We have sometimes been asked if hearing the same old story over and over again doesn't get old after a while. After all, just how many times can you stand to hear that same old story about how the father left and took all the money and now the mother and children have nothing? Well, we do hear that from time to time, but our work is hardly boring or routine. A couple of examples:

We received a call from a woman who had come to Midland to visit her 89-year-old grandmother who had been in a nursing home. She had been there for several months but now was ready to be released to go home provided that a family member could be there with her until she was able to get back on her feet. The grandmother had lived in a house that was given to her by her brother many years ago. He has since passed away. The granddaughter lived out of state, but made arrangements to stay with the woman, since the elderly woman had made it very clear that she did not want to leave her home.

To the granddaughter's horror she found out that the home had no water – nor had there been water for the past 7 or 8 years. The water pump had gone out years ago, and since then many of the water lines had deteriorated. The grandmother, in her pride, never mentioned it to anyone in her family and she had lived without running water in her home all that time. Her family lived out of state and she would visit them rather than vice a versa, so they had no knowledge of her plight. Still, the nursing home was reluctant to let her go until the home was livable. The granddaughter contacted us. She had gotten in touch with a water-well company that could make the necessary repairs, however the family could not afford the expense. Because the home was not in the grandmother's name no other agency that she contacted was able to help financially. Of course we jumped on it! To be able to help a woman especially of that age enjoy her remaining days in a house that she called her home was of utmost importance to us. We were grateful to have been able to help

Routine? Boring? Not hardly! There are as many stories out there as there are people on this planet. There is absolutely nothing "old" about this ministry. What a joy and special blessing it is to be a part of helping to right a wrong, and to bring peace and comfort to someone in genuine need. We thank all of you for your continued support of the needy through Helping Hands, that makes it possible to continue to help those in need.
