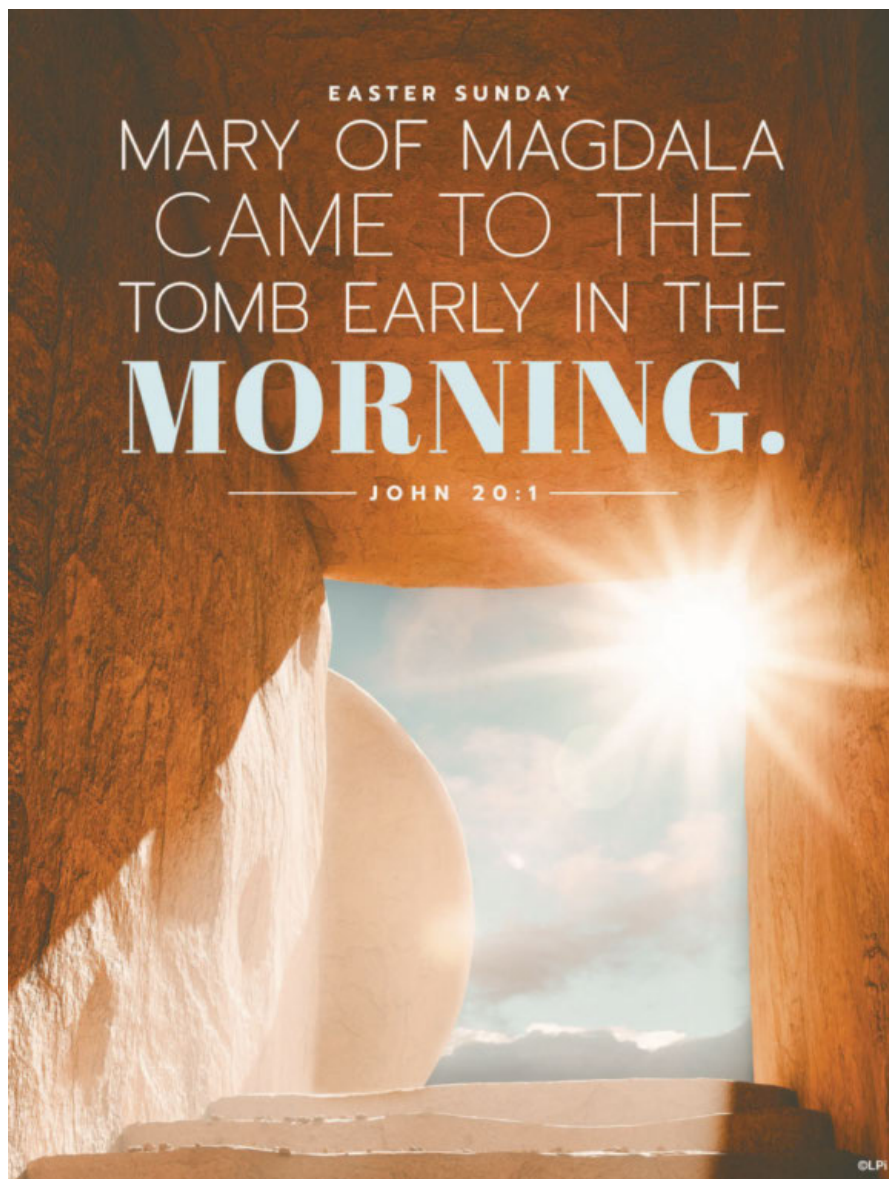

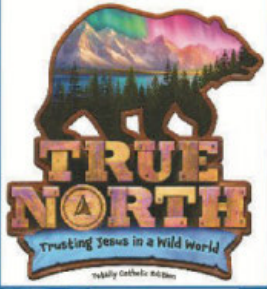

Frank Rouleau, of Outreach to Haiti, meeting with the students for Pizza lunch, Taco Thursday lunch, and School Assembly, and concelebrating Masses with Fr. Tom and Fr. Gary during the week. We also held a panel discussion at St. Madeleine Sophie, with Fr. Frank, Fr. Gary, and Fr. Tom serving as our panelists, to educate and inform our Parish Family parishioners about Outreach to Haiti and our sister Parish, Ste-Anne de Hyacinth. The culminating event of our week was the Fundraising Dinner.

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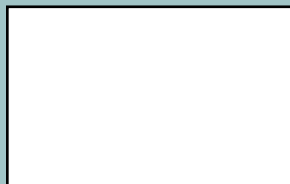
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
