Safeguarding material and human resources and using them responsibly are one answer; so is generous giving of time, talent, and treasure. But being a Christian steward means more. As Christian stewards, we receive God's gifts gratefully, cultivate them responsibly, share them lovingly in justice with others, and return them with increase to the Lord.

A NOTE FROM FATHER TOM, OMI

The end of June brings with it the preparing of a budget for the new fiscal year that will begin in July. The figures for the present year that we are completing will not all be in until at least the middle of July. This means that reporting on the year to the parish and to the Archdiocese will take place around the end of July or into August.

The Finance Council has already had a couple of meetings where budgeting issues have been worked on. The common practice – the one that we follow for budgeting – is to go over the figures for the year that is ending, examining how our parish financial situation has corresponded or not corresponded to the budget that was made in the summer of last year. We don't just take the same budget as the one we had for the previous year. Yet, we do calculate income and expenses on what the past year or two have been because that gives us the best idea of what the new year is likely to bring. As you are now beginning to see, our reporting, instead of a week to week listing of offertory income and expenses, will be one of quarterly figures. That, we believe, will make it easier to see the financial reality of the parish.

I also want to thank the members of our parish finance council who quarter by quarter work with the parish staff and with the archdiocese to maintain a responsible use of the resources with which we at Our Lady of the Angels have been blessed.

A NOTE FROM THE PASTORAL COUNCIL

The OLA Pastoral council was formed at the request of, and guidance from, the Archdiocese of Anchorage. As part of our governing by-laws we advise the Pastor and Pastoral Team on matters involving the "spiritual and community life of the Parish."

In recognition of this, the Pastoral Council has adopted a theme for the remainder of the calendar year, entitled "Prayer Life", that will focus primarily on the individual's personal

relationship with Christ. Our purpose for establishing this theme was to encourage emphasis on personal prayer, not only at church on Sunday, but at home, in the work place, and in our everyday happenings. We are inviting all parishioners to participate in enhancing their own personal prayer life. We will be encouraging prayer in messages communicated through various forms, specifically the parish bulletin, My Parish cell phone app, printed literature, and others to be determined.

At the same time what a person learns in a class doesn't necessarily translate into truth that changes their lives. What we learn in school frequently needs to be complemented by what we learn from practical experience. Our faith needs to bring us to action. This means that our experience of Church in action is of great importance for the young people of our parish. The Church in action is the community that really tries to be a community of love and mercy. It is a community that brings its joys, struggles, sufferings and hopes to God in shared prayer and worship. It is a community that is concerned about others in need and wants to be of service as a way of putting love and mercy into action the way Jesus did.

Young people in our parish come through our faith formation experience to make choices about belonging to a community of faith. Our faith formation program has to offer them not just a class where they are told about faith, but an experience of faith in action, of Church in action, in order for them to choose belonging as a way of living an ongoing relationship with God in practice. ~ Fr.
