SUNDAY REFLECTION BY FR. BALA

Theme: Living with Courageous Faith and Vigilant Hope in a World of Uncertainty

Readings: Wisdom 18:6–9; Hebrews 11:1–2, 8–19; Luke 12:32–48

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, Grace and peace to you on this Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time.

As we gather here in the presence of our loving God, let us pause for a moment and reflect on a simple truth: life is a journey, often filled with uncertainties, fears, and unexpected turns. Yet, in the midst of it all, our readings today whisper a profound invitation—to live with faith that moves mountains, hope that anchors the soul, and a readiness that opens our hearts to the Kingdom of God.

These words from Wisdom, Hebrews, and the Gospel of Luke are not just ancient texts; they are a balm for our weary hearts, a call to awaken from slumber, and a promise that God is ever faithful, even when we falter.

<u>Let us begin with the Book of Wisdom</u>, where we hear of the night of the Passover—the sacred vigil when God's people awaited their deliverance.

"The night of the exodus was known beforehand to our ancestors... so that... they might have courage."

Imagine the scene: families huddled in dimly lit homes, the blood of the lamb smeared on their doorposts, **hearts pounding with** a mix of terror and trust.

They didn't see the full picture—but they believed in the promises of God. Their faith wasn't passive—it was a courageous waiting, a vigilant hope that transformed fear into freedom.

This echoes so deeply in our own lives, doesn't it? How many of us have faced our own "nights of exodus"—moments of illness, loss, or uncertainty?

I think of a parishioner I visited last week, a young mother battling cancer.

With tears in her eyes, she shared how she clings to God's oaths, **not knowing what tomorrow holds, but trusting** that He who delivered Israel will walk with her through the valley.

Faith isn't the absence of fear; it's the presence of courage in the face of it.

God invites us today to reclaim that ancestral faith, to stand firm in His promises, knowing that our deliverance is already woven into His divine plan.

<u>Turning to the Letter to the Hebrews</u>, we encounter one of the most stirring definitions of faith in all of Scripture:

"Faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen."

The author then paints a vivid portrait of **Abraham**, our father in faith.

- By faith, Abraham obeyed when called to set out for a place he had never seen.
- By faith, he dwelt in tents as a stranger in the promised land.
- By faith, he offered up his only son Isaac, believing that God could raise the dead.

Abraham's life was a testament to radical trust—a willingness to leave the familiar, to embrace the unknown, all because he fixed his eyes on the city with foundations, whose architect and builder is God.

Abraham wasn't a superhero; he was a man like us, with doubts and delays.

Yet, he chose faith over fear, step by step.

In our world today, bombarded by distractions and doubts, **Hebrews challenges us**:

What are we hoping for? What unseen realities convict our hearts?

Perhaps it's the healing of a broken relationship, the strength to forgive a deep wound, or the grace to persevere in a thankless job. I recall a story from the life of **Saint Teresa of Calcutta**. She once found a dying man in the gutters. As she cared for him, he whispered, "Why do you do this?"

She replied, "Because I see Jesus in you."

Her faith was her assurance—she hoped for the Kingdom not as a distant dream, but as a present reality breaking into the now.

Faith isn't just believing; it's acting on the hope that God is building something eternal through our ordinary lives.

And now, the Gospel from Luke brings this all home with urgency and tenderness.

"Do not be afraid, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom."

What comforting words!

- Sell your possessions, give alms
- Make purses that do not wear out—an unfailing treasure in heaven
- Be like servants waiting for their master, lamps lit, ready at any hour

The parable of the faithful steward warns us: blessed is the servant whom the master finds vigilant on his arrival. But woe to the one who abuses his position, thinking the master is delayed.

This Gospel moves me profoundly because it's not a scolding; it's a loving exhortation from Jesus, who knows our frailties.

He calls us His "little flock"—small, vulnerable, yet cherished beyond measure.

In a culture obsessed with security—bank accounts, insurance policies, endless planning—

Jesus invites us to a different kind of readiness: one rooted in generosity, simplicity, and trust.

Closing Encouragement: So, dear friends, let us take heart.

- Like the Israelites, let us wait with courage.
- Like Abraham, let us walk by faith and not by sight.
- Like Saint Teresa, let us act with compassion rooted in conviction.
- Like the faithful servant, let us stay awake, our lamps burning bright.

Because the Kingdom is near. The Master is coming. And we, His little flock, are never forgotten.






