A Peek at Our Week

Math:

- Students used circle drawings to add partners.
- Math centers included the following: Popcorn Fact Fluency, Shake and Spill to 10, Repeating Patterns and IXL Counting.

Reading:

- Reviewed memory words: she, he, I, my, her, and his.
- Decoded words with sh.
- Ettabetta's Radish Patch and The Patch it up Shop were the stories of the week.
- Centers included: Ch Bingo, Read to Self, IXL Blending and Guided Reading.
