

Bishop Michael Duca

This past Sunday we celebrated Bishop Muench's 50th ordination anniversary as a priest. The heat index was over 100 degrees, and you could feel every one of those degrees. The air conditioner in the Cathedral couldn't keep up. Bishop Muench used a reference to St. Veronica in his homily to take the opportunity to wipe his own face with a handkerchief.

At the reception, there were hundreds of nice, laminated prayer cards for the occasion, so I grabbed a handful. I hand out different prayer cards from time to time, so you may receive one the next time you go to confession with me. The prayer cards have a nice picture of Bishop Muench on the front, and on the back a prayer entitled, "The EASY Prayer." What is the EASY prayer? Come to confession to find out!

It seemed like the news that dominated this event was Bishop Muench's fainting spell after the Mass. I wonder if the Vatican took note, because within two days we received news that Pope Francis had accepted Bishop Muench's retirement and named his successor. This August, we will have a new bishop for the Diocese of Baton Rouge, Bishop Michael Duca, currently the bishop of Shreveport. Bishop Duca showed his personality and his heart at the press conference last Tuesday. He choked up when he thought about the blessing of his past assignments, and he made a point to reach out to Hispanic Catholics by saying a few words in Spanish. He will be installed as our bishop August 24, so I look forward to meeting him and welcoming him.

Chapel/Office Update

Someone stopped me in the grocery store and asked, "When are we building the new chapel?" Here's an update. On June 14, I met with the Diocese to present the architect's design plans of the chapel and cluster office. The Diocese had a few questions. Overall, it was pleasant meeting. I thought to myself, "Finally, a smooth road in the process!"

The following week I met with the Cluster Building Committee to present the same design plan. These are representatives from all parishes to give me input and feedback. I mentioned their names in my June 3 article, but here they are again: Harry Oubre and Lionel Cola (St James); Glenn Hymel and Casey Amedee (St Philip); Blaise Gravois and Deacon Ricky Oubre (Our Lady of Peace).

The committee suggested a small change: "You should put a bathroom closer to the chapel." There are some very good reasons to have a bathroom closer. As it turns out, it may be easier (that is, cheaper) to build a new bathroom in the chapel annex than bust out concrete to make a handicap restroom in the current building. Long story short, I'm getting the design finalized and will be looking for contractors soon.

Even though this is taking longer than I want, I would rather do it right. Thanks for your patience!
