FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

Thank you so very much to Fr. Frank Rouleau, Fr. Gary and Fr. Tom, and the Standing with Haiti Committee, for continuing the tradition of supporting St. Anne de Hyacinthe parish and school in Haiti. The panel discussion at



St. Madeleine Sophie was so very informative, and I know that the people in attendance were touched by the good work that has been done by the parishioners at St. Louise and St. Anthony. St. Madeleine Sophie is happy to join in these efforts and we all look forward to a long and sustained relationship in support of St. Anne.

The Elect continue their faith journey with the second Scrutiny this weekend. The Scrutinies are meant to uncover and then heal what is weak within us. They are meant to strengthen all that is good and to provide protection against the temptations that separate us from God.

In the Cycle A Gospel reading from John, we hear about the man born blind. We can be blind ourselves to our own sins and to the needs of others. But Jesus can take away our blindness if we only have faith in him and follow his ways. Jesus is the light of the world and can break through our blindness.

In John's Gospel he never refers to Jesus' miracles as "miracles"; he always refers to them as "signs," because there is so much more that they signify. Beyond the appearance of what happens on the surface, they signify that something more spiritual is happening in the lives of the people in the stories, and in our lives. Scripture scholars suggest that this Gospel reading signifies how the early Christian community tried to recall what we all need to go through in our baptismal commitment to Christ. We use this Gospel as a catechetical teaching in preparation for the Easter Vigil, when catechumens enter into the baptismal waters with the prayer that they will receive the true enlightenment of faith.

Please be sure to note all the events and activities happening this week and over the rest of the Lenten season. Please join us.

En el ciclo A del Evangelio de Juan, escuchamos sobre el hombre ciego de nacimiento. Podemos ser ciegos a nuestros propios pecados y a las necesidades de los demás. Pero Jesús puede quitarnos la ceguera si tan solo tenemos fe en él y seguimos sus caminos. Jesús es la luz del mundo y puede vencer nuestra ceguera.

En el Evangelio de Juan, nunca se refiere a los milagros de Jesús como milagros; siempre los llama señales, porque significan mucho más. Más allá de la apariencia superficial, significan que algo más espiritual está sucediendo en nuestras vidas. Los eruditos de las Sagradas Escrituras sugieren que esta lectura del Evangelio refleja cómo la comunidad cristiana primitiva intentó recordarnos lo que todos necesitamos experimentar en nuestro compromiso bautismal con Cristo. Usamos este Evangelio como enseñanza catequética en preparación para la Vigilia Pascual, donde los catecúmenos entran en las aguas bautismales con la oración de recibir la verdadera iluminación de la fe.

Por favor, estén atentos a todos los eventos y actividades de esta semana y del resto de la Cuaresma. ¡Acompañemos!
