


PASTORAL REFLECTION


"On the sabbath Jesus entered the synagogue and taught. The people were astonished at his teaching, for he taught them as one having authority and not as the scribes." (Mark 1:21-22)

The people who listened to Jesus sensed that God Himself was speaking through the voice of Jesus, whose teachings rang true in their hearts. His teachings had authority because they were undeniable and came from His very person, which is Truth itself. As Jesus later says, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6)

Jesus is the ultimate prophet, the fulfillment of God's promise to Moses and the people: "I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their kin, and will put my words into his mouth; he shall tell them all that I command him." Jesus continues to teach with prophetic authority through His Catholic Church, even those teachings that are difficult for people to accept, such as the truths that the Church reveals and elucidates on marriage, family, and openness to children.

With a father and mother's concern for our souls, God patiently encourages us to listen to the prophetic voice of the Lord in His Church, as we hear in the psalm for today: "Oh, that today you would hear his voice: 'Harden




Consecration to St. Joseph!



Pope Francis declared 2021 a year dedicated to St. Joseph. Let's prepare to receive the greatest possible graces from this providential devotion by making a consecration to St. Joseph! This means that we renew our baptismal vows of complete dedication to Christ through our childlike trust in St. Joseph. This doesn't replace our

childlike trust in God our Father; in fact, it strengthens our trust in God because St. Joseph was given by God the Father to Christ His Son when the Word became Flesh in the immaculate virgin Mary, so that the holy child Jesus could see a human face of God's fatherly love in the kind, patient, and protective gaze of St. Joseph.

We can consecrate ourselves on the major feast day of St. Joseph, March 19. To get more out of the consecration, we can do a 33-day preparation starting February 15 using the book Consecration to St. Joseph: The Wonders of Our Spiritual Father by Fr Donald Calloway. You can do this on your own, with your family, or in a group. Father will also host a small meeting on Mondays at 6:00 pm starting February 15 at Our Lady of Hope parish hall, and will live-stream the meeting via our social media (YouTube and Facebook). Feast of St. Blase

On Wednesday, February 3, is the feast day of St. Blase, and we will offer the traditional "blessing of the throats." Saint Blase was bishop of Sebaste in Armenia in the fourth century. Before being martyred, he is said to have healed a boy who was choking. Since the eighth century,

Saint Blase has been venerated as the patron of those who suffer from diseases of the throat. We will pray in a special way for protection from afflictions of the throat and from other illnesses. The blessing of Saint Blase is a sign of our faith in God's protection and love for us and for the sick. With the crossed candles touched to the throat of each person, the celebrant says: "Through the intercession of Saint Blase, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."
