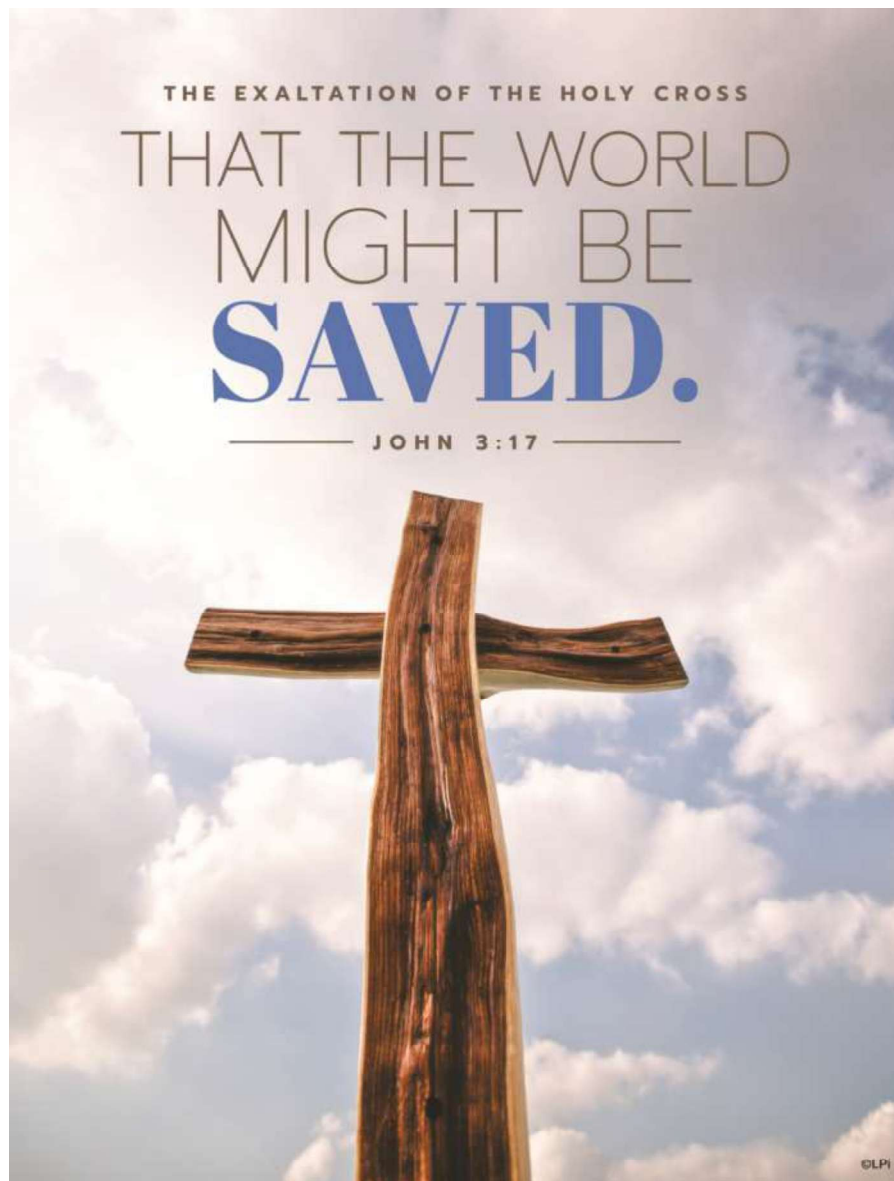

Exaltation of the Cross

In this weekend's Gospel from John, we hear of the profound mystery of the Cross as both the instrument of Christ's suffering and the means of our salvation. Jesus compares his coming crucifixion to the bronze serpent Moses lifted up in the wilderness (First Reading), a foreshadowing of how he himself would be lifted up on the Cross for the healing of all who look to him in faith.



At the heart of this Gospel passage is the revelation of God's love. John 3:16, one of the most well-known verses in Scripture, proclaims that God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, not to condemn but to save. The Cross, then, is the ultimate sign of divine love — a love willing to endure suffering and rejection for the sake of our redemption. This passage challenges us to see the Cross not merely as an historical event but as an ongoing invitation to trust in God's love.

This week let us ask ourselves: How does the Cross challenge our understanding of love and sacrifice in daily life? And in addition, let us each identify a personal challenge or suffering and intentionally unite it with Christ's sacrifice on the Cross.

We all have crosses in our lives that we offer in prayer but must bear nonetheless. We might have relationship issues, mental, emotional or physical health issues, or any of the myriad complexities of life. Health issues can be particularly challenging for all of us, especially when they happen without warning. Recently John Black, our school principal, suffered a minor stroke. While we are grateful the stroke was "minor," anything having to do with the brain can be complex and of course scary. In the aftermath John was optimistic that he would complete physical therapy and be able to return to school full-time.

However, after consulting with his neurologist and his family, John has decided to concentrate fully on his recovery, and therefore he has resigned as our school principal. Joellyn Jaster will become the interim Principal and Barbara Mann has been hired as the interim Vice Principal. Barbara has been a teacher and school parent at St. Louise and served as our interim Vice Principal a couple of years ago. I am grateful to Joellyn and Barbara for accepting these school leadership roles. John and Joellyn will continue to transition over the coming weeks via email. We will begin another principal search later this Fall. Joellyn has my full support as well as that of our parish priests and school faculty and staff. Please join me in prayers for John's full recovery.

Exaltación de la Cruz

En el Evangelio de Juan de este fin de semana, escuchamos el profundo misterio de la Cruz como instrumento del sufrimiento de Cristo y medio de nuestra salvación. Jesús compara su crucifixión venidera con la serpiente de bronce que Moisés levantó en el desierto (Primera Lectura), un anticipo de cómo él mismo sería levantado en la Cruz para la sanación de todos los que acuden a él con fe.

En el centro de este pasaje evangélico se encuentra la revelación del amor de Dios. Juan 3:16, uno de los versículos más conocidos de las Escrituras, proclama que tanto amó Dios al mundo que dio a su Hijo único, no para condenar, sino para salvar. La cruz, pues, es la máxima expresión del amor divino: un amor dispuesto a soportar el sufrimiento y el rechazo por nuestra redención. Este pasaje nos desafía a ver la cruz no solo como un acontecimiento histórico, sino como una invitación constante a confiar en el amor de Dios.

Esta semana, preguntémonos: ¿Cómo desafía la cruz nuestra comprensión del amor y el sacrificio en la vida diaria? Además, identifiquemos un desafío o sufrimiento personal y vinculémoslo intencionalmente con el sacrificio de Cristo en la cruz.

Todos tenemos cruces en nuestras vidas que ofrecemos en oración, pero no debemos soportar ninguna. Quizás podamos tener problemas de pareja, de salud mental, de salud física o cualquier otra de las innumerables complejidades de la vida. Los problemas de salud pueden ser especialmente difíciles para todos, sobre todo cuando ocurren sin previo aviso. Recientemente, John Black, el director de nuestra escuela, sufrió un derrame cerebral leve. Si bien agradecemos que el derrame fuera leve, cualquier problema relacionado con el cerebro puede ser complejo y, por supuesto, aterrador. John se sentía optimista de que completaría la fisioterapia y podría regresar a la escuela a tiempo completo.

Sin embargo, tras consultar con su neurólogo y su familia, ha decidido concentrarse por completo en su recuperación, por lo que ha renunciado a su cargo como director de nuestra escuela. Joellyn Jaster asumirá el cargo de directora interina y Barbara Mann ha sido contratada como subdirectora interina. Barbara ha sido maestra y madre de familia en Sta. Luisa y fue subdirectora interina hace un par de años. Agradezco a Joellyn y Barbara por aceptar estos roles de liderazgo escolar. John y Joellyn continuarán la transición en las próximas semanas por correo electrónico. Comenzaremos otra búsqueda para un nuevo director a finales de este otoño. Joellyn cuenta con todo mi apoyo, así como con el de nuestros sacerdotes, los maestros y el personal de la escuela. Les pido que se unan a mí en oración por la completa recuperación de John.

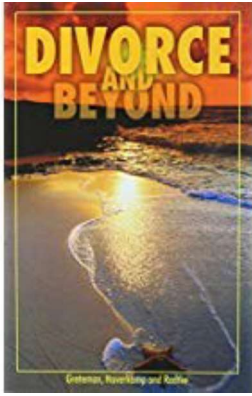

First Holy Communion Prep for Children - what you need to know about changes to the program:

Dear Families,

Thank you for your feedback! First Holy Communion is a significant experience and highpoint in your child's faith journey and we want to do all we can to support you. To help achieve this goal we've made the following program changes:

- **Flexible Meeting Schedule (within limits)**

- We're adding more meeting dates over a longer period of time with planned absences, so if you cannot attend 100% of the sessions, that's OK, as long as you meet the required amount **AND** make arrangements in advance with Susie. We want your child to feel prepared, joyful, and confident for their First Reconciliation (confession) and First Communion 😊!

- **New Meeting Days and Times**

- 2nd graders meet on Sundays 8:30-9:30am (during Sunday Faith Formation time) in the school/faith formation classrooms. At 9:30am children will walk to the church with parish staff or volunteer catechists and either join their parents at Mass or be picked up from inside the church narthex (inside the front doors of the church).
- 4th -12th graders meet on Thursdays 7:00-8:00pm in the school/faith formation classrooms.
- All children, grades 2nd - 12th **AND** their parents meet on 4 select Saturdays 10:30am-12:30pm for clergy led family workshops and special art projects, plus orientation on Saturday October 11 from 10:30-11:30am and rehearsal/breakfast on Saturday April 25 from 10:30am-12:30pm.
- First Communion celebrations are May 2 at the 5pm Mass or May 3 at the 9am Mass (and possibly May 3 at the 5pm Mass).

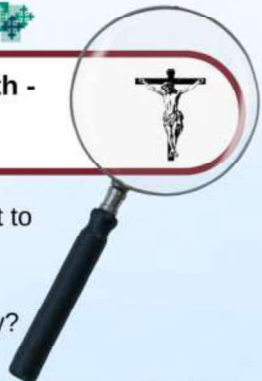

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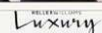


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
