UNDERSTANDING THE SCRIPTURE

When I was a seminarian almost 20 years ago, a bank vice president taught us etiquette classes. She said, "Gentlemen, please make sure your breath isn't bad. Take some breath mints before you hear confessions, okay?" We nervously laughed because the proximity that makes breath noticeable (whether pleasant or not) can be a bit awkward.

When Jesus breathes on his Apostles, He must have been within inches of at least some of them. This closeness of His breath has a purpose: the purpose of forgiveness of sins. **"Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them" (John 20:23)**. Why in the world would the almost uncomfortable closeness of His breath forgive sins?

In the Bible, breath is spirit or wind. It comes from above and makes that which is below to have identity. To not have a single identity is to be multiple, divided. The word "sin" comes from an ancient word that means "to split" or "render asunder." Sin divides us sinners and the world around us; our spiritual "breath" leaves us and our identity splinters. Only breath from above restores. For example, a shattered vase is rendered whole because the craftsman breathes the spirit of the vase back into it when he repairs it. A human being shattered by sin is made whole by the breath of God, breathed by Jesus through His priests. His breath alone forgives sins. It's always done with his gentle, loving closeness.

The Holy Spirit came on the day of Pentecost.	A windsock; a strong fan.	Acts 2:1-21

DISCUSSION

You probably know this is a windsock or a type of kite. It was invented many years ago in Japan and was flown on "Boys Day." Families would hang one windsock for each son in their family. You might've seen one at an airport, too. They show pilots which way the wind is blowing so they can take off and land safely. They're even used to help guide the Space Shuttle pilots.

No one can see the wind, but we know the wind is there because it moves the windsock. But just because we can't see the wind, that doesn't mean it's not important. The wind helps us cool off when we get hot; it cleans the air from smog; and it can even be used to power our homes. What other things can you think of that the wind does? (Pause.)

God's Spirit is kind of like the wind. We can't see the Holy Spirit, but the Holy Spirit is very important and always with us. What is something else you can think of that you can't see but is still very important? (Pause.)


When God sent His Holy Spirit to be with His people for the first time, it was like a mighty, rushing wind. (Lead kids in making a "whoosh!" sound.) Many churches still celebrate that special day. It's called the day of Pentecost. A bunch of believers were all gathered together. (Turn on the fan, and blow it on the children.) When the loud wind came, they saw what looked like tongues of fire that came to rest on each of them, and all of them were filled with the Holy Spirit. How would you feel if you saw fire coming down on your head? Would you be scared? (Pause.)

The Holy Spirit helped them share God's message of love with everyone around by speaking other languages! When we believe, God puts His Holy Spirit in us, too. (While still feeling the wind from the fan, invite children to say "I believe!" and say an affirmation over each child, such as "God's Holy Spirit lives in you!")

There are so many ways the Holy Spirit helps us every day. You might say, "He is the wind in your socks!"

Dear God, we thank You for sending Your Holy Spirit to comfort us, guide us, and live within us. In Jesus' name, amen.


