SUNDAY REFLECTION BY FR. BALA

Homily: 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time – Year C

Theme: "The One Thing Necessary: Presence Over Performance" **Readings**: Genesis 18:1-10a | Colossians 1:24–28 | Luke 10:38–42

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Today's readings bring to life a divine invitation—an invitation to rediscover the sacred priority of being with God over merely doing for God. Our world is fast-paced, our calendars full, our souls distracted. But God still whispers what He told Martha: "There is need of only one thing." What is this "one thing"? It is the attentive, loving, listening heart that sits before the Lord and lets Him speak, heal, and fill.

1. Abraham: Hospitality to God is the Gateway to Miracles (Genesis 18:1–10a)

Abraham welcomes three mysterious visitors—who are, in fact, the Lord Himself. The Church Fathers, particularly **St. Ambrose** and **Origen**, interpret this moment as a *Trinitarian theophany*. Abraham's tent becomes a temple. His table becomes an altar. His hospitality becomes worship.

St. John Chrysostom says: "When you open your door to the stranger, you welcome Christ. When you feed the hungry, you serve the Lord."

CCC 1970 teaches us: "The Law of the Gospel requires us to make the decisive choice between 'the two ways' and to put into practice the words of the Lord." Abraham didn't wait to be asked—he ran to serve. But his service flowed from a heart attuned to God's presence.

2. Martha and Mary: The Struggle of Every Soul (Luke 10:38–42)

This Gospel scene is not just about two sisters. It is a drama within the human heart. Martha, distracted and overwhelmed, symbolizes the active life; **Mary**, sitting and listening, the contemplative life.

St. Augustine beautifully says: "Martha received the Lord into her house; Mary received Him into her heart." Martha's mistake wasn't in serving—it was in forgetting why she served. **Pope Benedict XVI** reminds us, "We must not forget that the true treasure of the Church is not her activity, but her constant dwelling with the Lord.'

St. Teresa of Ávila wrote: "We need both Marthas and Marys. But let Mary always have the better part in us." CCC 2709 affirms this need for interior prayer: "Contemplation is a gaze of faith, fixed on Jesus. 'I look at Him and He looks at me': this is what a certain peasant of Ars used to say to his holy curé."

3. St. Paul: Suffering for the Church, Christ in You (Colossians 1:24–28)

Paul's mysterious words—"I rejoice in my sufferings for your sake"—invite us into redemptive suffering. We are not saved by our works, but when united with Christ, our suffering becomes a participation in His saving work.

St. Thomas Aquinas explains: "Christ's passion is not only the cause of our salvation, but also the model of our

And what is the mystery Paul speaks of? "Christ in you, the hope of glory." This is not mere inspiration; it's the real indwelling of the Trinity through grace.

CCC 521: "Christ enables us to live in Him all that He Himself lived, and He lives it in us."

Practical Applications: How to Choose the "One Thing Necessary"

1. Start Your Day at the Feet of Jesus

Before checking your phone, bow your head. Read the Gospel. Let Him speak.

2. Let Hospitality Be Worship

When you open your home, welcome someone as you would welcome Christ.

3. Turn Interruptions Into Intercessions

Instead of annoyance, see each interruption as God asking: Will you make room for Me?

4. Embrace Contemplative Moments

Like Mary, sit before the Blessed Sacrament—even five minutes of silence with Jesus is worth more than hours of busy work without Him.

5. Offer Your Sufferings

Unite them with Christ. Like Paul, say: "I rejoice in my sufferings," not because you like pain, but because pain can be filled with divine purpose.

A Final Anecdote:

When St. Francis of Assisi was asked how he accomplished so much with so little, he replied, "I have done what is mine to do; may Christ teach you what is yours."

He spent hours in silence before the crucifix—and from that silence flowed the transformation of the Church.

Conclusion: Beloved in Christ, we are all Marthas running around. But Jesus is waiting. He wants us to be Marys—sitting, listening, loving. He wants to fill our emptiness with His fullness.

Let your life be a tent like Abraham's. Let your heart be a home like Mary's.

Let your sufferings be like Paul's—offered up for the glory of Christ.

And let your soul hunger for the *one thing necessary—to be with Jesus*. **Amen.**
