

Itinerary Overview

Day 1: Monday, June 29, 2026

Depart Dallas, USA

Depart from Dallas (DFW) for an overnight flight to Rome, Italy (FCO). Relax and prepare for the sacred journey ahead. Overnight on flight.

Day 2: Tuesday, June 30, 2026

Rome, Italy

Arrive at Rome's Fiumicino Airport (FCO) and transfer to your hotel. Begin the pilgrimage with visits to the Basilica of Santa Maria Maggiore, the Basilica of St. John Lateran, the Colosseum, and Santa Croce in Gerusalemme. Celebrate Mass and enjoy a welcome dinner. Overnight in Rome.

Day 3: Wednesday, July 1, 2026

Rome, Italy

Attend a Papal Audience at the Vatican (subject to availability). Visit St. Peter's Basilica for Mass, followed by the Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel. Explore the Trevi Fountain and Spanish Steps. Enjoy lunch and dinner in Rome. Overnight in Rome.

Day 4: Thursday, July 2, 2026

Rome to San Giovanni Rotondo, Italy

Visit St. Paul Outside the Walls and Tres Fontane in Rome. Travel to Montecassino Abbey and Pietrelcina's Santa Maria degli Angeli, birthplace of Padre Pio. Arrive in San Giovanni Rotondo for dinner. Overnight in San Giovanni Rotondo.

Day 5: Friday, July 3, 2026

San Giovanni Rotondo, Italy

Journey to Monte Sant'Angelo for a morning visit to the sacred cave shrine. Return to San Giovanni Rotondo for lunch and a visit to the Padre Pio Shrine to view his relics. Conclude with Evening Mass and dinner. Overnight in San Giovanni Rotondo.

Day 6: Saturday, July 4, 2026

San Giovanni Rotondo to Loreto, Italy

Drive to Lanciano for Mass at the Eucharistic Miracle Sanctuary. After lunch, continue to Loreto to visit the Basilica of the Holy House. Enjoy dinner and rest. Overnight in Loreto.

Day 7: Sunday, July 5, 2026

Loreto to Florence, Italy

Travel to Assisi to visit St. Francis' Tomb and St. Carlo Acutis' relics, followed by Mass. Depart for Florence in the afternoon to explore Basilica di Santa Croce. Savor dinner in Florence. Overnight in Florence.

Day 8: Monday, July 6, 2026

Florence to Mariazell, Austria

Celebrate Mass at Florence Cathedral. Drive to Venice for lunch and a visit to St. Mark's Basilica. Continue to Mariazell for dinner and rest. Overnight in Mariazell.

Day 9: Tuesday, July 7, 2026

Mariazell to Krakow, Poland

Attend Mass at Mariazell Basilica, a revered Marian shrine. Travel to Krakow and visit the Divine Mercy Sanctuary. Enjoy dinner and rest. Overnight in Krakow.

Day 10: Wednesday, July 8, 2026

Krakow to Prague, Czech Republic

Visit Krakow Cathedral in the morning. Drive to Auschwitz for a guided tour of the memorial. Continue to Prague for dinner and an overnight stay. Overnight in Prague.

Day 11: Thursday, July 9, 2026

Prague to Einsiedeln, Switzerland

Celebrate Mass at the Infant Jesus of Prague shrine. Walk across Charles Bridge and enjoy lunch. Drive to Einsiedeln for dinner and rest. Overnight in Einsiedeln.

Day 12: Friday, July 10, 2026

Einsiedeln to Cologne, Germany

Attend Mass at Einsiedeln Monastery, home to the Black Madonna. Visit Rhine Falls for a two-hour stop, then continue to Cologne for dinner. Overnight in Cologne.

Day 13: Saturday, July 11, 2026

Cologne to Bruges, Belgium

Tour Cologne Cathedral. Drive to Kevelaer for Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary, then proceed to Bruges for dinner and rest. Overnight in Bruges.

Day 14: Sunday, July 12, 2026

Bruges to Paris, France

Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Holy Blood in Bruges. Travel to Paris to visit Sacré-Cœur, the Miraculous Medal Chapel, and Notre-Dame (exterior). Enjoy a Seine River boat ride and view the Eiffel Tower. Dinner in Paris. Overnight in Paris.

Day 15: Monday, July 13, 2026

Paris to Tours, France

Journey to Lisieux to visit St. Thérèse Basilica. Continue to Mont St. Michel for a guided tour of the island abbey. End in Tours with a visit to St. Martin Basilica and dinner. Overnight in Tours.

Day 16: Tuesday, July 14, 2026

Tours to Lourdes, France

Travel to Lourdes and check into your hotel. Visit the Lourdes Shrine, attend Mass, and join the candlelight procession. Enjoy dinner and rest. Overnight in Lourdes.

Day 17: Wednesday, July 15, 2026

Lourdes to Barcelona, Spain

Celebrate Mass at the Lourdes Grotto and experience the Holy Bath. Drive to Montserrat to visit the Black Madonna Basilica, then continue to Barcelona for dinner. Overnight in Barcelona.

Day 18: Thursday, July 16, 2026

Barcelona to Madrid, Spain

Visit Sagrada Família for Mass. Drive to Madrid and explore Almudena Cathedral. Enjoy dinner and rest in Spain's capital. Overnight in Madrid.

Day 19: Friday, July 17, 2026

Madrid to Santiago de Compostela, Spain

Travel to Santiago de Compostela, the endpoint of the Camino de Santiago. Visit the Cathedral and celebrate Mass. Enjoy dinner and rest. Overnight in Santiago de Compostela.

Day 20: Saturday, July 18, 2026

Santiago de Compostela to Fatima, Portugal

Drive to Fatima, arriving for Mass at 5:00 PM and the candlelight procession. Savor dinner and rest in this Marian shrine. Overnight in Fatima.

Day 21: Sunday, July 19, 2026

Fatima, Portugal

After breakfast, enjoy optional prayer time at the Fatima Shrine. Spend the day reflecting at this sacred site, with Mass and free time for personal devotion. Dinner in Fatima. Overnight in Fatima.

Day 22: Monday, July 20, 2026

Fatima to Lisbon, Portugal, and Return to Dallas, USA

Transfer to Lisbon Airport (LIS) for your return flight to Dallas (DFW). Arrive in Dallas on the same day, concluding your pilgrimage.
