SUNDAY REFLECTION BY FR. BALA

Pentecost Sunday Homily: "The Fire Still Burns"

Readings: Acts 2:1-11 | Romans 8:8-17 | John 14:15-16, 23b-26

I. Introduction: The Promise Fulfilled

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ.

Today, we celebrate the birth of the Church. Pentecost is not merely an event of the past—it is the unfolding of God's divine plan through the Holy Spirit, who hovers over creation, speaks through prophets and apostles, fills the hearts of saints, and now dwells in us, the baptized children of God.

"They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues." (Acts 2:4)

What began in a hidden Upper Room in Jerusalem is now proclaimed to the ends of the earth: God is with us and within us.

II. The Spirit From the Beginning

Let us go back to the beginning—Genesis 1:2: "The Spirit of God was hovering over the waters." Even before creation took shape, the Spirit was moving. Every act of creation was breathed into existence by this divine Wind. The same Spirit:

- **Inspired Noah** to build an ark of hope.
- **Strengthened Moses** to part the sea and receive the law.
- **Empowered the Judges** like Gideon and Deborah to lead with courage.

Spoke through the prophets like Isaiah, Jeremiah, and Ezekiel, calling God's people to repentance and hope.

The Holy Spirit is not a New Testament gift alone. He is the eternal breath of God, active from the dawn of time.

III. The Spirit in the Apostles and the Church

In today's Gospel, Jesus promises:

"The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." (John 14:26)

And He did just that.

At Pentecost, the Spirit did not come quietly. He came as a mighty rushing wind and tongues of fire—symbols of power, transformation, and purification. The same Peter who denied Jesus three times now stands before a crowd and proclaims Him boldly. That's what the Spirit does—He changes cowards into martyrs, sinners into saints, and doubters into preachers.

IV. The Spirit in the Saints and in Us

From St. Paul to St. Augustine...

From St. Francis of Assisi to St. Thérèse of Lisieux...

From St. Teresa of Calcutta to the saints of today...

Each of them was aflame with the same fire of Pentecost.

And this fire is **not reserved for the elite**, but for you and me.

"You did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you received a spirit of adoption." (Romans 8:15)

We are not orphans, but children of God, and the Spirit bears witness within us.

V. Living Pentecost Today

Pentecost is not just a memory—it is a mission.

The Holy Spirit:

- Convicts us of sin, but never to condemn—only to heal.
- Gives us gifts (wisdom, courage, understanding...) to build the Church.

Unites us in diversity, as He did that day in Jerusalem when every nation heard the Gospel in their own language. You are called to be a living Pentecost:

- Be the fire in a cold world.
- Be the wind that stirs hearts back to God.

Be the voice that speaks the language of love, mercy, and truth.

VI. Conclusion: Set the World on Fire

St. Catherine of Siena once said, "Be who God meant you to be, and you will set the world on fire." The world does not need more noise. It needs **Spirit-filled Christians** who listen to the Spirit, obey His voice, and live with holy courage. Let us pray today:

"Come, Holy Spirit. Rekindle in us the fire of Your love. Make us bold like Peter, prayerful like Mary, and passionate like Paul. Let the fire of Pentecost burn in us and through us."

And may this Church, this city, and this world know that God is not dead, He is alive in the Holy Spirit!

Amen. Alleluia!


















MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS

We are seeking compassionate medical professionals, (physicians, nurses, PAs and NPs), to join us in providing essential healthcare services to underserved communities. This mission aims to offer medical assistance, health education, and support to those in need.







FATHER'S DAY MASS INTENTIONS

His boss had to go to Lubbock due to a death in the family, and since he had the day off, he found his way to Helping Hands. We told him to go into our store and find a clean set of clothing.

When he came back with one pair of jeans and a t-shirt we asked if he had money for food. He said that his boss bought him lunch every day. Since his boss was in Lubbock, what was he going to eat until he got back? The man was quick to respond that he didn't need much food and would be just fine until his boss got back from Lubbock.

And where was he staying? He said that he had been sleeping behind a dumpster at a motel. He had stayed at the motel when he first got to town, but his money ran out. But he quickly added he was not looking for a place to stay. The nights were warm, and he rather enjoyed lying outside, looking up at the stars. They certainly are spectacular in Texas, he said. Did his boss know he was sleeping outside? No, he replied. His boss was good enough to give him a job. He was grateful enough just for that.

There was something about this many that touched this caseworker deeply. His cheerfulness and the simplicity of his needs bespoke a person who is far freer and more at peace that most of us could ever hope to be with all our possessions.

Despite his protests, we got him a room for a week (until his first paycheck came in), gave him a gift card for food so he could eat during the time his boss was gone, and gave him some change to clean his clothes. We wish him well...but we know that he will be just fine. He most certainly must be one of God's most cherished ones!
