

The fire at the Mosaic Apartments last week left 8 families homeless. The tenants of some of those apartments lost virtually everything they had. Others fared a little better. The Red Cross did their usual great job of ministering to the needs of the victims, giving each family \$500 to help offset expenses. The management of the Mosaic Apartments also did a great job of rehoming the victims of the fire, either in the same complex or in other complexes owned by the same company. We understand that several churches and groups came forward with clothing to help the families in need. We are meeting with any of those families that contact us to assist them with their upcoming rents. They are charged with replacing all that they have lost...the least we can do is help offset that expense by assisting with rent. We are so grateful that you continue to provide us with the funds to help those families in need. And how blessed we are that we live in a city like Midland, where we all pull together to assist our neighbors in need!

We also met with a woman whose gas had been shut off because her gas lines had corroded and needed to be replaced. It was a huge expense (over \$4,000), however her husband is extremely ill and unable to work, and she has to be at home to provide care for him. There is absolutely no way that they could have afforded to make those repairs on their own. Thankfully Atmos Energy has provided us with funding to use for instances such as this one.

This year requests for utility assistance has been much higher than in the past. We figure a lot of that has to do with overall inflation and the rising costs of living. We are grateful for the assistance that the Abell-Hanger Foundation provides for us to use for utility assistance.

It is so humbling to see how so many of us work together to make life easier for those in need. We feel especially privileged to be a part of this process, and we are forever grateful to all of you who make it possible to help so many, thanks to your very generous donations! God bless you!


