We look forward to the fun activities our staff has planned!

Tuition for the 2023-2024 school year. After discussing tuition at the most recent SAC meeting, we decided to publish a tuition range for the coming school year. Right now, we are looking at \$4650-\$5000 for tuition for the coming school year. A lot will depend on enrollment, specifically kindergarten. We are also looking at other fundraising opportunities for additional revenue along with trimming the budget where we can. We will have a set amount by mid-February. If the high end of the range concerns you, please let me know. Your feedback is very important to us as we try to come up with the best possible rate that meets the financial needs of the school and parish.

As we have consistently said, if you want a high quality Catholic education for your child, we will find a way to make it happen. The inability to pay full tuition should not keep your child from attending our amazing school. Financial aid is available from the school and from other donors. You can apply through TADS. Total aid allocated for this current school year, between the parish and other sources was over \$100,000.
