Many of the shoppers of our thrift store are "regulars." They shop every day (Wednesday and Saturday) that we are open and we come to know them – their habits, their moods, their anxieties, their joys. When we noticed Isaac a few months ago desperately seeking something in the store in areas that he did not usually frequent, we became curious. He usually looked through movies, books and knickknacks. But when we asked him, he said that he was looking for hardware.

He told us that his cousin, a victim of MS, had recently been relegated full-time to an electric scooter. She is only 41 years old. While she had managed the transition to the scooter, she was despondent over the fact that she was homebound. She had always participated heavily in her children's athletic endeavors, and even after the horrible disease started robbing her of her mobility, she was at least able to watch them from the sidelines. But that was no longer an option. Insurance had covered the scooter, but would not cover the lift that would allow the scooter to be hoisted into a vehicle. Her husband could not bear his wife's depression. Her spirit was gone. Their budged was already stretched to the max over her medical expenses and there was no way he could raise the money for the lift. He approached Isaac to see if there was some way they could build something themselves that would work to transport the scooter. And so Isaac came to Helping Hands looking for a miracle that might be hidden on the shelves of our store.

What he found was the attentive eye of a caseworker who noticed his anxiety, listened to his story, and then offered a helping hand. We were able to get his cousin a refurbished lift that was needed to get her out of the house and actively back into her children's lives. What a joy! Thank you for your generous donations to the store which makes Helping Hands a place where miracles happen!
