Fr. Bala Sunday Reflection

Responding to God's Call with Commitment and Purpose Introduction: "Today, as we gather on this Second Sunday in Ordinary Time, we reflect on the beautiful tapestry of readings that invite us to listen and respond to God's call in our lives. Each reading today offers a unique perspective on how we are called and how we might respond."

1 Samuel 3:3b-10, 19 - Hearing God's Call: "In our first reading, young Samuel hears God calling him. Initially, he doesn't recognize God's voice, but with guidance, he responds, 'Speak, for your servant is listening.' This narrative invites us to attune ourselves to hear God's voice in our lives. Often, amidst the noise and distractions of our daily lives, we might miss His gentle calling. Let us learn to listen more deeply, with the willingness to be guided and taught."

Psalm 40:2, 4, 7-8, 8-9, 10 - A Song of Commitment: "The Psalmist expresses a profound commitment to God, acknowledging His help and professing a desire to do His will. 'I have come to do your will, O God.' Our response to God's call should be one of dedication and joy, recognizing the ways He lifts us and sets our feet upon solid ground."

1 Corinthians 6:13c-15a, 17-20 - Our Bodies, a Temple of the Holy Spirit: "St. Paul reminds the Corinthians that our bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, and thus we are called to glorify God through them. This is a profound reminder of the sanctity of our physical selves and the responsibility to use our actions, words, and lives to honor God. In our daily choices, let us remember this sacred calling."

John 1:35-42 - Following Jesus: "The Gospel brings us to the moment where John the Baptist points two of his disciples towards Jesus, saying, 'Behold, the Lamb of God!' This encounter leads to Andrew and Simon Peter following Jesus. Like them, we are invited to encounter Jesus in our lives and make the choice to follow Him. It's a journey that demands commitment and a willingness to be transformed."
