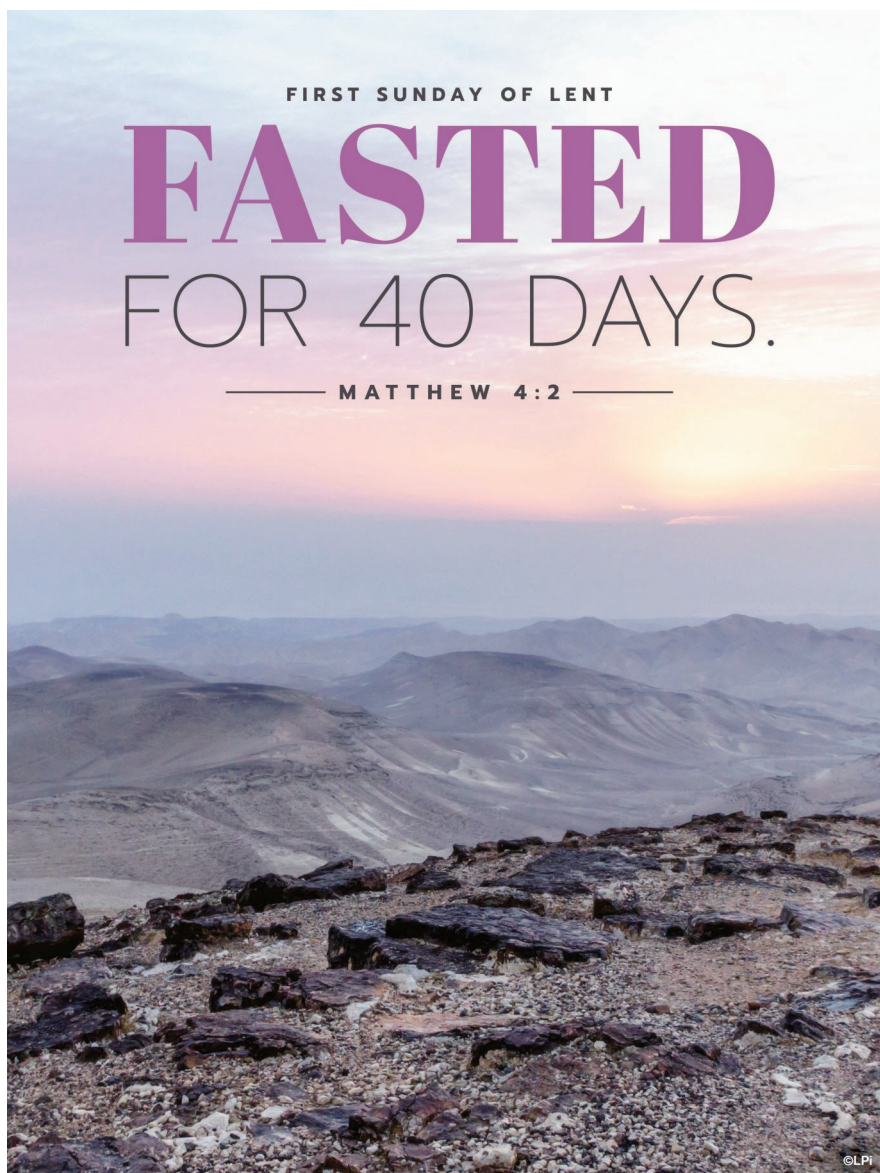

FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

Lent has now begun, and will last until the beginning of the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. It is a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting.



On Ash Wednesday, we were called to turn away from sin to live more fully as followers of Jesus Christ. It is difficult for most people to admit that they themselves sin, that they fail to live as they ought. Lent is a season in which we look closely and honestly at our lives. During Lent, we each acknowledge the ways in which we need to change our minds and hearts to more fully live as people of faith. We have a special name for the changes we are invited to embrace during Lent: *metanoia*. In the spirit of this call to *metanoia*, many people will make a Lenten resolution. The traditional Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving or offering works of charity help us to center our lives as followers of Jesus. Whatever practices we embrace or resolutions we make, the 40 days of Lent are a time of spiritual renewal, a season in which we strive to more fully live our faith in our daily lives. By living Lent well, our lives will be transformed for the better.

Each Lent, Catholic households across the country unite to put their faith into action through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Through CRS Rice Bowl, we learn about how our sisters and brothers across the globe overcome hardships like hunger and climate change, and how, through Lenten alms, we have the power to make the world a better place for all.

Another way to participate in almsgiving is in giving of our time and talent. This year Fr. Gary is celebrating 40 years of ordination! In community with his former seminary, St. Meinrad, he is inviting us to be a part of their annual "Day of Service" on Saturday, March 14, 2026. Join us for a day of fun and action as we work to improve our community. We will be partnering with Volunteer Services to provide basic yard care and maintenance to a neighborhood in need. Please see the bulletin for more information, or contact Amy Baumgartner in the Parish Office.

Please keep our Catechumen (preparing for Baptism) and Candidates (already baptized and preparing for Full Communion) in the OCIA process in your prayers as they continue their journey to the Easter Vigil and Full Communion. The Catechumen participated in the Rite of Election on Saturday morning at the Cathedral with Bishop Frank Schuster. Thank you to our catechists and sponsors who are helping our Catechumen and Candidates on their faith journey.

PRIMER DOMINGO DE CUARESMA

La Cuaresma ya ha comenzado y durará hasta el comienzo de la Misa por la tarde de la Cena del Señor el Jueves Santo. Es un tiempo de preparación para celebrar la Resurrección del Señor en Pascua. Durante la Cuaresma, buscamos al Señor en oración leyendo la Sagrada Escritura; servimos dando la ofrenda; y practicamos la abstinencia mediante el ayuno.

El Miércoles de Ceniza, fuimos llamados a alejarnos del pecado para vivir más plenamente como seguidores de Jesucristo. A la mayoría de las personas les resulta difícil admitir que pecamos, que no vivimos como deberíamos. La Cuaresma es un tiempo en el que reflexionamos profunda y honestamente sobre nuestras vidas. Durante la Cuaresma, reconocemos cómo necesitamos cambiar nuestra mente y nuestro corazón para vivir más plenamente como personas de fe. Tenemos un nombre especial para los cambios que se nos invita a adoptar durante la Cuaresma: *metanoia*. En el espíritu de este llamado a la *metanoia*, muchas personas hacen un propósito cuaresmal. Las prácticas tradicionales cuaresmales de oración, ayuno y limosna u ofrendas de caridad nos ayudan a centrar nuestras vidas como seguidores de Jesús. Sean cuales sean las prácticas que adoptemos o los propósitos que hagamos, los cuarenta días de Cuaresma son un tiempo de renovación espiritual, un tiempo en el que nos esforzamos por vivir más plenamente nuestra fe en nuestra vida diaria. Al vivir bien la Cuaresma, nuestras vidas se transformarán para mejor.

Cada Cuaresma, familias católicas de todo el país se unen para poner su fe en acción mediante la oración, el ayuno y la ofrenda. A través de Plato de Arroz de CRS, las familias aprenden cómo nuestros hermanos y hermanas de todo el mundo superan dificultades como el hambre y el cambio climático, y cómo, mediante la ofrenda cuaresmal, tenemos el poder de hacer del mundo un lugar mejor para todos.

Otra forma de participar en la ofrenda es compartiendo nuestro tiempo y talento. ¡El Padre Gary celebrará 40 años de ordenación en 2026! En comunidad con su antiguo seminario, St. Meinrad nos invita a participar en su "Día de Servicio" anual el sábado 14 de marzo de 2026. Únase a nosotros para un día de diversión y acción mientras trabajamos para mejorar nuestra comunidad. Colaboraremos con Servicios Voluntarios para brindar cuidado y mantenimiento básico de jardines a un vecindario necesitado. 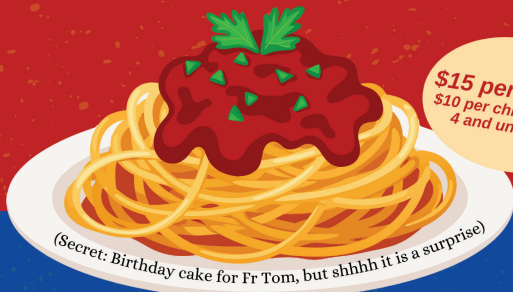

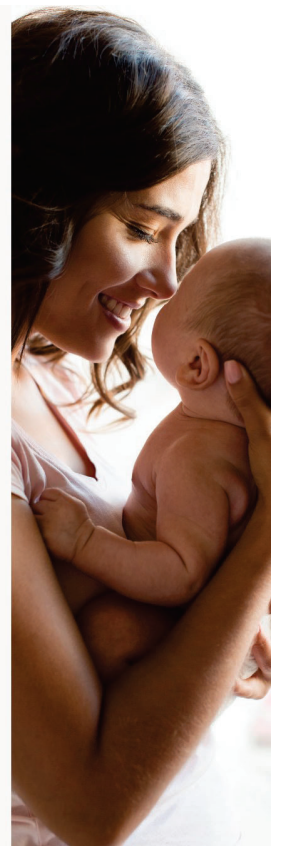

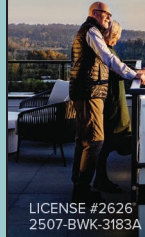
