SUNDAY REFLECTION BY FR. BALA

Homily – Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time Theme: Humility Opens the Door to God's Kingdom

Introduction

My dear brothers and sisters,

Today's readings center around one of the greatest and most difficult virtues: **humility**. In a world that prizes self-promotion, status, and recognition, the Word of God invites us to something radically different—the quiet greatness of humility, which is the key to entering the Kingdom of God.

First Reading: Sirach 3:17-18, 20, 28-29

The Book of Sirach gives us timeless wisdom: "My child, conduct your affairs with humility, and you will be loved more than a giver of gifts."

The wise man reminds us that the more we grow in knowledge, position, or success, the more humble we must become. Like a tree: the more fruit it bears, the lower its branches bend. True wisdom bows low before God and others. Pride closes our heart, but humility opens it to God's grace.

Second Reading: Hebrews 12:18-24a

The Letter to the Hebrews contrasts two mountains:

• Mount Sinai, where the Israelites trembled in fear before thunder, fire, and divine majesty.

Mount Zion, the heavenly Jerusalem, where we approach Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, with confidence and joy.

The point is this: God is not calling us into terror but into communion. But to enter Zion—the heavenly banquet—we must come as beggars, not as claimants; as children, not as masters. Pride cannot stand before God's glory, but humility allows us to receive His mercy and join the saints in worship.

Gospel: Luke 14:1, 7-14

In the Gospel, Jesus attends a banquet. He notices how people scramble for the places of honor. With divine wisdom, He teaches: "When you are invited, go and sit in the lowest place." This is not merely about etiquette but about the posture of our hearts.

Those who exalt themselves will be humbled; those who humble themselves will be exalted.

Jesus then goes further: "When you give a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind." In other words, humility is not just about lowering ourselves but about lifting others up, especially those who cannot repay us. This reflects the very heart of God, who gives without expecting repayment.

Spiritual Application

- 1. **Humility before God** Do I recognize that everything I have—life, health, talents, family, faith—is a gift? Or do I act as if I earned it all myself?
- 2. **Humility before others** Do I seek recognition, titles, or praise? Or do I serve quietly, even when no one notices?

Hospitality of the heart – Am I willing to open my life to the poor, the broken, the marginalized, even when it is inconvenient or costly?

The Eucharist itself is God's banquet where we come not as the worthy but as the hungry. We kneel in humility, and God feeds us with His very Body and Blood.

Examples from the Saints

- St. Francis of Assisi left behind wealth and honor to embrace poverty and simplicity, showing us that humility leads to joy.
- St. Teresa of Calcutta (Mother Teresa) often said: "God cannot fill what is already full. We must empty ourselves to let Him in."

Even **Jesus Himself**, the King of kings, humbled Himself to wash the feet of His disciples and die on the Cross. This is the model of humility we are called to imitate.

Conclusion

Dear friends, the Kingdom of God is not about climbing ladders of power, but about stooping low in service. True greatness is found not in being honored, but in honoring others; not in being served, but in serving. Let us then live out Sirach's wisdom, walk in the joy of Mount Zion, and follow Jesus' example at the banquet of life. If we humble ourselves now, one day we will hear the words of the Lord: "Friend, move up higher... Come, share in your Master's joy." Amen.



We received a call from a young man needing assistance. He was clearly uncomfortable to be making the call, and it was obvious that he had never done this before. He has a steady, full-time job and we had no record of any agency having helped him in the past.

When we met with him, we found that he was a single parent, raising two young children. His wife had left him when his youngest was an infant and the older one was a toddler. She left without warning – just called him a work one day five years ago and told him she wanted out. She was tired of being a mother and was leaving him. If he didn't want the children left alone, he'd better get home now

He left work as soon as he contacted his supervisor, and when he got home, true to her word, the children were alone. Over the next several months he rearranged his life to accommodate the needs of his children while still maintaining his job, paying his bills, and being both mom and dad. Family members helped out with daycare when they could until he made suitable arrangements.

Five years passed and he remained the single parent, working at his job, raising his two babies. His life revolved around them. Then, several months ago, his wife telephoned him for the first time in many years. She threatened to come and take the children away. Frantic that he might lose his babies to a woman who had been less than stable in the past, he hired a lawyer to do whatever was necessary to protect his rights and the well-being of his children. The lawyer filed papers that would make the mother unable to get passports for the children without the father's consent. The immediate threat of his children being taken across the border was averted, at least for the time being. The financial costs left him unable to pay his small electric bill and part of his rent. We gladly paid and wished we could do more, however he would not accept additional help.

We hear so much about the plight of single mothers. There are many, many dads out there who are left in the same predicament. Please pray for all of them.


