SEVEN THEMES OF CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING

II. Call to Family, Community, and Participation

The person is not only sacred but also social. How we organize our society -- in economics and politics, in law and policy -- directly affects human dignity and the capacity of individuals to grow in community. Marriage and the family are the central social institutions that must be supported and strengthened, not undermined. We believe people have a right and a duty to participate in society, seeking together the common good and well-being of all, especially the poor and vulnerable.

III. Rights and Responsibilities

The Catholic tradition teaches that human dignity can be protected and a healthy community can be achieved only if human rights are protected and responsibilities are met. Therefore, every person has a fundamental right to life and a right to those things required for human decency. Corresponding to these rights are duties and responsibilities—to one another, to our families, and to the larger society.

IV. Solidarity

We are one human family whatever our national, racial, ethnic, economic, and ideological differences. We are our brothers and sisters keepers, wherever they may be. Loving our neighbor has global dimensions in a shrinking world. At the core of the virtue of solidarity is the pursuit of justice and peace. Pope Paul VI taught that if you want peace, work for justice.1 The Gospel calls us to be peacemakers. Our love for all our sisters and brothers demands that we promote peace in a world surrounded by violence and conflict.

2018 OBOB SHORT-FALL

Every year the Archdiocese assesses each parish a goal for the **One Bread One Body Campaign**.

All parishes are assessed 11.47% of the prior year's adjusted revenue. **Our assessment for 2018 was \$24,634**.

In the spring, each parishioner is sent information and a pledge card for this campaign which supports the many ministries of the Archdiocese.

To date, our parish is **short of our goal by \$10,829.00**. It is the practice of the Archdiocese to bill the parish for the shortfall.

If no more OBOB donations are received, in July 2019 we will withdraw \$10,829.00 from the parish savings to pay this remaining assessment of the 2018 OBOB. At this time we have not been notified of the assessment amount for 2019.
