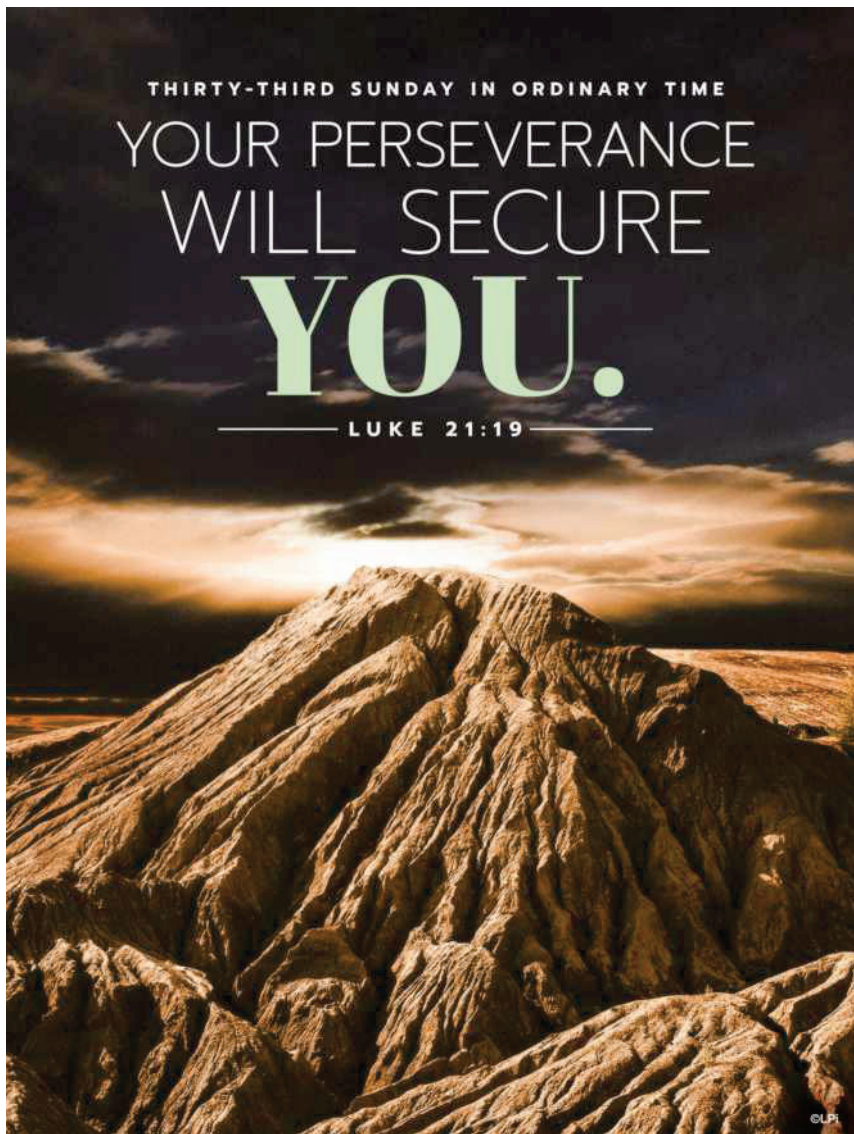

33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

At this time of year, we often participate as a community in the Rite of Entrance and the Rite of Welcome with those in the OCIA process. Please pray for the inquirers as they continue their conversion journey and for our OCIA process as we assist them in moving toward a closer relationship with God.



What is the OCIA Rite of Entrance into the Order of Catechumens? The Rite of Entrance into the Order of Catechumens is for inquirers who are preparing for their Baptism. They are now ready to publicly declare their intention to continue their journey towards becoming Catholics. At this rite, they are asked to more fully embrace the Gospel message with the help of God and are also signed with the Cross to show that they now belong to Christ. In this rite, the parish community can more fully participate in the OCIA process and pray for those at this stage of their faith journey.

The Rite of Welcome is for inquirers who have been previously baptized in another faith tradition and are ready to publicly declare their intention to continue their journey toward full communion with the Catholic Church. At this rite, they are asked if they are ready to listen to the Word of God, gather with the worshipping community in prayer, and join that community in the love and service of others. They too are signed with the Cross to show that they belong to Christ.

Why is the participation of the parish community important at the Rites of Entrance and Welcome? Members of the parish community affirm that they are ready to help and support the OCIA candidates seeking to follow Christ. The Rites of Entrance and Welcoming are celebrated at a time designated by the parish, and can be offered multiple times, depending upon when a given inquirer is ready to move forward, so sometimes you may see this at Mass, other times the rite will be offered outside of Mass. Regardless, our prayers are an important part of supporting our inquirers' faith journey.

Please be sure to check the bulletin for all the special events, activities, and liturgies coming up this month. Please note the Solemnity of Christ the King is celebrated on the weekend of November 22-23. At the 11AM bilingual celebration we will have a procession following Mass. Please see the bulletin for more information. Thanksgiving follows on Thursday, November 27. Both parishes will celebrate Mass on Thanksgiving Day at 9AM. The 9AM Mass at St. Louise will be bilingual.

Please be sure to turn in your Stewardship Pledge card, either in the collection basket at Mass or by filling out the pledge card online. If you have any questions, please contact the Parish Office.

En esta época del año, solemos participar como comunidad en el Rito de Entrada y el Rito de Bienvenida con quienes están en el Proceso de la OCIA. Les pedimos que oren por los interesados mientras continúan su camino de conversión y por nuestro proceso de la OCIA, mientras les ayudamos a profundizar su relación con Dios.

¿Qué es el Rito de Entrada a la Orden de Catecúmenos de la OCIA? El Rito de Entrada a la Orden de Catecúmenos es para quienes se preparan para el Bautismo. Ahora están listos para declarar públicamente su intención de continuar su camino hacia la fe católica. En este rito, se les invita a abrazar plenamente el mensaje del Evangelio con la ayuda de Dios y se les santigua con la cruz para mostrar su pertenencia a Cristo. En este rito, la comunidad parroquial puede participar más activamente y orar por quienes están en el proceso de la OCIA.

El Rito de Bienvenida es para quienes, habiendo sido bautizados previamente en otra tradición religiosa, desean declarar públicamente su intención de continuar su camino hacia la plena comunión con la Iglesia Católica. En este rito, se les pregunta si están dispuestos a escuchar la Palabra de Dios, unirse a la comunidad de fieles en oración y participar en el amor y el servicio a los demás. También se les estampa la cruz como símbolo de su pertenencia a Cristo.

¿Por qué es importante la participación de la comunidad parroquial en los Ritos de Entrada y Bienvenida? Los miembros de la comunidad parroquial afirman estar dispuestos a ayudar y apoyar a los candidatos de la OCIA que buscan seguir a Cristo. Los Ritos de Entrada y Bienvenida se celebran en una fecha designada por la parroquia y pueden ofrecerse varias veces, según la disposición de cada persona para dar el siguiente paso. Por lo tanto, a veces se celebran durante la Misa y otras veces fuera de ella. En cualquier caso, nuestras oraciones son una parte importante del apoyo a su camino de fe.

La Solemnidad de Cristo Rey se celebrará el fin de semana del 22 y 23 de noviembre. En la celebración bilingüe de las 11:00 am, habrá una procesión después de la misa. NEW PLACEMENT OF THE PROCESSIONAL CRUCIFIX

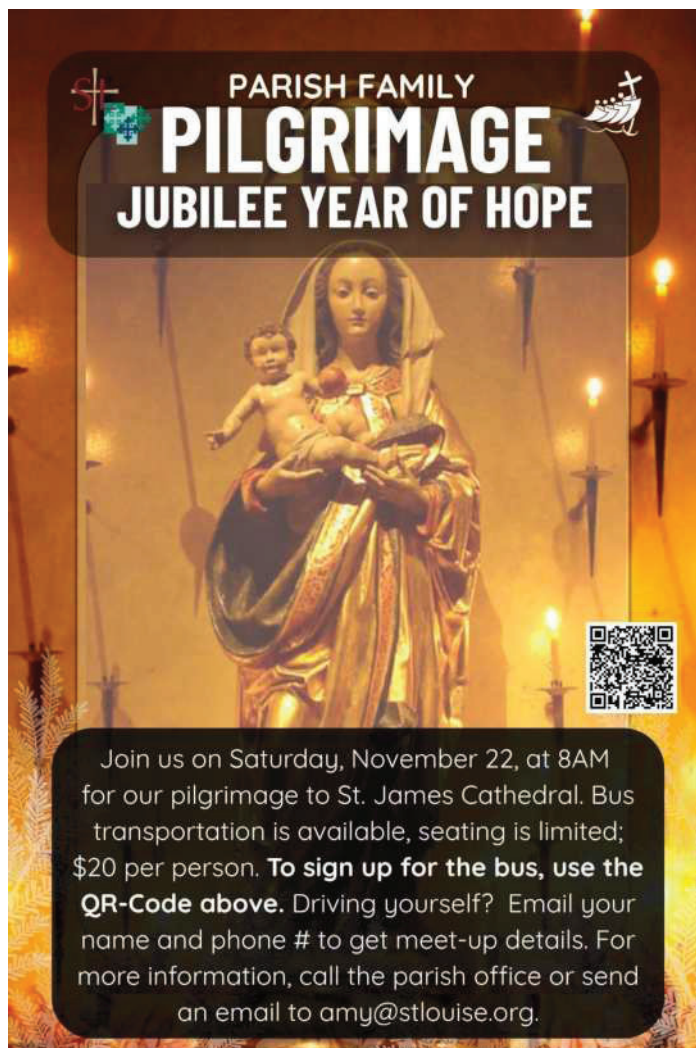
The Crucifix will be

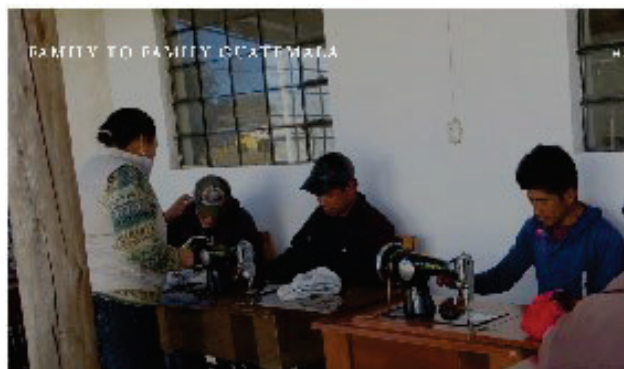
