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How Are You? A Prayer for Unity

When someone asks, "How are you?", how many times have you responded, "Terrible, thanks for asking." Not too many, I imagine! I was thinking of this response because there's a radio show with the title, "Terrible, Thanks For Asking." The show includes interviews with people who are in a difficult place in life. They share their feelings which are sometimes complicated but always honest.

I was thinking of this phrase because of a recent heart-to-heart with a friend. On a recent visit to St. Ben's – a term of endearment for seminary on the north shore – I met up with a former Baton Rouge seminarian who is now teaching at the seminary. He asked me, "How are you?", and I responded with the expected platitudes. Then he looked me straight in the eye and said, "No, really. How are you?" He wanted to hear how I was doing at the level of the heart. Because I know this man well and am comfortable sharing with him, I told him how I was doing at the time: the good, the bad, the ugly. I don't remember what I said, and that's not the point. The point is I connected with a friend at a deeper level than sports and weather, two favorite topics for shootin' the bull.

As my friend asked me, so I ask you, "How are you, parishioners?" After sharing with you a couple of weeks ago that some parishioners are hurting right now, I heard concern from other parishioners about this. Some parishioners are hurting, and others feel compassion for their hurting brethren. One parishioner asked if we could pray for unity in the midst of the hurt, so I asked Fr. John to compose a prayer for unity. Below you will find his prayer. Please join me in praying this prayer. The Lord wants to heal the hurts in our parishes. How can you and I be an instrument of his healing?

If you would like to have your child Baptized in the cluster churches you **must** register online at www.canecatholics.com. The form has been redesigned so that you can indicate whether you are registering for the class and baptism or just baptism. You are only required to attend a class every five years. If you do not need to attend the class, you will fill out the information and indicate baptism only. This is the information we will use to record your child's baptism in the church records and to print the certificate. You are encouraged to log on to the website early in your pregnancy and read the requirements for Godparents before you choose them. Choosing a Godparent for your child is an important decision and we want you to have the information you need to make the best choice. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to call the Pastoral Center.

Treasures from our Tradition

Although June is the month most associated with weddings in the United States, September has become more popular in recent years. Wedding celebrations always require some savvy planning, and people who have a

talent for hospitality in the mix. At the wedding feast at Cana, the mother of Jesus was recruited to deal with some of the details of the banquet, and when a very understandable crisis arose, she did what she could to rescue the party. Anyone who has ever run out of ice, dessert, or table settings knows the stress! Slowly, the memory of Jesus Christ's blessing of this marriage feast led the Church to form a way to bless marriages. A thousand years ago weddings migrated from the family home to the doors of the church, where the celebration was held in public view. From this practice came a prayer called the Nuptial Blessing, one of the most solemn prayers in our tradition. It is very much like the prayers by which baptismal water and chrism are consecrated, the ordination prayer over a priest, and the Eucharistic Prayers over bread and wine. Four hundred fifty years ago, weddings moved inside the church building. All of this gives married couples good reason to celebrate their anniversaries well, especially with the clinking of glasses filled with good wine.
