Fr. Bala Sunday Reflection

The Epiphany: Light Piercing the Shadows of Our Lives

Brothers and sisters in Christ, the season of Christmas has passed, yet its starlit echoes linger in our hearts. Today, on the Feast of the Epiphany, we celebrate not just the birth of a babe in a manger, but the manifestation of a light so radiant, it pierces the shadows of ignorance and illuminates the path to salvation for all humanity.

Let us turn to the prophet Isaiah, his words painted with the brush of hope, a promise shimmering against the backdrop of darkness: "Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord rises upon you!" (Isaiah 60:1). The world, veiled in the fog of

doubt and disbelief, awaits the illumination of God's presence. Yet, this light does not descend from an ivory tower, but from a humble stable in Bethlehem. Jesus, the newborn Word, embodies the dawning of a new era, an era where divine grace embraces not just the chosen few, but the entirety of creation.

Echoing this universal love, the Apostle Paul writes in his letter to the Ephesians: "This mystery was not made known to people in generations past, as it has now been revealed by the Spirit to his holy apostles and prophets: that is, the Gentiles are heirs together with the Jews, members of the same body, and sharers in the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel." (Ephesians 3:2-3a, 5-6). Paul emphasizes the shattering of boundaries, the dismantling of walls that separated Jew and Gentile, rich and poor, wise and simple. In Jesus, all become heirs to the Kingdom of Heaven, invited to bask in the warmth of His light.

And just as light attracts moths, Christ's radiance beckoned even from afar. Look to the story of the Magi, those star-gazing seekers from the East. Guided by celestial whispers, they embarked on a perilous journey, their hearts heavy with expectation, their souls yearning for understanding. They could have been kings, wealthy scholars, or astrologers, yet they set aside their comfort and prestige, following a glimmer in the night sky.

Their journey mirrors our own, doesn't it? We, too, navigate a world fraught with challenges, searching for meaning, for purpose, for a flicker of hope in the darkness. We hunger for something beyond the mundane, something that speaks to the deepest longings of our hearts. And like the Magi, we are called to answer the call, to pack our bags of faith and courage, and embark on a pilgrimage towards the light of Christ.

The path may be arduous, but remember, we are not alone. Just as the Magi were led by a celestial beacon, we have the guiding star of scripture, the compass of conscience, and the unwavering presence of the Holy Spirit within us. And when we arrive at the manger, at the foot of the cross, at the threshold of our own spiritual awakenings, let us offer what the Magi offered: gold, representing our willingness to surrender our pride and worldly treasures; frankincense, symbolizing our prayers and devotion; and myrrh, foreshadowing the sacrifices we are prepared to make for the sake of truth.

The Epiphany is not just a historical event; it is a timeless invitation. It is a call to rise above the shadows of doubt, to follow the light of Christ, and to share its radiance with the world. Let us be agents of illumination, dispelling the darkness of injustice, prejudice, and despair. Let us be beacons of hope, guiding others towards the manger of Bethlehem, reminding them that salvation has come, not just for a chosen few, but for all who open their hearts to the dazzling light of the Son of God.

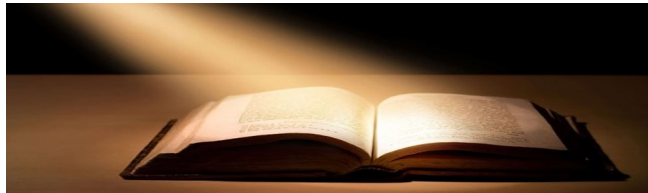

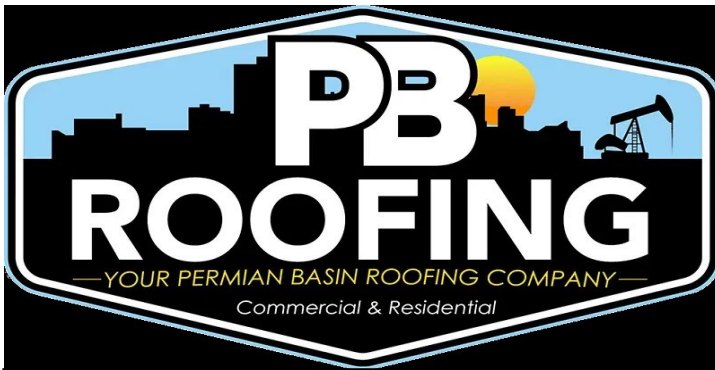
