SUNDAY REFLECTION BY FR. BALA

Homily for the Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Readings: Isaiah 66:10–14c, Galatians 6:14–18, Luke 10:1–12, 17–20

Beloved in Christ, today's Scriptures pour out a torrent of God's love, a love that cradles us, redeems us, and sends us forth to heal a broken world. On this Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, we are invited to weep with joy at God's tenderness, to cling fiercely to the Cross, and to run with burning hearts as disciples of the Kingdom. Let these readings stir your soul, drawing on the fire of theology, the wisdom of the Church, and words that will linger in your heart, urging you to live boldly for Christ.

A Mother's Embrace: God's Unfailing Love (Isaiah 66:10–14c)

Imagine a mother cradling her child, wiping away tears, whispering comfort. This is the God Isaiah reveals: "Rejoice with Jerusalem... suck fully of the milk of her comfort." To a people stumbling home from exile, hearts heavy with loss, God promises not just restoration but abundance—rivers of prosperity, a love that rocks us "in her lap." This is no distant deity but a God who aches for us, who gathers our brokenness into a warm embrace.

Julian of Norwich, that mystic of divine love, saw this truth: "As truly as God is our Father, so truly is God our Mother." The Church teaches that God's love is boundless, surpassing all human imagining (CCC, 239). In our own exile—whether it's grief, loneliness, or fear—God's promise holds: "You shall be carried in her arms." Can you feel it? The God who formed the stars bends low to hold you, to whisper, "You are mine."

"In God's arms, every tear becomes a song of joy."

The Cross: Our Only Glory (Galatians 6:14–18)

St. Paul's voice thunders through the ages: "May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ!" Picture him, scarred from beatings, chains, and rejection, yet his heart blazes with love for the Cross. To the Galatians, tempted to trust in human achievements, Paul cries, "The world has been crucified to me, and I to it!" The Cross is not defeat—it's victory, the moment God's love shattered the chains of sin.

St. Augustine called the Cross "the bed where Christ sleeps for love of us." The Church proclaims it as the source of our salvation (CCC, 616–618). Paul's "marks of Jesus" on his body—scars of sacrifice—shout that he belongs to Christ. What are your marks? The sleepless nights caring for a loved one? The courage to forgive when it hurts? Every wound borne for love is a badge of glory, a testament that you, too, are a new creation.

"The Cross is your anchor, your glory, your home."

Sent with Burning Hearts (Luke 10:1–12, 17–20)

Now, picture Jesus, his eyes alight with urgency, sending seventy-two disciples into the world. "The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few." Like lambs among wolves, they go—without money, without baggage, only the fire of God's peace in their hearts. They offer, "Peace be to this household," and miracles follow: demons flee, hearts awaken. When they return, faces glowing, Jesus rejoices, "I saw Satan fall like lightning!" Henri Nouwen said, "Mission is living with a heart on fire for God." The Church calls every baptized soul to this work (Lumen Gentium, 33). Jesus' command to travel light strips us bare: let go of fear, pride, control. Trust God. Speak peace. And when rejection stings, shake the dust from your feet, not in anger, but in freedom, knowing your worth lies in heaven. Go out, and share the good news with your smile, your kindness, your courage—they are sparks of the Kingdom.

"Run with a burning heart, for your name shines in heaven."

A Call to Live with Passion

These readings are a love letter from God, written in the ink of Isaiah's hope, Paul's scars, and the disciples' dusty feet. Isaiah wraps us in God's maternal embrace, promising that no pain is beyond God's healing. Paul lifts the Cross as our banner, daring us to find glory in sacrifice. Jesus sends us, hearts ablaze, to be peace in a world of chaos.

In this moment, feel the weight of your calling. You are not just a face in the pew—you are God's beloved, marked by the Cross, sent to love fiercely. As St. Catherine of Siena cried, "Be who God meant you to be, and you will set the world on fire!" Bring peace to your family. Offer mercy to your enemy. Share hope with the stranger. The harvest waits, and Christ goes with you.

Closing Prayer: O God, you hold us as a mother, redeem us through the Cross, and send us with burning hearts. Fill us with your love, that we may run to the harvest, proclaiming your peace. May our lives shout your glory, now and forever. Amen.

Santa María Goretti
6 de julio 2025
Hermana Gertrudis Muñoz Mendieta I.C.A.S.

Santa María Goretti es una santa sencilla y humilde. Murió a los 11 años, pero su madurez humana superaba con mucho la edad cronológica. En su casa hacía las faenas domésticas mientras su madre trabajaba en el campo, pues ya había muerto su papá. Cuidaba a sus hermanitos pequeños, les hacía rezar y los educaba con sus consejos y buenos ejemplos.

Hubiera querido comulgar todos los días desde su primera comunión, pero la iglesia parroquial estaba a más de 10 kilómetros de distancia. Iba todos los domingos y aprovechaba para vender huevos y palomas para conseguir algún dinero para la economía familiar.

En su misma casa vivía un joven de 18 años, llamado Alejandro Serenelli, quien se fijó en ella y quiso obligarla a tener relaciones sexuales, pero ella tenía un alto concepto del valor de la pureza y no aceptó. Al mes del primer intento, Alejandro la mató, occasionándole 14 heridas con un punzón.

Desde el primer momento fue considerada como mártir de la pureza. Su figura se fue engrandeciendo, le hicieron monumentos, la invocaban y ella obtenía de Dios muchas gracias y bendiciones. Por lo cual se comenzó el proceso para probar su martirio. Fue beatificada en 1947 y canonizada en 1950, asistiendo su propia madre, ante más de quinientas mil personas. Hoy santa María Goretti es un ejemplo para la juventud, un modelo de pureza y santidad.

Su asesino Alejandro se arrepintió sinceramente de su pecado y llevó una vida ejemplar en los 27 años de cárcel y, especialmente, después de salir de ella. Trabajó en varios oficios, pero durante sus últimos años vivió, siendo seglar y miembro de la tercera Orden franciscana, en un convento de padres capuchinos, dando ejemplo a todos de vida de oración, sacrificio y obediencia como portero y hortelano. Murió a los 88 años. De él podemos decir: Fue un asesino convertido por el perdón y el amor de su víctima. Ella se le apareció, estando en la cárcel de Noto, manifestándole su deseo de que estuviera con ella eternamente en el paraíso.

Evita a los malos amigos, que tienen los ojos sucios y el alma podrida, porque te van a contaminar. Levanta tu mirada al cielo, Dios te está mirando. Mira el rostro de Dios, a través de las cosas bellas que ha creado para ti. Mira con ojos puros a los niños y alégrate con su inocencia, mira las mujeres bellas y alégrate con su belleza, pero no las manches con miradas impuras. Mira a los pájaros, a los árboles, a las flores, y sentirás su pureza reflejada en tu rostro.




