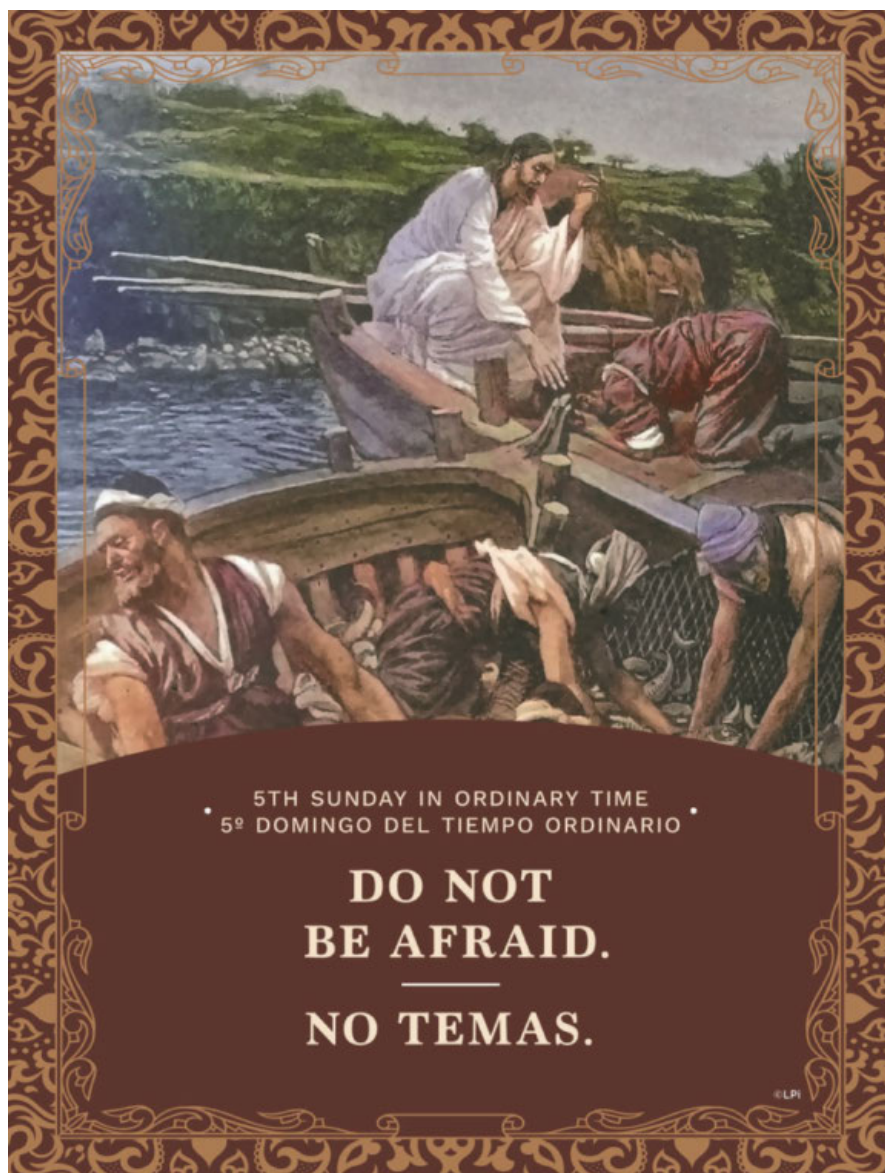

We are in Ordinary Time, but there is nothing ordinary about this time! There is much to celebrate, to recognize and to pray for in our parishes.



The Secretariat on Laity, Marriage, Family Life and Youth has selected February 9 to remember World Marriage Day. The observances of National Marriage Week (February 7-14) and World Marriage Day (Sunday, February 9) are an opportunity to focus on building a culture of life and love that begins with supporting and promoting marriage and the family. Family, as we know, does not have a single meaning. It can refer to a group of people connected by blood, marriage, adoption, or even simply a strong sense of shared love and belonging. Let us pray that all our bonds of love and friendship are strengthened through our prayer and worship together, especially in our new parish family.

It is within the context of supporting families that we will be participating in the Catholic Community Services "PREPARES: Open Your Heart" Appeal this weekend. For the past decade, PREPARES has been a parish-based ministry designed to assist parents in need during pregnancy and the first five years of their children's lives. The vision was that, over time, every parish would have a PREPARES ministry to assist vulnerable families who do not have adequate resources. This vision has become a reality. Statewide, PREPARES has grown to include 197 parishes actively supporting pregnant women and families in need with the help of 1,144 trained volunteers and family companions. In 2024 alone, the PREPARES Ministry Team provided 22,193 family encounters with families in need across the state.

We are so very blessed to have amazing volunteers who have come together to create a PREPARES ministry in our parish family of St. Louise and St. Madeleine Sophie. This new ministry coordinated an Advent collection of baby essentials. In total over 12,800 diapers and 130 packages of wipes were donated. These items will go to families in need in our local community. I know our volunteers are so very excited to be working together in this important ministry, and look forward to its growth. But none of this would be possible without the generosity of our parishioners. Please give generously to this appeal and help the needy children and families in our community.

Estamos en tiempo ordinario, pero no hay nada ordinario en este tiempo. Hay mucho que celebrar, reconocer, y por lo que orar en nuestras parroquias.

El Secretariado para los Laicos, el Matrimonio, la Vida Familiar y la Juventud ha elegido el 9 de febrero para recordar el Día Mundial del Matrimonio. Las celebraciones de la Semana Nacional del Matrimonio (del 7 al 14 de febrero) y el Día Mundial del Matrimonio (domingo 9 de febrero) son una oportunidad para centrarnos en la construcción de una cultura de vida y amor que comience con el apoyo y la promoción del matrimonio y la familia. La familia, como sabemos, no tiene un solo significado. Puede referirse a un grupo de personas conectadas por sangre, matrimonio, adopción o incluso simplemente un fuerte sentido de amor y pertenencia compartidos. Oremos para que todos nuestros lazos de amor y amistad se fortalezcan a través de nuestra oración y adoración juntos, especialmente en nuestra nueva familia parroquial.

Es en el contexto de apoyar a las familias que participaremos en la Campaña Open Your Heart " abre tu corazón" de los Servicios Comunitarios Católicos PREPARES este fin de semana. Durante la última década, PREPARES ha sido un ministerio parroquial diseñado para ayudar a los padres necesitados durante el embarazo y los primeros cinco años de vida de sus hijos. La visión era que, con el tiempo, cada parroquia tendría un ministerio PREPARES para ayudar a las familias vulnerables que no tienen los recursos adecuados. Esta visión se ha convertido en realidad. A nivel estatal, PREPARES ha crecido hasta incluir 197 parroquias que apoyan activamente a las mujeres embarazadas y a las familias necesitadas con la ayuda de 1,144 voluntarios capacitados y acompañantes familiares. Solo en 2024, el Equipo del Ministerio PREPARES brindó 22,193 encuentros familiares con familias necesitadas en todo el estado.

Somos muy afortunados de tener voluntarios increíbles que se han unido para crear un ministerio PREPARES en nuestra familia parroquial de Santa Luisa y Santa Magdalena Sofia. Este nuevo ministerio coordinó una colecta de artículos esenciales para bebés durante el Adviento. En total, se donaron más de 12,800 pañales y 130 paquetes de toallitas húmedas. Estos artículos se destinarán a familias necesitadas de nuestra comunidad local. Sé que nuestros voluntarios están muy emocionados de trabajar juntos en este importante ministerio y esperan con ansias su crecimiento. Pero nada de esto sería posible sin la generosidad de nuestros feligreses. Por favor, done generosamente a esta campaña y ayude a los niños y familias necesitadas de nuestra comunidad.

Caring for the vulnerable, needy and marginalized is part of Catholic social teaching. It is woven into the fabric of how we live out the values of the Gospel. In recent weeks the plight and challenges of those in our communities who face immigration issues have been intensified. Please know that our two parishes are doing everything we can to support our immigrant and refugee brothers and sisters. There are resources available in the narthex of each of our two churches, on our two websites, and in our Parish Offices. Our parish staff and school principals have been briefed on how to deal with situations that may arise regarding law enforcement. Our goal is to keep the fear to a minimum but be aware of appropriate actions and ways we can offer support. As the bishops of our state noted in their recent letter, "May all our brothers and sisters on the margins, especially migrants, refugees and asylum seekers, know that our parishes are open for prayer, comfort and solace. May each of us embrace the Gospel teaching and Pope Francis' call to recognize the dignity of others as we welcome the stranger. As pilgrims of hope entering into a Jubilee year, we journey together through these uncertain times knowing Our Lady of Guadalupe walks with us." 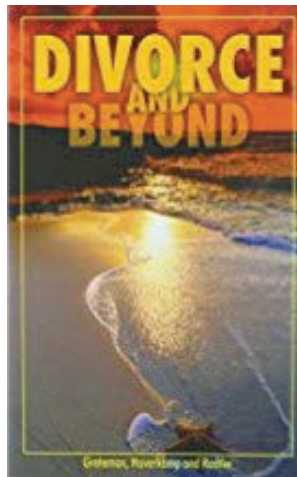

Cuidar a los vulnerables, necesitados y marginados es parte de la enseñanza social católica. Está entrelazado en la forma en que vivimos los valores del Evangelio. En las últimas semanas, la difícil situación y los desafíos de quienes en nuestras comunidades tienen problemas de inmigración se han intensificado. Sepa que nuestras dos parroquias están haciendo todo lo posible para apoyar a nuestros hermanos y hermanas inmigrantes y refugiados. Hay recursos disponibles en el nártex de las iglesias, en nuestros sitios web y en las oficinas de nuestras parroquias. Nuestro personal parroquial y los directores de las escuelas han sido informados sobre cómo lidiar con situaciones que puedan surgir con respecto a la aplicación de la ley. Nuestro objetivo es mantener el miedo al mínimo, pero estar conscientes de las acciones apropiadas y las formas en que podemos ofrecer apoyo. Como señalaron los obispos de nuestro estado en su reciente carta: "Que todos nuestros hermanos y hermanas en los márgenes, especialmente los migrantes, refugiados y solicitantes de asilo, sepan que nuestras parroquias están abiertas para la oración, el consuelo y el solaz. Que cada uno de nosotros abrace la enseñanza del Evangelio y el llamado del Papa Francisco a reconocer la dignidad de los demás al dar la bienvenida al extranjero. Como peregrinos de esperanza que entran en un año jubilar, caminamos juntos a través de estos tiempos inciertos sabiendo que Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe camina con nosotros". 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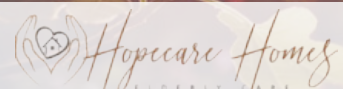
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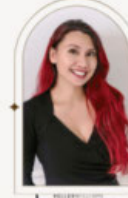
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
