The Diocese of San Angelo has recently developed an on-line version of its Safe Environment Training Program, which includes The Diocese of San Angelo Policies on Ethics and Integrity in Ministry. The development of this new format is the result of two important factors. First, are the recommendations by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) and the independent auditors who audit our Safe Environment Program. The USCCB and auditors have recommended for the past few years that the diocese have refresher Safe Environment Training for all of its ministers. Secondly, we have been wanting to make it easier for people to attend the Diocesan Safe Environment Training. Everyone whose ethics workshop date is over five years must take this new training in order to continue working in ministry. If anyone is not sure if their workshop is over five years ago, they can check with Gladys at the parish office, 432-520-7394 or email gladys@ststephensmidland.com. To access the training go to https://sanangelo.cmgconnect.org/. Register to open your own training account and begin your training. In order to complete the training everyone must have a copy of the revised ethics policy booklet (June 1, 2020) and a completed background check before they begin the training. People may obtain a copy from their parish office or download and print one from either our diocesan webpage or the on-line training site. If you have not yet ordered copies of the ethics policies booklet for your parish, please be sure and do so. Because we feel it is important that you know how and where your donations to Helping Hands are spent, here is what was done in the past week:

Electric	2 families	\$	252.64

We met with two women last week who both approached us with requests for rental assistance. While their needs were similar, their reasons for needing help were very different. And it is that difference that can at times make our jobs very hard. Shirley is a 63-year-old woman who suffered a stroke two months ago. As a result of the stroke, she is suffering from aphasia and has difficulty with her speech and gets confused easily. She has also recently been diagnosed with COPD. She has an appointment with Social Security the end of June.

Before her stroke she had a job grooming animals. When she approached her employer asking for help in getting unemployment benefits, she was told to come back later, that they were too busy. She went back again to get documentation that she had worked there and was again blown off. She is at a standstill with them. Meanwhile, she said she has been selling off her personal belongings trying to raise money for food, rent and utilities.

When we met with her our hearts immediately went out to this woman who is trying so hard, but who is so confused, so alone. We walked her through the steps we felt she needed to take: to contact Legal Aid and a disability lawyer for assistance in cutting through the red tape with the unemployment and perhaps seeing if she qualifies for disability. We also gave her a list of agencies that assist with utilities and a list of places she can go in Midland to get food at no cost. We paid her rent for three months because we feel it might take that long for assistance to come through. We will check on her and pray that her obstacles are quickly overcome.

Cynthia is a 35-year-old woman with two children. She recently quit her job when she did not get the raise she expected. She came to us because she had not found another job yet and July was approaching. We offered to pay her July rent but pointed out to her that that job market was opening up and there should be no reason not to have a job in the foreseeable future. She told us that she was really expecting three months of rent. After all, she said, "I know someone that you helped with 3 months rent and she was old and didn't have any kids like I do!"

Needless to say, we only assisted with the one month and told her that if she got a job within the next week or two, she should have no trouble making her August rent. We did give her a list of other agencies should she be needing help later. Her feelings of entitlement are unfortunately something we run into way more than we would like. We certainly hope that she learns to count her blessings and to manage her life better.
