Crossroads, located in Thibodaux, is a life-affirming Christian organization serving women struggling with an unexpected pregnancy who may be considering abortion. Founded in 2002 by Bishop Oscar Solis and a St. Joseph parishioner, Crossroads has helped over 2,800 women and men in Lafourche, Terrebonne, Assumption, Saint James and Saint Mary parishes. Crossroads does not provide abortions nor do they give referrals for abortions.

This is a joint project sponsored by Court St Philip and Court Notre Dame de la Paix and will occur at all three parishes.
