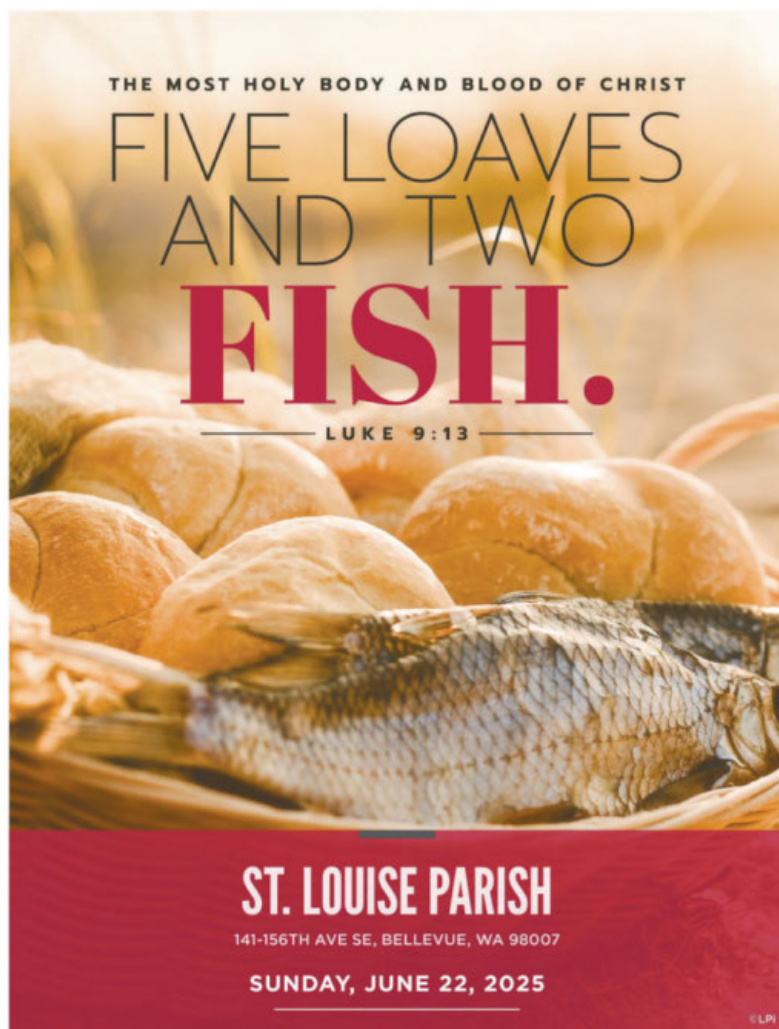

Solemnity of Corpus Christi

This Corpus Christi weekend, we are again celebrating Masses together as one parish family due to the floor renovations in the church this past week. We will also be celebrating Word and Communion Services June 23-26 and Mass on Friday, June 27, at St. Madeleine Sophie due to the resealing of the St. Louise parking lot.

The primary purpose of the Solemnity of Corpus Christi is to focus our attention on the Holy Eucharist, the source and summit of the Catholic faith. At every Mass, we have the privilege of focusing our attention on this mystery – so why would the Church have one day dedicated to this? The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) reminds us that when Jesus says “And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age,” he is referring to the Eucharist! Jesus confirmed his actual presence in the Holy Eucharist until the end of time.

We are also reminded that the Church is the Body of Christ, formed and sustained by Jesus's living presence. The Church is the continuation of Christ's life in the world – his presence made visible, tangible, and active through Word, Sacrament, and community.

As I mentioned at the 11AM Mass on Pentecost at St. Louise, we are now embarking on Phase 2 of Partners in the Gospel.

St. Louise de Marillac once said, *“I must have great trust in God however difficult it may appear to be, and listen to the promptings of the Holy Spirit.”* We will all need to listen to the Holy Spirit as he guides us forward, but this is also a time of action. This action will take the form of feedback sessions that we will hold on several dates in the coming weeks and months. These listening sessions will provide several opportunities for parishioners to discuss the gifts and charisms of each of our parishes, the challenges that face our parish family, and who we want to become as a future parish.

The input from the feedback sessions will be used by the Parish Family Advisory Council to create a One Parish Plan to be submitted to the Archbishop in 2027. More information about these listening sessions will be in upcoming bulletins and on our respective parish websites.

It is up to us, all of us, to shape our future as a new faith community. We are called by virtue of our baptism to be active participants in our faith. This is an historic time in our archdiocese, in our parish, and in our lives as members of the Catholic Church.

May we take to heart what our new Pope Leo has said. “Let us build a church founded on God's love, a sign of unity, a missionary church that opens its arms to the world, proclaims the word, allows itself to be made restless by history, and becomes a leaven of harmony for humanity.” There is no doubt our parish family will chart a course firmly rooted in our faith in God and in each other. That is who we are. I know we are up to this challenge.

Solemnidad del Corpus Christi

Este fin de semana de Corpus Christi, celebramos las misas como familia parroquial debido a las renovaciones del piso de la iglesia la semana pasada. También celebraremos la Liturgia de la Palabra y Comunión del 23 al 26 de junio, y la Misa del viernes 27 de junio en Santa Magdalena Sofía debido a la renovación del estacionamiento.

El propósito principal de la Solemnidad del Corpus Christi es centrar nuestra atención en la Sagrada Eucaristía, fuente y cumbre de la fe católica. En cada misa, tenemos el privilegio de centrar nuestra atención en este misterio, así que ¿por qué la Iglesia dedicaría un día a esto? La Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo (Corpus Christi) nos recuerda que cuando Jesús dice: «Y es aquí donde yo estaré con ustedes todos los días, hasta el fin del mundo», ¡se refiere a la Eucaristía! Jesús confirmó su presencia real en la Sagrada Eucaristía hasta el fin de los tiempos.

También se nos recuerda que la Iglesia es el Cuerpo de Cristo, formado y sostenido por la presencia viva de Jesús. La Iglesia es la continuación de la vida de Cristo en el mundo: su presencia se hace visible, tangible y activa mediante la Palabra, el Sacramento y la comunidad.

Como mencioné en la Misa de las 11 am en Pentecostés en Santa Luisa, ahora nos estamos embarcando en la Fase 2 de compañeros en el Evangelio.

Santa Luisa dijo una vez: *« Debo tener una gran confianza en Dios, por difícil que parezca , y escuchar las inspiraciones del Espíritu Santo»*. Todos necesitaremos escuchar al Espíritu Santo mientras nos guía hacia adelante, pero este también es un momento de acción. Esta acción se concretará en sesiones de escucha que tendremos en varias fechas durante las próximas semanas y meses. Estas sesiones de escucha brindarán varias oportunidades para conversar sobre los dones y carismas de cada una de nuestras parroquias, los desafíos que enfrenta nuestra familia parroquial y en quiénes queremos convertirnos como futura parroquia.

Los aportes de las sesiones de escucha serán utilizados por el Consejo Asesor de la Familia Parroquial para crear un Plan Parroquial único que se presentará al Arzobispo en 2027. Habrá más información sobre estas sesiones de escucha en los próximos boletines y en el sitio web de nuestra respectiva parroquia .

Nos corresponde a todos forjar nuestro futuro como nueva comunidad de fe. En virtud de nuestro bautismo, estamos llamados a ser participantes activos de nuestra fe. Este es un momento histórico en nuestra arquidiócesis, en nuestra parroquia, y en nuestra vida como miembros de la Iglesia Católica.

Que tomemos en serio lo que dijo nuestro nuevo Papa León XIV: «Construyamos una Iglesia fundada en el amor de Dios, signo de unidad, una Iglesia misionera que abra sus brazos al mundo, proclame la palabra, se deje inquietar por la historia y se convierta en fermento de armonía para la humanidad». Sin duda, nuestra familia parroquial trazará un rumbo firmemente arraigado en nuestra fe en Dios y en los demás. Eso es lo que somos. Sé que estamos a la altura de este desafío.

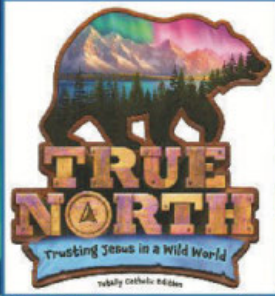

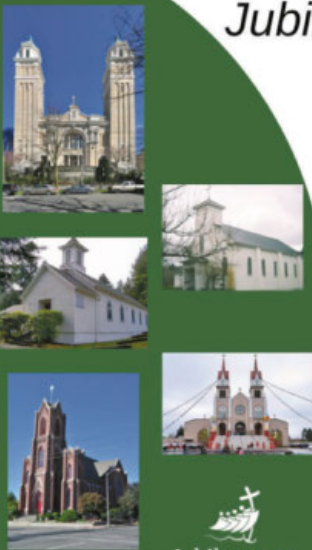

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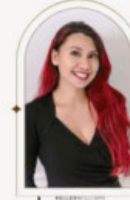
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
