Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Recently, Archbishop Etienne, Cardinals Cupich and McElroy, Archbishop Wester and others traveled to Japan on a Pilgrimage of Peace to commemorate the 80th anniversary of the atomic bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki. Organized under the theme of the Catholic Church's Jubilee Year, "Pilgrims of Hope," this marked the third pilgrimage for Archbishop Wester and the second for Archbishop Etienne, reaffirming their deep commitment to peace, reconciliation, and nuclear disarmament. Archbishop Etienne has written about his trip to Japan and about the efforts to promote peace in his blog *Truth in Love*. I want to note here some of what he wrote: "As we commemorate the 80th anniversary of the atomic bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki, our world still yearns for peace. Clearly, world leaders and diplomats are key agents of change, and we must pray for them daily. But when we ask ourselves what one person can do to advance peace amid such enormous global challenges, it can seem overwhelming. Pope Leo recently offered encouragement in an address to a group of Italian bishops: *The relationship with Christ calls on us to develop a pastoral focus on the theme of peace. Indeed, the Lord sends us into the world to bring his same gift: 'Peace be with you!,' and to become its creators in everyday life. I am thinking of parishes, neighborhoods and families.* (Pope Leo to Italian bishops June 17, 2025)

Archbishop Etienne concludes his article with "Peace is not a distant dream. It is a daily decision that requires practical actions. And it begins with you and me." In today's Gospel we hear Jesus speak of peace, but in a very shocking way. Jesus speaks of bringing division, not peace, because his message and the truth he embodies will inevitably cause conflict and separation, especially within families, as people choose sides based on their response to his teachings. This division isn't his primary goal, but a consequence of his message challenging the status quo and demanding a choice between his way and the world's ways. The "peace" Jesus refers to is not a superficial harmony or absence of conflict. Instead, he offers a deeper, transformative peace that comes from aligning with God's will. It is important to reflect on Archbishop Etienne's reminder that peace is a daily decision. Our accepting God's will is a daily decision. Our offering of love and forgiveness is a daily decision. This week, let us find ways to make the choice to offer peace, love, and forgiveness to those in our families and communities. To read Archbishop Etienne's blog please visit our St. Louise website. Vigésimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Recientemente, el arzobispo Etienne, los cardenales Cupich, McElroy, el arzobispo Wester y otros viajaron a Japón en una peregrinación por la paz para conmemorar el 80.º aniversario de los bombardeos atómicos de Hiroshima y Nagasaki. Organizada bajo el lema del Año Jubilar de la Iglesia Católica, "Peregrinos de la Esperanza", esta marcó la tercera peregrinación para el arzobispo Wester y la segunda para el arzobispo Etienne, reafirmando su profundo compromiso con la paz, la reconciliación y el desarme nuclear. El arzobispo Etienne ha escrito sobre su viaje a Japón y sobre los esfuerzos para promover la paz en su blog *Truth in Love*. Quiero mencionar aquí algunos de sus escritos: "Al conmemorar el 80.º aniversario de los bombardeos atómicos de Hiroshima y Nagasaki, nuestro mundo aún anhela la paz. Claramente, los líderes mundiales y los diplomáticos son agentes clave del cambio, y debemos orar por ellos a diario. Pero cuando nos preguntamos qué puede hacer una sola persona para promover la paz en medio de desafíos globales tan enormes, puede resultar abrumador. El Papa León XIV ofreció recientemente un mensaje de aliento en un discurso a un grupo de obispos italianos: *"La relación con Cristo nos llama a desarrollar un enfoque pastoral en el tema de la paz. De hecho, el Señor nos envía al mundo para llevar su mismo don: '¡La paz sea con ustedes!'*", y para convertirnos en sus creadores en la vida cotidiana. Pienso en las parroquias, las comunidades y las familias". (Papa León XIV a los obispos italianos, 17 de junio de 2025)

El arzobispo Etienne concluye su artículo con la siguiente frase: "La paz no es un sueño lejano. Es una decisión diaria que requiere acciones prácticas. Y comienza contigo y conmigo". En el Evangelio de hoy, escuchamos a Jesús hablar de paz, pero de una manera muy impactante. Jesús habla de traer división, no paz, porque su mensaje y la verdad que encarna inevitablemente causarán conflicto y separación, especialmente en las familias, ya que las personas eligen bando según su respuesta a sus enseñanzas. Esta división no es su objetivo principal, sino una consecuencia de su mensaje, que desafía el statu quo y exige una elección entre su camino y el del mundo. La "paz" a la que se refiere Jesús no es una armonía superficial ni la ausencia de conflicto. En cambio, ofrece una paz más profunda y transformadora que surge de la alineación con la voluntad de Dios. Es importante reflexionar sobre el recordatorio del arzobispo Etienne de que la paz es una decisión diaria. Aceptar la voluntad de Dios es una decisión diaria. Nuestra ofrenda de amor y perdón es una decisión diaria. Esta semana, busquemos maneras de tomar la decisión de ofrecer paz, amor y perdón a quienes forman parte de nuestras familias y comunidades.
