THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT Scrutinies

The "Scrutinies of the Elect" take place on the 3rd, 4th and 5th Sundays of Lent. Scrutiny is a word that means "to search," to look for. In modern English it is used to mean "a critical observation or examination." During the Scrutinies, the Elect are expected to take an intense look at their lives. During the First Scrutiny (Third Sunday of Lent), the Elect will have hands laid upon them, in prayer that they may reject everything in their lives that is contrary to Christ.

We, as their faith community, are not there just to observe. This is a great opportunity for all of us to take a deep look into our own lives. The prayers of the Elect should become everyone's prayers. The purifying of the Elect should become the purifying of the whole community. Please continue to keep our Elect in prayer during this Lenten Season as we all journey together toward Easter!

Over the next three weekends we will hear Gospel passages from John. This weekend the Gospel reading tells the story of Jesus and the Woman at the Well. The Woman at the Well (Jn 4:5-42) is a story about opening ourselves to the mercy of the Lord, of hearing his message, and of being called to evangelize spirit and truth. The Samaritan woman is gently drawn into a conversation by Jesus. The longer she talks with him, the more her understanding grows, until she sees the full truth: Jesus is the Messiah. The Samaritan woman is the first person to whom Jesus openly reveals himself as the Messiah. Throughout this conversation she demonstrates a posture of discipleship, learning from Jesus, and answering his call to evangelize. She leaves her water jar behind – just as the disciples left their fishing nets – a sign of her complete embrace of this calling to follow Jesus. She returns to her town and there shares her own experience with Jesus, inviting the villagers to come and see if they reach the same conclusion about him.

This woman whose name we do not know is a wonderful model for all of us on our own journeys of faith. Her actions invite us to stay connected to Jesus and to ask questions about our faith in order to come to a fuller understanding of it.

But because our growth in faith is not only for our own benefit, the Samaritan woman takes her new learning and is propelled into action. She reaches out to her community and invites them to join her on the journey. Whether we feel called to evangelize as she does or called to use our gifts in other ways, her story reminds us that each of our callings presents opportunities to turn personal growth in faith into action for the sake of others.

TERCER DOMINGO DE CUARESMA Escrutinios

Los "Escrutinios de los Elegidos" tienen lugar durante el 3º, 4º y 5º Domingo de Cuaresma. Escrutinio significa "indagar". En inglés moderno, significa "observación o examen crítico". Durante los Escrutinios, se espera que los Elegidos examinen profundamente sus vidas. Durante el Primer Escrutinio (tercer domingo de Cuaresma), se les impondrán las manos en oración para que rechacen todo lo que sea contrario a Cristo en sus vidas.

Nosotros, como su comunidad de fe, no estamos allí solo para observar. Esta es una gran oportunidad para que todos reflexionemos profundamente sobre nuestras propias vidas. Las oraciones de los Elegidos deben convertirse en las oraciones de todos. La purificación de los Elegidos debe convertirse en la purificación de toda la comunidad. ¡Por favor, sigan orando por nuestros Elegidos durante esta Cuaresma mientras caminamos juntos hacia la Pascua!

Durante los próximos tres fines de semana escucharemos las lecturas del Evangelio de Juan. Este fin de semana, la lectura del Evangelio narra la historia de Jesús y la mujer junto al pozo. La mujer junto al pozo (Juan 4,5-42) narra la historia de abrirnos a la misericordia del Señor, de escuchar su mensaje y de ser llamados a evangelizar en espíritu y verdad. La samaritana se deja llevar suavemente por la conversación de Jesús. Cuanto más conversa con él, más crece su comprensión hasta que ve la verdad completa: Jesús es el Mesías. La samaritana es la primera persona a quien Jesús se revela abiertamente como el Mesías. A lo largo de esta conversación, demuestra una actitud de discipulado, aprendiendo de Jesús y respondiendo a su llamado a evangelizar. Deja su cántaro, tal como los discípulos dejaron sus redes de pesca, señal de su completa aceptación de este llamado a seguir a Jesús. Regresa a su pueblo y comparte su propia experiencia con Jesús, invitando a los aldeanos a acercarse para ver si llegan a la misma conclusión sobre él.

Esta mujer, cuyo nombre desconocemos, es un modelo maravilloso para todos nosotros en nuestro camino de fe. Sus acciones nos invitan a conectar con Jesús y a cuestionarnos sobre nuestra fe para comprenderla mejor.

Pero como nuestro crecimiento en la fe no es solo para nuestro propio beneficio, la mujer samaritana toma su nuevo aprendizaje y se ve impulsada a la acción. Se acerca a su comunidad y la invita a unirse a ella en el camino. Ya sea que nos sintamos llamados a evangelizar como ella o a usar nuestros dones de otras maneras, su historia nos recuerda que nuestros llamados son oportunidades para convertir el crecimiento personal en la fe en acción por el bien de los demás.

The season of Lent involves a more intense period of examination and preparation for the Elect (those preparing to be baptized at the Easter Vigil), and hopefully for those of us already living the Catholic faith. Though they are meant for the OCIA Elect, the Scrutinies can help all Catholics seeking to live a life of continuous conversion.

The purpose of the Scrutinies is “to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful” in the hearts of the Elect and to “strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good.”

Remember that at the beginning of this Gospel the disciples had left Jesus at the well so they could go and find food. When the disciples return from their trip to buy food, their concern is a practical one: "We have food, Rabbi, eat!" We don't want to criticize them for that. Food is important! When Jesus answers, "I have food to eat that you know nothing about," they wonder who brought him food.

It is interesting how completely they miss the point; it doesn't seem to occur to them that their master, who spends half of his time talking in parables, might not be speaking literally this time. And like the disciples, sometimes we need to look more closely at what Jesus is trying to teach us ... he is calling us to a deep conversion of heart, especially in Lent.

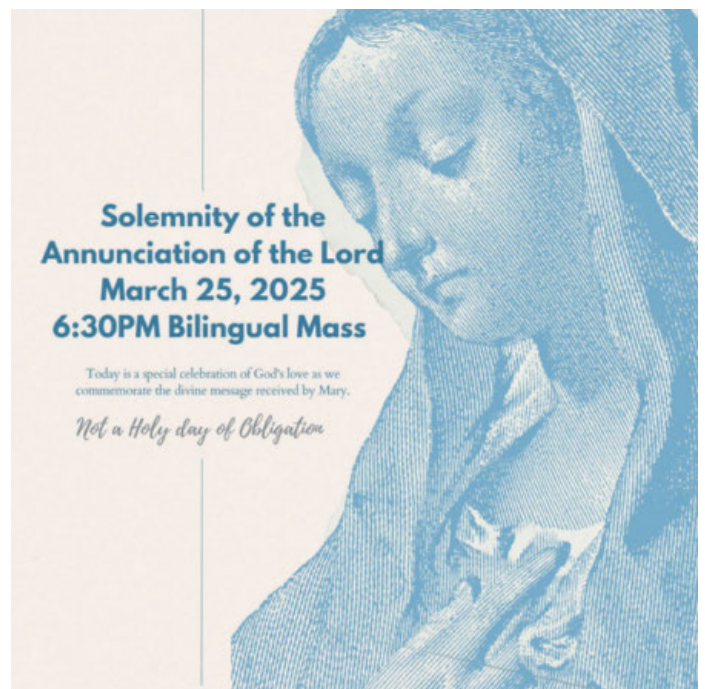

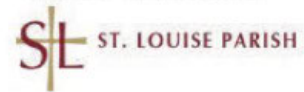

Cuando Jesús responde: «Tengo comida que comer, de la que no saben nada», se preguntan quién le trajo la comida.

Es curioso cómo pasan por alto por completo el punto; no parecen darse cuenta de que su maestro, que pasa la mitad del tiempo hablando en parábolas, podría no estar hablando literalmente. Y al igual que los discípulos, a veces necesitamos analizar con más atención lo que Jesús intenta enseñarnos... Nos llama a una profunda conversión del corazón, especialmente en Cuaresma.

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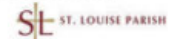
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
