SUNDAY REFLECTION BY FR. BALA

Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Genesis 14:18–20 | 1 Corinthians 11:23–26 | Luke 9:11b–17

Theme: "Become What You Receive"

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ.

Today, we come before the altar not merely to observe a feast, but to adore a miracle. This is the **Solemnity of Corpus Christi**—the day the Church lifts high the mystery of the **Eucharist**, the most sacred gift of Jesus Himself: *Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity*, hidden in humble bread and wine.

Saint John Paul II once said, "The Eucharist is not a part of life—it is life."

1. The Eucharist: Covenant Fulfilled in Love

We begin with Genesis 14, where **Melchizedek**, the priest-king of Salem, offers **bread and wine**—a mysterious and prophetic gesture. He blesses Abram in the name of God Most High. The Church has always seen in Melchizedek a figure of Christ, who, centuries later, would also offer **bread and wine—but changed into His very self.**

As the Lauda Sion sings:

"Now the new the old effaces, Truth away the shadow chases, Light dispels the gloom of night."

The Eucharist is not merely a meal—it is the **new covenant**, the **light that pierces the darkness**, the **true sacrifice** that ends all sacrifices. Saint Augustine reminds us: "You are what you receive."

In receiving Christ's Body, we are called to become His Body—healers, peacemakers, living tabernacles in a broken world.

2. The Institution: A Gift and a Command

In 1 Corinthians, St. Paul transmits to us what he himself received: "This is my Body... This is my Blood... Do this in remembrance of Me." These are not empty words. They are divine instructions that echo at every Mass. Every time the priest repeats these words at the altar, heaven touches earth, and we proclaim a love that dies, rises, and returns again.

Saint Thérèse of Lisieux said: "O Jesus, who are You if not the Eucharist?

The living Bread come down from heaven!"

Her whole life was a Eucharistic surrender—a reminder that this sacrament is not just for adoration but for **transformation**. In the *Lauda Sion* we hear:

"Whoso of this food partakes, Does not rend the Lord nor breaks; Christ is whole to all that taste."

Whether one or a thousand receive, Christ remains undivided, entirely present to each heart.

3. The Miracle of Multiplication

In Luke's Gospel, Jesus feeds **five thousand** with five loaves and two fish. This is not only a miracle of provision—it is a **foreshadowing of the Eucharist**.

He took the bread, blessed it, broke it, and gave it—the same actions repeated in the Mass, from the Last Supper until today.

Saint John Vianney said, "If we truly understood the Mass, we would die of joy."

Yes, because it is here that Jesus multiplies His very self—not in quantity, but in grace and presence.

We are like the tired crowd in the Gospel—hungry, hurting, in need of guidance. And Christ says to each of us: "Take and eat; this is My Body." This food never runs out, never goes stale, and never ceases to satisfy the deepest hunger of the human soul.

4. The Saints: Witnesses of Eucharistic Fire

The saints loved the Eucharist with burning hearts.

- St. Padre Pio would spend hours in thanksgiving after Mass, his eyes wet with tears.
- St. Teresa of Calcutta once said,

"When you look at the crucifix, you see how much Jesus loved you then.

When you look at the Eucharist, you see how much He loves you now."

• St. Peter Julian Eymard devoted his entire life to Eucharistic adoration, calling it "the divine heartbeat of the Church."

They believed what we profess: "Very bread, good shepherd, tend us,

Jesu, of Your love befriend us..." (Lauda Sion)

5. Living the Eucharist Daily

Beloved friends, the Eucharist is not a moment in the week—it is **the rhythm of our life**.

If Christ gives us **everything** in the Eucharist, how can we give Him anything less than our **everything** in return?

So let us ask ourselves today:

- Do I approach Holy Communion with awe or out of habit?
- Do I spend time with Jesus in **adoration**, or leave Him waiting?
- Do I live as **His Body**, offering forgiveness, charity, and mercy to others?

The Lauda Sion urges us with bold prayer:

"Grant us with Your saints, though lowest, Where the heavenly feast You show, Fellow heirs and guests to be."

Final Invitation

So come, dear people of God. Come to the **altar of mercy**. Come to the **feast of love**. Come with your wounds, your doubts, your hopes, and your longing. Come to **Jesus in the Eucharist**, and become what you receive— **His Body, broken for the world**; **His Blood, poured out in love**.

Amen.



Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo (Corpus Christi) 22 de junio 2025 Hermana Gertrudis Muñoz Mendieta

La festividad de Corpus Christi se celebra el jueves posterior al domingo de la Santísima Trinidad. Después de la reforma litúrgica del Concilio Vaticano II la fiesta de Corpus Christi se llama Fiesta del Cuerpo y de la Sangre de Cristo. La Solemnidad del Corpus Christi fue establecida en 1246 por el Obispo Roberto de Torete y a sugerencia de Santa Juliana de Mont Cornillon. Después del milagro eucarístico de Bolsena, a mediados del Siglo XIII, el Papa Urbano IV expandió esta celebración a toda la Iglesia Universal.

La Eucaristía es 'fuente y culmen de la vida cristiana'. 'Los demás sacramentos, e incluso todos los ministerios eclesiásticos y las obras de apostolado, están vinculados a la Eucaristía y a ella se orientan. Pues en la sagrada Eucaristía se contiene todo el bien espiritual de la Iglesia, es decir, Cristo mismo, nuestra Pascua'. – Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, 1324

Este fin de semana, la Iglesia celebra una de las grandes solemnidades de nuestro calendario: la fiesta del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo (más conocida por su nombre en latín, Corpus Christi). Instituida en el siglo citado en el texto anterior y surgida de la devoción popular a Jesucristo en la Eucaristía, esta fiesta es una oportunidad para honrar y agradecer el gran don del Santísimo Sacramento, más allá del sacrificio diario de la Misa.

Para ayudarles a celebrar esta gran fiesta y meditar en el misterio de la Eucaristía, aquí tienen algunas citas de algunos de nuestros santos. Como nos aconseja el Papa San Juan Pablo II en su encíclica de 2003, Ecclesia de Eucharistia : «Queridos hermanos y hermanas, sigámonos en la escuela de los santos, que son los grandes intérpretes de la verdadera piedad eucarística».

Santa Teresa de Lisieux (1873 – 1897)

«Oh, querida mía, piensa entonces qué Jesús está allí en el Sagrario expresamente para ti, solo para ti; arde en el deseo de entrar en tu corazón.»

Santa Teresa Benedicta de la Cruz (Edith Stein) (1891 – 1942)

Para cada católico existe un tesoro inconmensurable: la cercanía del Señor en el santo sacrificio y en el santísimo sacramento del altar. Quien está imbuido de una fe viva en Cristo presente en el sagrario, quien sabe que un amigo lo espera constantemente —siempre con el tiempo, la paciencia y la compasión para escuchar quejas, peticiones y problemas, con consejo y ayuda en todo—, esta persona no puede permanecer desolada ni abandonada ni siquiera en las mayores dificultades. Siempre tiene un refugio donde puede reencontrar la quietud y la paz.

San Juan María Vianney (1786 – 1859)


Nuestro Señor está escondido allí, esperando que vayamos a visitarlo y le pidamos algo. ¡Miren qué bueno es! Se adapta a nuestra debilidad. En el Cielo, donde seremos gloriosos y triunfantes, lo veremos en toda su gloria. Si se hubiera presentado ante nosotros en esa gloria ahora, no nos habríamos atrevido a acercarnos a él; pero se esconde, como una persona en prisión, que podría decirnos: «No me ven, pero eso no importa; pídanme todo lo que quieran y se lo concederé». Él está allí, en el Sacramento de su amor, suspirando e intercediendo incesantemente ante su Padre por los pecadores

San Juan Pablo II (1920 – 2005)







They were behind one month on their rent. We happily paid the month they owed plus the current month, and we pray Raymond is correct and that his disability does start soon.

Tammy was asked by her landlord to vacate her apartment. He found that he could rent the same space for much more money than Tammy was able to afford. She had enough money to pay a deposit on a new place, but was unable to afford the first month's rent. We helped her with two month's rent because she still had to move her belongings and arrange to have utilities turned on.

Beatrice missed a lot of work last month caring for her daughter who was diagnosed with thyroid cancer. She had to take her to Ft. Worth several times for doctor consultations and finally the surgery. The American Cancer Society helped her with accommodations while she was in Ft. Worth, but she needed help paying her rent in midland. Because her daughter is still in need of several more trips to Ft. Worth after the surgery, we elected to pay two months of their rent as well.
