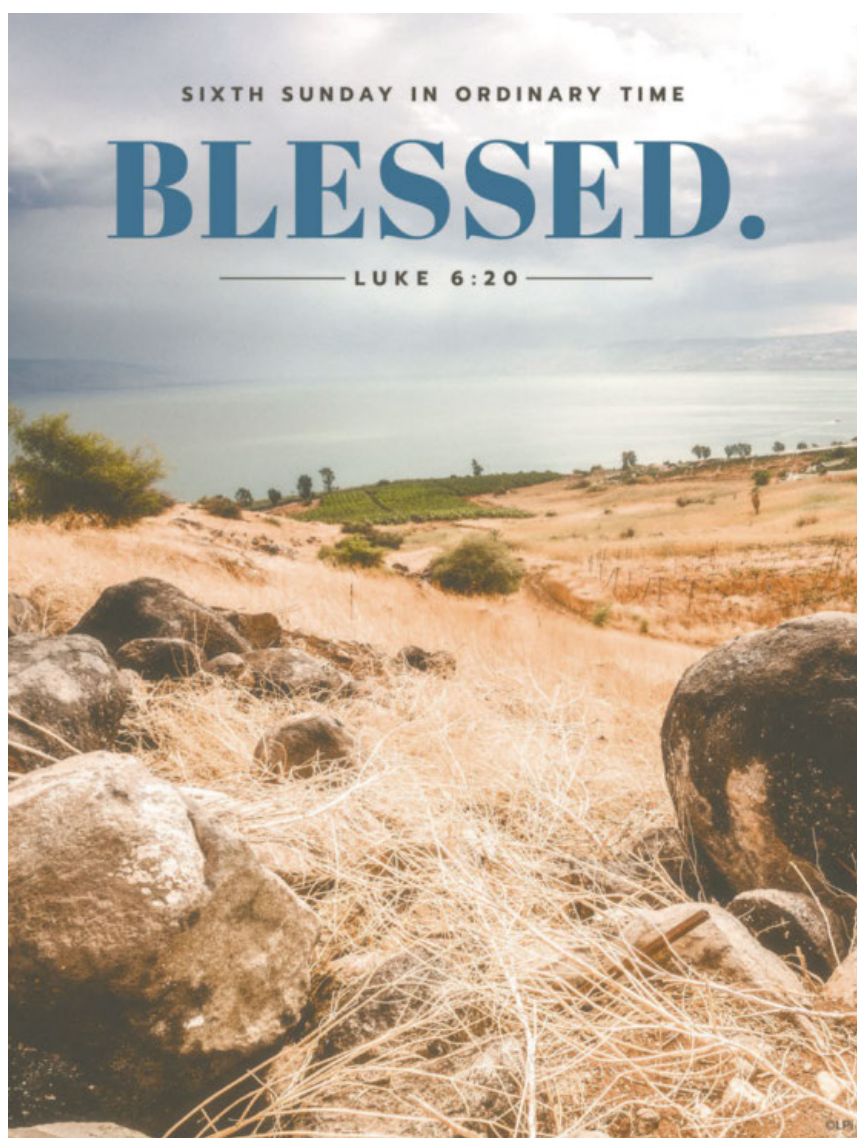

If you have read other parts of the New Testament, the Gospel from Luke today looks a lot like the Beatitudes at the beginning of the Sermon on the Mount in Matthew. The difference is that in Matthew you don't have the "blessings" contrasted with the "woes" that Luke records. Why is that?



In this Luke version, Jesus is speaking specifically to his disciples: those who are directly following him. In Matthew's version, the crowd is immense, and probably very diverse. While at this point in Jesus' ministry he had a large following, Jesus was speaking on "level ground," which detail indicates he did not need to find higher ground in order to be seen. This is important because it helps us realize that Jesus is speaking directly to us as well.

We as his disciples need to hear the full message, the good and the bad, the blessings and the woes. To truly be Jesus' disciples, we have to be prepared for the difficulties and challenges that are part of the Christian journey. This week let us find ways to accept the challenges of following Jesus and his message. Let us rejoice in the blessings and find strength through our faith to deal with the woes.

Thank you so very much to our Prepares Ministry team members in our parish family who have joined together in support of families in need. I am grateful to our speakers last weekend who helped us learn more about this important ministry. If you would like to join this ministry, please email prepares@stlouis.org for more information.

Thank you also to our amazing facility team!! The snow and the ice at both campuses present such a challenge but the team's hard work allowed everyone to be safe. Please be sure to always check your email or Flocknote texts or our websites for updates on any schedule changes due to weather.

Si ha leído otras partes del Nuevo Testamento, el Evangelio de Lucas de hoy se parece mucho a las Bienaventuranzas que aparecen al comienzo del Sermón del Monte en Mateo. La diferencia es que en Mateo no aparecen las "bendiciones" en contraste con los "ayes" que registra Lucas. ¿Por qué?

En esta versión de Lucas, Jesús habla específicamente a sus discípulos: aquellos que lo siguen directamente. En la versión de Mateo, la multitud es inmensa y probablemente muy diversa. Si bien en este punto del ministerio de Jesús tenía un gran número de seguidores, Jesús estaba hablando en "terreno llano", detalle que indica que no necesitaba encontrar un terreno más alto para ser visto. Esto es importante porque nos ayuda a darnos cuenta de que Jesús también nos está hablando directamente a nosotros.

Nosotros, como discípulos suyos, necesitamos escuchar el mensaje completo, lo bueno y lo malo, las bendiciones y las desgracias. Para ser verdaderamente discípulos de Jesús, tenemos que estar preparados para las dificultades y los desafíos que forman parte del camino cristiano. Esta semana, busquemos maneras de aceptar los desafíos de seguir a Jesús y su mensaje. Alegrémonos por las bendiciones y hallemos fuerza a través de nuestra fe para enfrentar las desgracias.

Muchas gracias a los miembros del equipo del Ministerio Prepares de nuestra familia parroquial que se han unido para apoyar a las familias necesitadas. Estoy agradecida con nuestros conferenciantes del fin de semana pasado que nos ayudaron a aprender más sobre este importante ministerio. 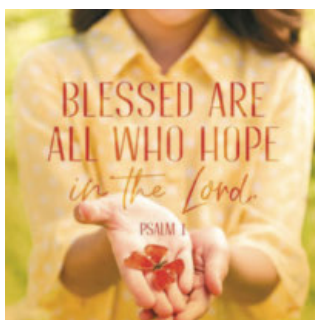

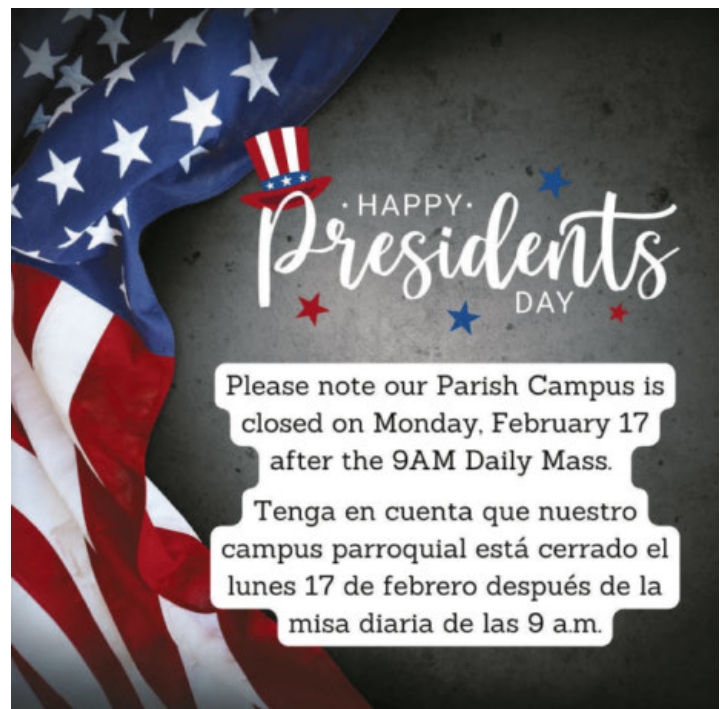

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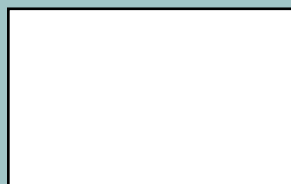
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
