

We ran this in the St. Stephen's bulletin and Midland Reporter-Telegram on January 16, 2003, when our organization was just 5 years old:

There was a small church in a village in Germany that was destroyed by a bomb during World War II. When the villagers set about to rebuild the church they found in the rubble the ancient crucifix that once hung behind the alter, however both of Jesus' arms were missing. Much discussion took place over whether the crucifix should be repaired, or a facsimile of the original be made. In the end, it was decided that the original crucifix, without arms, be hung behind the altar of the newly rebuilt church. Above the crucifix is a sign that reads "You are my arms." The crucifix and sign are still there today.

We are all called to be God's arms in this world, and we must never, through laziness, weariness, or for any reason, miss an opportunity to be His instruments for making His redemptive work present in our lives, and in the lives of those around us. Any small service that we do for our neighbors becomes the fruit of our love for Christ.

We then reported that the week previously we helped 16 families with rent, utilities, transportation and medical expenses at a cost of \$2,363.25.

How far we have come! As reported last week we assisted 26 families at a cost of \$34,592.77! Back in 2003 we struggled to come up with even that little bit of revenue and as such were limited in how much we could spend on each family. Through your incredible generosity over the years, we have grown to where we can now assist families with TOTAL NEED. And last week that was \$34,592.77. Your arms have reached out to embrace us over the years and allowed us the opportunity to do so much more. That we are here at all is all due to our donors, and we are humbled by how you have protected us over the years and allowed us to grow. God bless you!
