## Fr. Bala Sunday Reflection

### Faith, Sacrifice and Divine Promise

Today, we gather to reflect on the Word of God, which speaks to us across ages, cultures, and personal circumstances. Our readings from Genesis, Psalms, Romans, and Mark share a common thread: the theme of faith, sacrifice, and divine promise. These scriptures invite us to contemplate the depth of our faith, the nature of our sacrifices, and the assurance of God's promises in our lives.

### **Genesis 22:1-2, 9a, 10-13, 15-18 - The Test of Faith**

In Genesis, we encounter the profound story of Abraham's faith and obedience. God tests Abraham, asking him to sacrifice his son Isaac. Despite the unimaginable demand, Abraham proceeds in faith, willing to sacrifice what is most precious to him. At the last moment, God provides a ram as a substitute for Isaac, sparing his life. This story is not merely about the test but about Abraham's unwavering faith and trust in God's promises.

**Application:** Like Abraham, we are called to trust in God's providence, even when faced with trials that test the very foundation of our faith. Our sacrifices may not be as dramatic as Abraham's, but every day, we are invited to lay down our plans, desires, and sometimes, our very comfort, trusting that God's plans for us are greater.

### **Psalms 116:10, 15, 16-17, 18-19 - The Joy of Salvation**

The Psalmist speaks of faith in times of distress and the preciousness of the faithful to the Lord. It's a song of thanksgiving for deliverance and a commitment to continue serving the Lord in the land of the living.

**Application:** We are reminded to maintain our faith in difficult times and to express our gratitude for God's salvation. Our service to God, expressed through our daily lives and actions, is a testament to the faith we hold in our hearts.

### **Romans 8:31b-34 - God's Unfailing Support**

Paul reassures us that with God on our side, we can face any challenge. No one can be against us if God is with us. This passage celebrates God's ultimate sacrifice—Jesus Christ—and His ongoing intercession for us.

**Application:** This message is an invitation to lean into our faith, especially when we feel alone or opposed. It encourages us to remember that in our struggles, we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us, for Christ is interceding for us.

### **Mark 9:2-10 - The Transfiguration**

The Transfiguration of Jesus before Peter, James, and John reveals His divine glory, affirming His Sonship and the fulfillment of God's promise. This event strengthens the disciples' faith and prepares them for the challenges ahead.

**Application:** The Transfiguration invites us to recognize the divine moments in our lives, where God's presence and promises become palpably real. It's a call to spiritual awakening, to open our eyes to the divine glory that surrounds us and to the hope of our transformation in Christ.

Because we feel it is important that you know how and where your donations to Helping Hands are spent, here is what was done last week:

Electric	10 families	\$ 4,963.39
Water	6 families	\$ 5,410.23
Rent	17 families	\$ 33,565.86
Transportation	1 family	\$ 1,753.54

People continue to ask us how we can continue to spend as much as we do each week on assistance to the needy. Well, we answer, we are blessed to have supporters like you who realize the importance of helping our neighbors in need. And we are blessed to have volunteer caseworkers who are willing to allocate that money. And because we are volunteer, every cent that you donate to us goes directly to the poor. So far we have been able to keep up with, and at times exceed the \$40,000/week we are allotted to spend. God bless all of you for making that possible!

We are very privileged at Helping Hands in that your generosity makes it possible that we are not bound by rules that limit how much we can spend on someone in need. Some examples: a man in his mid-40's suffered 3 strokes. He was partially paralyzed and had difficulty with speech. We helped him with his rent and utilities for 3 months. His needs ended up costing Helping Hands over \$4,000, but we were privileged to be able to pay it — the man did not have to worry about keeping a roof over his family's heads while he learned to live with his handicap and eventually get his disability benefits. Likewise, the middle-aged woman who became afflicted with seizures: unable to work or to drive her car, she went through her entire life savings paying for utilities and medications while she waited for disability benefits. Finally, she had no choice but to come to us for help. She expressed that doing so was personally the most humiliating thing she had ever done — she had never dreamed of being in that situation. We joyfully helped her with utilities and medical bills for the two months it took for her first disability check to arrive. We worked on a case of an elderly woman whose daughter was in a car accident and had been hospitalized for several months. The rent on the daughter's house had not been paid. The mother's small social security check did not enable her to help financially, nor did she have room in her 1-bedroom apartment for the 5 children. The daughter's rent was 3 months overdue and while the landlord had been very patient, he needed his money. Bringing her rent current cost us almost \$5,000 but we felt the money was well spent.

Is our spending wasteful or frivolous? No! Are we covering everyone who comes to us with a legitimate need? Not hardly.
