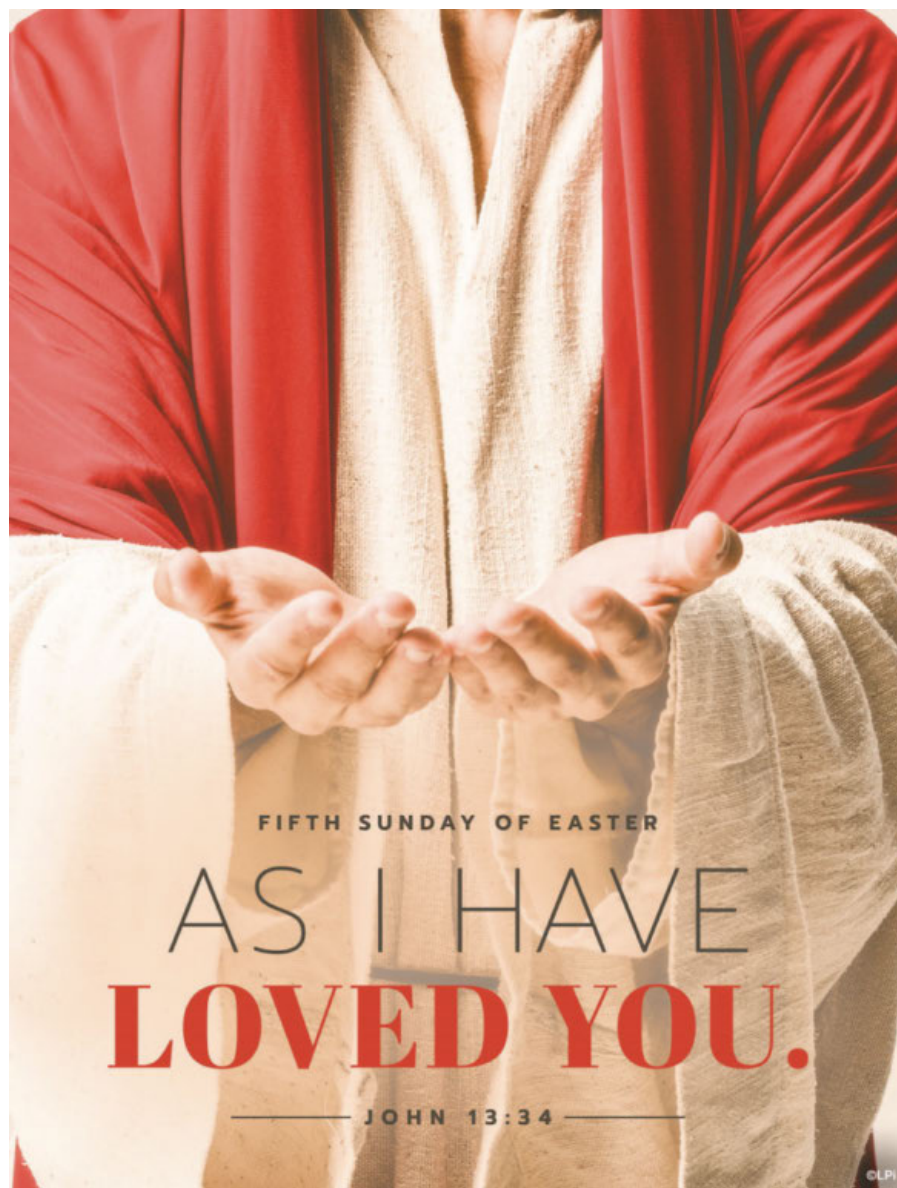

It has now been over a week since we learned of the election of Pope Leo XIV. It was certainly an unexpected and stunning surprise to learn that Cardinal Robert Prevost, born in the United States, had been elected by the College of Cardinals to be the 267th Pope.



We will learn much more about Pope Leo and how he will shape the Church during his pontificate. The Vatican revealed Saturday that Pope Leo would retain the motto and coat of arms that he had as bishop of Chiclayo, Peru. The motto, "In Illo uno unum," was pronounced by St. Augustine in a sermon to explain that "although we Christians are many, in the one Christ we are one."

In today's Gospel reading from John, we hear Jesus say: "I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, you also should love one another. This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." Pope Leo's *Urbi et Orbi* blessing calls all of us to join him in following Jesus' message of trusting that God loves us always and that when we are to love and care for each other.

"All of us are in God's hands. So, let us move forward, without fear, together, hand in hand with God and with one another! We are followers of Christ. Christ goes before us. The world needs his light. Humanity needs him as the bridge that can lead us to God and his love. Help us, one and all, to build bridges through dialogue and encounter, joining together as one people, always at peace."
Pope Leo XIV

We are now entering Phase 2 of Partners in the Gospel. Phase 1 was all about getting to know each other in terms of our two parishes. Phase 2 will be about collecting feedback, but more importantly listening to each other on some key questions. The first questions we will be asking are: Who are we? What are our charisms as a parish? This past Thursday, we held the annual Parish Leadership gathering of Parish Council and Commission members and chairs of the respective committees.

Those in attendance participated in the first listening session, designed to allow conversation around these questions. The next step is to schedule opportunities for parishioners at large to participate in responding to these questions. We will offer in-person listening sessions as well as online surveys. Thank you to everyone who participated and who will help us navigate these next steps. There will be more information in the coming days about how all can participate.

Our Annual Catholic Appeal campaign continues this weekend. The theme this year is "Together in faith." The ACA helps us support our mission to encounter Christ and live out the joy of the Gospel through the various Archdiocesan regional ministries. Ha pasado más de una semana desde que nos enteramos de la elección del Papa León XIV. Sin duda, fue una sorpresa inesperada y sorprendente saber que el Cardenal Robert Prevost, nacido en Estados Unidos, había sido seleccionado por el Colegio Cardenalicio para ser el Papa número 267.

Aprenderemos mucho más sobre el Papa León y cómo moldeará la Iglesia durante su Pontificado. El Vaticano reveló el sábado que el Papa León conservaría el lema y el escudo de armas que tenía como obispo de Chiclayo, Perú. El lema, "In Illo uno unum", fue pronunciado por San Agustín en un sermón para explicar que "aunque los cristianos somos muchos, en un solo Cristo somos uno".

En el Evangelio de hoy, según san Juan, escuchamos a Jesús decir: "Les doy un mandamiento nuevo: que se amen los unos a los otros. Como yo los he amado, también ustedes deben amarse los unos a los otros. En esto todos conocerán que son mis discípulos, si se aman los unos a los otros". La bendición *Urbi et Orbi* del Papa León nos llama a todos a unimos a él en el seguimiento del mensaje de Jesús: confiar en que Dios siempre nos ama y que, cuando debemos amarnos y cuidarnos unos a otros, Todos estamos en las manos de Dios. Así que, avancemos sin miedo, juntos, de la mano de Dios y unos con otros. Somos seguidores de Cristo. Cristo va delante de nosotros. El mundo necesita su luz. La humanidad lo necesita como el puente que nos lleva a Dios y a su amor. Ayúdenos, a todos, a construir puentes a través del diálogo y el encuentro, uniéndonos como un solo pueblo, siempre en paz.

Ahora estamos entrando en la Fase 2 de compañeros en el Evangelio. La Fase 1 se centró en conocernos mutuamente en términos de nuestras dos parroquias. La Fase 2 se centrará en recopilar comentarios, pero más importante aún, en escucharnos mutuamente sobre algunas preguntas clave. Las primeras preguntas que nos haremos son: ¿Quiénes somos? ¿Cuáles son nuestros carismas como parroquia? El jueves pasado, celebramos la reunión anual de Liderazgo Parroquial con los miembros del consejo parroquial y de las comisiones, y los presidentes de las respectivas Comités.

Los asistentes participaron en la primera sesión de escucha, diseñada para facilitar el diálogo sobre estas preguntas. El siguiente paso es programar oportunidades para que los feligreses en general participen respondiendo a estas preguntas. Ofreceremos sesiones de escucha presenciales, así como encuestas en línea. Gracias a todos los que participaron y a quienes nos ayudarán a guiar estos próximos pasos. En los próximos días habrá más información sobre cómo participar.

Nuestra Campaña Católica Anual continúa este fin de semana. El tema de este año es "Juntos en la fe". La Campaña Anual Católica nos ayuda a apoyar nuestra misión de encontrar a Cristo y vivir la alegría del Evangelio a través de los diversos ministerios regionales de la Arquidiócesis.

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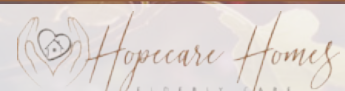
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
