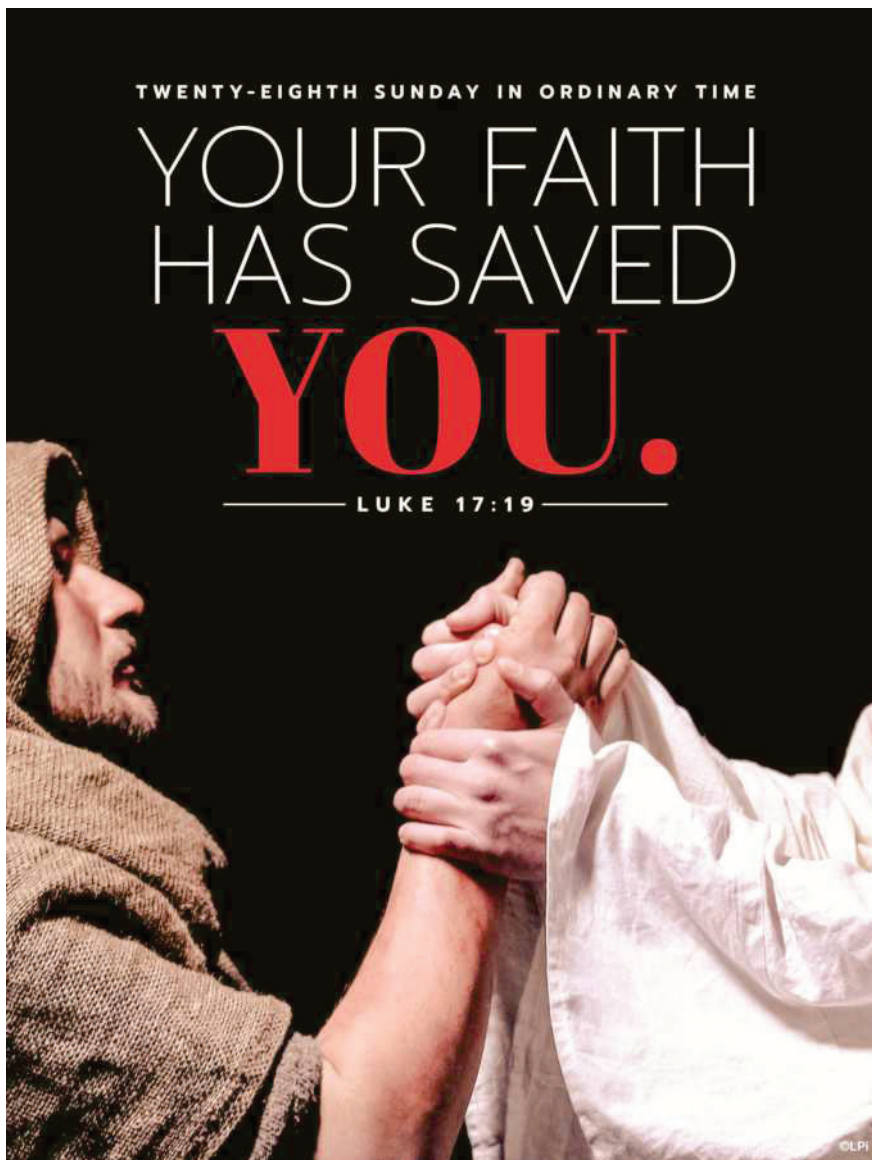

Twenty Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

October is one of my favorite months! Fall has arrived, the leaves are changing, the colors are amazing, we can wear sweaters again etc. I think many of us have the same feelings. In addition, the month is full of feast days, memorials, and special liturgical observances.



We began the month with St. Therese of Lisieux, followed by the feast of the Guardian Angels and St. Francis of Assisi. This past Tuesday, we celebrated the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary with our parish school. Each year the month of October is dedicated to the Most Holy Rosary. The rosary is appealing and simple. The purpose of the rosary is to help us meditate on the great mysteries of our salvation. Every time we pray the Our Father, we are reminded that Jesus' Father is the initiator of salvation. Praying the Hail Mary reminds us that we are joining with Mary in contemplating the mysteries of the rosary. In addition, those mysteries help to make us aware that Mary was and is still intimately joined with her son, Jesus. The constant repetition of the prayers that comprise the rosary prayer creates a time of contemplation.

During October, Pope Leo XIV invites the faithful to pray the rosary daily for peace in our world, and to be faithful instruments of reconciliation in our daily lives. "I invite everyone to pray the rosary every day during the coming month – for peace – personally, with your families and in your communities," he said. And he invited everyone to pray the rosary together on October 11 "during the vigil of the Jubilee of Marian Spirituality, also remembering the anniversary of the opening of the Second Vatican Council," which began on October 11, 1962.

Our parish family's Legion of Mary led us in a Rosary for Peace this Saturday at noon at St. Madeleine Sophie. Thank you to this combined parish ministry for their service to our communities in the way of prayer and ministry to the homebound.

Vigésimo Octavo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

¡Octubre es uno de mis meses favoritos! Llegó el otoño, las hojas están cambiando, los colores son increíbles, podemos volver a usar suéteres, etc. Creo que muchos compartimos esa sensación. Además, el mes está lleno de festividades, conmemoraciones y celebraciones litúrgicas especiales.

Comenzamos el mes con Santa Teresita de Lisieux, seguida de la fiesta de los Ángeles de la Guarda y San Francisco de Asís. El martes pasado celebramos la fiesta de Nuestra Señora del Rosario con nuestra escuela parroquial. El mes de octubre de cada año está dedicado al Santo Rosario. El Rosario es atractivo y sencillo. Su propósito es ayudarnos a meditar en los grandes misterios de nuestra salvación. Cada vez que rezamos el Padrenuestro, recordamos que el Padre de Jesús es el iniciador de la salvación. Rezar el Avemaría nos recuerda que nos unimos a María en la contemplación de los misterios del rosario. Además, nos ayudan a tomar conciencia de que María estuvo y sigue estando íntimamente unida a su hijo, Jesús. La repetición constante de la oración crea un tiempo de contemplación.

Durante octubre, el Papa León XIV invita a los fieles a rezar el Rosario diariamente por la paz en nuestro mundo y a ser fieles instrumentos de reconciliación en nuestra vida diaria. "Invito a todos a rezar el Rosario todos los días durante el próximo mes —por la paz— personalmente, en familia y en comunidad" dijo. Y los invito a rezar juntos el Rosario el 11 de octubre, durante la vigilia del Jubileo de la devoción Mariana, recordando también el aniversario de la apertura del Concilio Vaticano II, que comenzó el 11 de octubre de 1962".

Nuestra Legión de María, de la familia parroquial, nos guio en el Rosario por la Paz este sábado al mediodía en Santa Magdalena Sofía. Agradecemos a este ministerio parroquial por su servicio a nuestras comunidades mediante la oración y el ministerio con las personas confinadas en sus hogares.

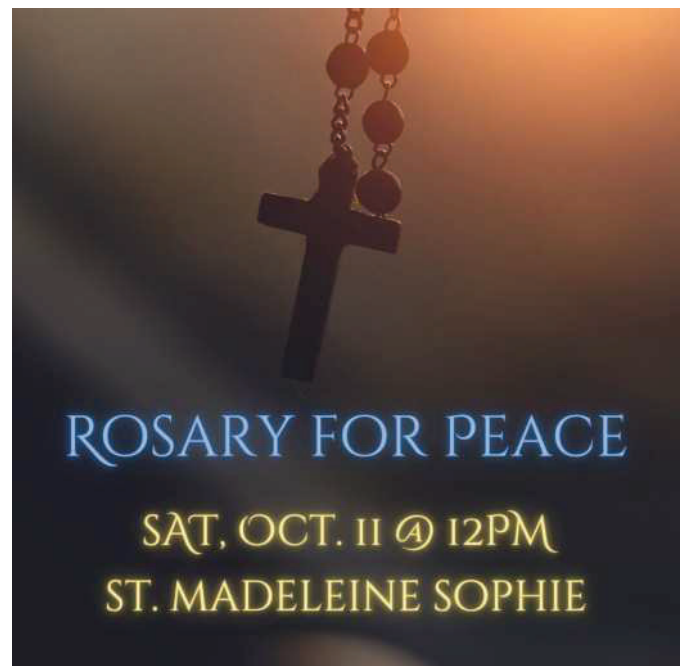

St. Louise Parish Library



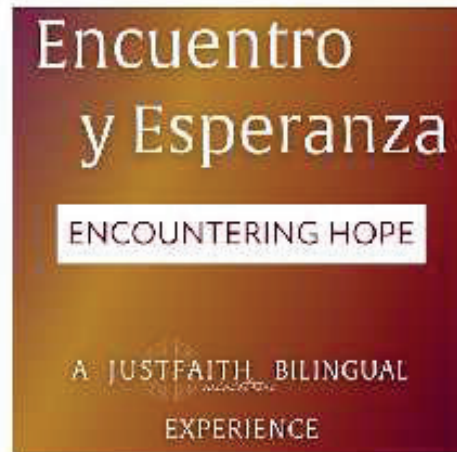
