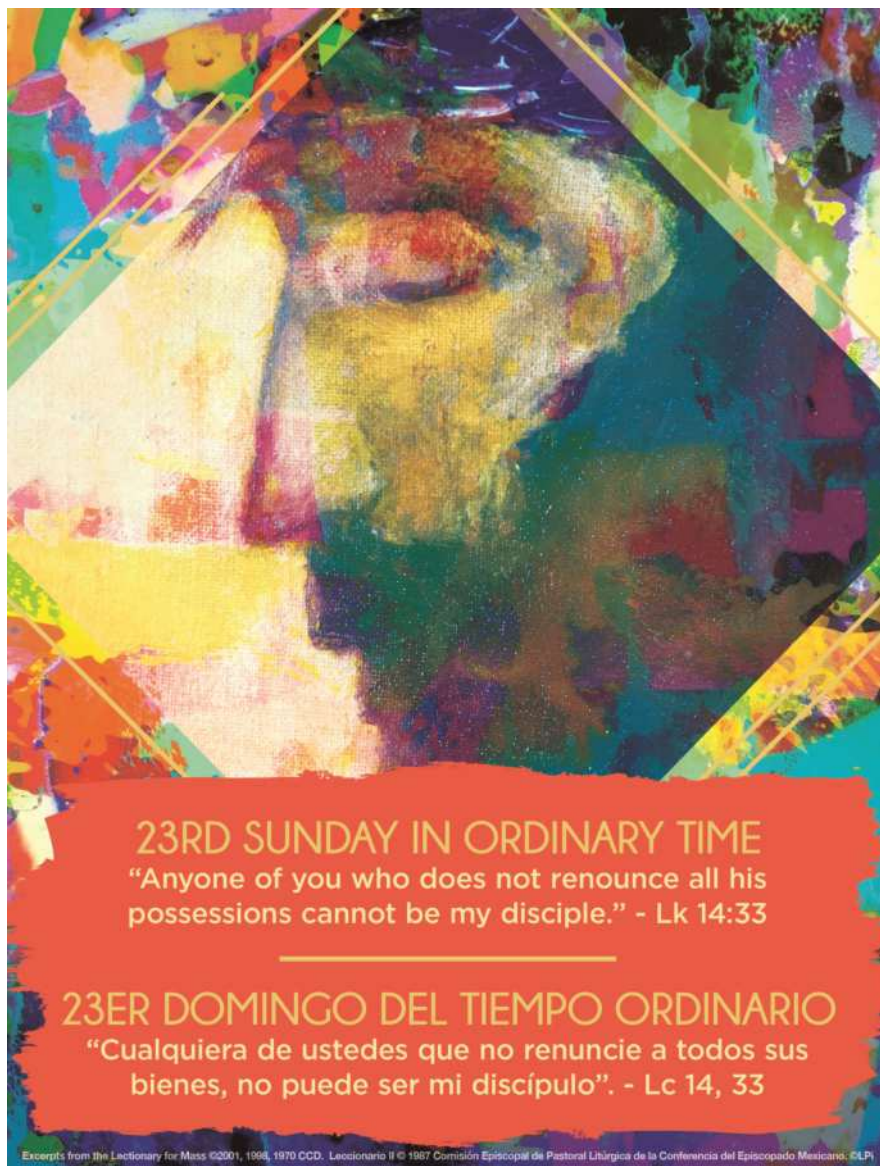

23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

At the time I am writing this article, we had not yet begun school but were looking forward to the first full week of school here at St. Louise, also at St. Madeleine Sophie and all the schools in the area. Some of us have already sent our older children to schools across the country, and some will be leaving in a few weeks.



This time of year brings so much change. A change in the weather, in our day-to-day schedules, in traffic patterns, in our family routines, and on and on. As I mentioned last week, change can be a time of growth. However, change whether or not it's expected, can still be unsettling. It doesn't matter whether the cause of a change is our intention or not, whether a change is good or bad, personal or cultural — it's normal to feel anxious and uncertain. People in all seasons of their faith journeys ask questions of God during times of change. We long to be assured of His presence, to feel peace, to understand what's happening to us, or to even know whether God cares. It can be scary to ask these questions, and it can even make us feel like our faith is on shaky ground.

The good news is that God does not turn away from our questions. And He has lovingly provided His Word for us to turn to in times of uncertainty. The Bible is filled with the stories of God's people — testimonies to God's constant care and abiding presence. If we follow the story of the Israelites through the Old Testament, we see that they went through long periods of time where it may have seemed like God had abandoned them. However, when we read the *whole* story, we get to see that God was at work, even during these long periods, and that He never left His people. Similarly, the New Testament writers recount stories of how Jesus was present *with* his disciples both before and after his death and resurrection, and how his promises for the early Church continue to be true for us today.

Let us continue to have trust in God, that He is with us always. Let us use our prayer as time to talk with God, but more importantly to listen to what God wants us to hear. I know that like you, I have been in prayer so much lately, asking for healing and strength for those in our world who are experiencing unbelievable suffering. The devastation and famine in Gaza, the continuing war in Ukraine, the many other conflicts in the world, and now especially the unbelievable grief and tragedy of the Annunciation School shooting. We hold those children, their families, the school community, and the parish community of Annunciation, close to our hearts, and will continue to pray for healing and strength. As always, we are vigilant about safety measures for our school and parish community, and will continue to fine-tune and adjust our safety procedures as needed.

In this Jubilee year of hope, "may the God of hope fill us with joy and peace in believing, that we may abound in hope in the power of the Holy Spirit." Romans 15:13

23^o Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Al momento de escribir este artículo, aún no habíamos empezado las clases, pero esperábamos con ilusión la primera semana completa de clases aquí en Santa Luisa, también en Santa Magdalena Sofía y en todas las escuelas de la zona. Algunos ya hemos enviado a nuestros hijos mayores a escuelas de todo el país, y otros se irán en unas semanas.

Esta época del año trae consigo muchos cambios. Un cambio en el clima, en nuestros horarios, en los patrones de tráfico, en nuestras rutinas familiares, y así sucesivamente. Como mencioné la semana pasada, el cambio puede ser una época de crecimiento. Sin embargo, sea esperado o no, el cambio puede ser inquietante. No importa si la causa de un cambio es nuestra intención o no, si es bueno o malo, personal o cultural, es normal sentirse ansioso e inseguro. Las personas, en todas las etapas de su camino de fe, cuestionan a Dios en tiempos de cambio. Anhelamos tener la seguridad de su presencia, sentir paz, comprender lo que nos sucede o incluso saber si a Dios le importamos. Puede ser cuestionar, e incluso puede hacernos sentir que nuestra fe se tambalea.

La buena noticia es que Dios no se aparta de nuestras dudas. Y nos ha dado amorosamente su Palabra para que recurramos a ella en tiempos de incertidumbre. La Biblia está llena de historias del pueblo de Dios: testimonios del cuidado constante y la presencia constante de Dios. Si seguimos la historia de los israelitas a lo largo del Antiguo Testamento, vemos que atravesaron largos períodos en los que pudo haber parecido que Dios los había abandonado. Sin embargo, al leer la historia *completa*, vemos que Dios estaba obrando, incluso durante esos largos tiempos, y que nunca abandonó a su pueblo. De igual manera, los escritores del Nuevo Testamento relatan historias de cómo Jesús estuvo presente *con* sus discípulos tanto antes como después de su muerte y resurrección, y cómo sus promesas para la Iglesia primitiva siguen siendo ciertas para nosotros hoy.

Sigamos confiando en Dios, que Él siempre está con nosotros. Usemos nuestra oración como un momento para hablar con Dios, pero sobre todo para escuchar lo que Él quiere que escuchemos. Sé que, al igual que ustedes, últimamente he estado orando mucho, pidiendo sanación y fortaleza para quienes en nuestro mundo están experimentando un sufrimiento increíble. La devastación y la hambruna en Gaza, la continua guerra en Ucrania, los muchos otros conflictos en el mundo y, ahora especialmente, el increíble dolor y la tragedia del tiroteo en la Escuela de la Anunciación. Apreciamos profundamente a estos niños, a sus familias, a la comunidad escolar y a la comunidad parroquial de la Anunciación, y seguiremos orando por sanación y fortaleza. Como siempre, estamos atentos a las medidas de seguridad para nuestra escuela y comunidad parroquial, y seguiremos ajustando nuestros procedimientos de seguridad según sea necesario.

En este año jubilar de esperanza, "que el Dios de la esperanza nos llene de alegría y paz en el creer, para que abundemos en esperanza por el poder del Espíritu Santo". (Romanos 15:13)

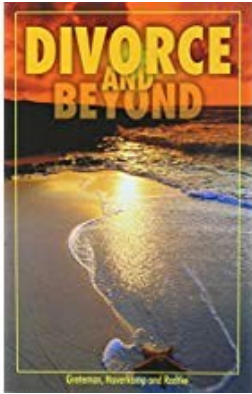
