



UNDERSTANDING THE SCRIPTURE

What is the secret to sharing in God's power to overcome our difficulties? Mary teaches us this in the prophecy of her pierced heart. This Sunday, the old man Simeon prophesies that when her son faces opposition, Mary's soul will be pierced by a sword. The seemingly pointless agony of a mother helplessly watching her son be mocked, tortured, killed and then cruelly desecrated in death by a spear — somehow this piercing of her heart releases a power by which **"the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed"** (Luke 2:35). What to make of this?

Whatever problems we currently face, the deepest threat is finally that evil thoughts are hidden in the human heart: hatred, envy, pride, lust, greed and so on. Behind every tyrant's injustice, for example, is a heart unpierced by love. Evil hides in our hearts. Mary's pierced heart, and its suffering love for her son, reveals and scatters these evil thoughts, and replaces them with love, forgiveness, generosity and peace.

This week, I invite us to ponder Mary's pierced heart. Her heart is quietly at work for us in the Church and world, exposing our evil thoughts and making a path for her son's divine love. This is how she gently cooperates in our salvation. Closed hearts are our biggest problem; love-pierced hearts are the ultimate power to overcome every difficulty.

THEME	OBJECTS	SCRIPTURE
If God tells you to do it, you can do it.	Textbook.	Jeremiah 1:4-10

DISCUSSION

Do you ever feel like you're just too young or too small to do something? Can anyone think of a time when you might have said, "I just can't do it!" (Pause for responses.) We have all said that at one time or another. Maybe you said it when the coach asked you to play a new position for the first time, or while you were trying to do your homework. (Hold up textbook). We've all found ourselves feeling defeated, saying, "I just can't do it."

Our Bible lesson today is about a man named Jeremiah. One day, God spoke to Jeremiah and said, "Before you were even born, I chose you to be My prophet to all the nations." Wow, that's a tall order! Can you imagine being chosen by God to speak His words to all the nations of the world? Jeremiah answered, "I can't! I'm not a good speaker, and besides, I'm too young." "Don't say 'I can't,'" the LORD answered Jeremiah. "If I tell you to go and speak to someone, then go! And when I tell you what to say, don't leave out a word!" Then the LORD reached out His hand, and touched Jeremiah's mouth and said, "I am giving you the words to say, and I am sending you with authority to speak to the nations for Me."

God called Jeremiah to a monumental task before he was even born. But He wasn't going to leave Jeremiah to do it all on his own. God also promised to give Jeremiah all the words he would need to speak. Just like God had some mighty big plans for Jeremiah, He also has some pretty big plans for you too. He knows your name. He knew you before you were even born and He has a plan for your life.

There will be times in your life when God will come to you, as He did to Jeremiah, and ask you to do something important for Him. He may call you to do something that feels difficult, or maybe even impossible. You may feel like you're too young, and you might even want to say, "I just can't do it." But when that happens, remember what God said to Jeremiah, "Don't say, 'I can't!'" If God calls you to do something, He will reach out His hand and touch your life to give you the ability to do it.

Dear Father, there may be some things in this life that we cannot do on our own. But we know that if You ask us to do something, You will give us the ability to do it if we just trust in You. Amen.



2025 is a Jubilee Year! The Jubilee year is based on an ancient Hebrew tradition from the book of Leviticus. The 50th year was a time of spiritual "reset". Land was left uncultivated, prisoners were freed, debts were forgiven and people focused on faith and social justice. In 2016 Pope Francis declared an extraordinary (out of sequence) Jubilee of Mercy. We are encouraged to experience God's love through reconciliation, mercy, acts of charity and forgiveness. This Jubilee is the year of Hope. The logo for the Jubilee is the anchor, symbol of hope. We are pilgrims of hope, anchored in our faith. We are called to be signs of hope for the sick, the poor, the elderly, prisoners and the displaced. It is an opportunity for our own spiritual "reset".




